What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 4 balls 00007 Light Blue A, 1 ball each 09851 Royal Blue B and 00003 Orange C

Crochet Hooks: 5mm [US H-8] and 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle, sewing needle, black sewing thread, straight pins, black netting measuring 45.5 x 20.5 cm [18" x 8"], 2 buttons, 13mm [1/2"] (for flowers), 1 package medium size beads, 1 package sequins, 1 package craft feathers

TENSION/GAUGE: 12 sts = 10cm [4"]; 12 rows = 10 cm [4"] in pattern stitch using larger hook and 2 strands of A held together. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Wonderland Top Hat

Look like you just stepped out of a cinematic film in this fetching crocheted top hat! Deck it out with crocheted flowers, sequins and netting as we did, or let your creativity go as wild as you please.

Hat measures 48 cm [19"] circumference.

NOTES

Hat is worked in continuous rounds with right side facing at all times.

Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

HAT

Crown and Sides

With 2 strands of A held together and larger hook, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Work 8 dc into ring—8 dc.

Round 2: Work 2 dc in each st—16 dc.

Round 3: [Dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] 8 times-24 dc.

Round 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8

Round 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8 times-40 dc.

Round 6: Do in each st.

times-32 dc.

Round 7: [Dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8 times-48 dc.

Round 8: Dc in each st.

Round 9: [Dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8 times-56 dc.

Round 10: [Dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8 times-64 dc.

Round 11: Do in each st.

Round 12: [Dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8

times—72 dc.

Rounds 13-16: Do in each st.

Round 17: [Dc in next 7 sts, dc2tog] 8

times-64 dc.

Rounds 18 and 19: Dc in each st. Round 20: [Dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog] 8 times-56 dc.

Rounds 21-32: Dc in each st. Do not fasten

Brim

Round 33: [Dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8

times-64 dc.

Round 34: Do in each st.

Round 35: [Dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8

times—72 dc.

Round 36: Dc in each st.

Round 37: [Dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st] 8

times-80 dc.

Round 38: Dc in each st.

Round 39: [Dc in next 9 sts. 2 dc in next st] 8

times-88 dc.

Round 40: Dc in each st. Fasten off.

Hat Band

With larger hook and 1 strand of **B**, ch 9.

Row 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in ch. turn-8 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1. dc in each st. turn.

Repeat Row 2 until Hat Band fits around the base of Hat. Fasten off, leaving tail for sewing.

FLOWERS

Large Flower

With smaller hook and 1 strand of C. ch 25. Row 1: Work 3 tr in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Small Flower

With smaller hook and 1 strand of **A**, ch 17. Row 1: Work 3 tr in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Loosely roll each row around in a spiral to form flower. Sew a button and bead in the center of each flower through all layers to hold its shape.

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FINISHING

Hat Band

With black thread and sewing needle, sew three rows of sequins down the center of the Hat Band. With long tail threaded through yarn needle and wrong sides held together, sew Hat Band seam. Slip Hat Band onto the hat; sew in place. Pin flowers and feathers in desired positions and sew onto Hat Band. Sew beads around the flowers.

Netting

With double thickness of black thread, baste across one long edge of the netting. Gently gather the netting by pulling the thread until it fits across the front of hat. Sew the netting under the hat band.

Brim

Roll up the sides of the brim up and pull the front and the back of the brim down for a more stylish appearance. With **A**, tack brim in place if desired.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; tr = triple or treble crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
