### What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 15 balls  
00002 Nature A and 3 ball 00009  
Turquoise B

Crochet Hook: 9mm [US N-15]

Yarn needle

**TENSION/GAUGE:** 10 sts = 13 cm  
[5"]; Rows 1-4 = 8 cm [3"] using  
2 strands of yarn held together.  
**CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.**  
Use any size needles to obtain  
the tension/gauge.

## Weekend Throw

*Enjoying some time to relax on the weekend  
is easier with this cuddly crocheted throw.  
We've shown it in neutral with a contrasting  
border, but it would be just as comforting in  
any colour you desire.*

Throw measures 114 cm x 140 cm [45" x  
55"].

### Note

Work with 2 strands held together throughout.

### Special Abbreviations

**shell** = 7 tr in next space.

**Vst** = (tr, ch 2, tr) all in st or space indicated.

### Throw

With 2 strands of **A** held together, ch 116.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Dc in 2nd ch from hook  
and in next 5 ch, [ch 2, skip next 3 ch, (dc, ch  
2, dc) in next ch, ch 2, skip next 3 ch, dc in  
next 5 ch] 9 times, dc in last ch; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, skip first dc, tr in next 5 dc,  
[ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, Vst in next ch-2  
space, ch 2, tr in next 5 dc] 9 times, tr in last  
dc; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, skip first tr, tr in next 5 tr, [skip  
next ch-2 space, shell in next ch-2 space, skip  
next ch-2 space, tr in next 5 tr] 9 times, tr in  
top of ch-3; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, skip first tr, tr in next 5 tr, [ch  
2, Vst in 4th tr of shell, ch 2, skip next 3 tr of  
shell, tr in next 5 tr] 9 times, tr in top of ch-3;  
turn.

**Rows 5-62:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

**Row 63:** Ch 3, skip first tr, tr in next 5 tr, [ch  
2, skip next ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next  
ch-2 space, skip next ch-2 space, ch 2, tr in  
next 5 tr] 9 times, tr in top of ch-3; turn.

**Row 64:** Ch 1, dc in first 6 tr, [ch 3, skip next  
ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, skip  
next ch-2 space, dc in next 5 tr] 9 times, dc in  
top of ch-3. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

#### Border

**Round 1:** With right side facing, holding 2  
strands together, join **B** in any corner; ch 1,  
[(dc, ch 2, dc) in corner, work an odd number  
of dc evenly spaced to keep work flat to next  
corner] 4 times; join with a slip st in first dc.  
**Round 2:** Ch 1, skip first dc, \* (dc, ch 2, dc, ch  
3, dc, ch 2, dc) all in corner ch-2 space, skip  
next dc, \*\* (dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc, skip next  
dc; repeat from \*\* to next corner; repeat from  
\* around; join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

#### Abbreviations

**A, B, C** = Colour A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** =  
centimetres; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** =  
millimetres; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = triple  
or treble crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in  
brackets the number of times specified; **\*** or  
**\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as  
indicated.
