### What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each 09935 Waterscape A, 00003 Orange B, and 00001 White C

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle; two 12mm buttons for eyes; one 2 cm [¾"] wooden button

TENSION/GAUGE: 12 sts = 8 cm [3½"]; 11 rows = 9 cm [3½"] in pattern stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

## Woodland Owl Cup Cosy

*Here's a neat gift idea for anyone who enjoys a good warm cup of coffee or tea. This friendly owl can be crocheted quickly and is a good companion any time of day, but especially great for night owls!*

Cosy Measures 3¾" (9.5 cm) tall

### NOTE

Wrap size can be easily changed to fit any mug: to fit a taller or shorter mug, add or subtract an even number of chains at beginning; to fit a wider or narrower mug, add or subtract an even number of rows.

### COSY

With A ch 16.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** Dc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 15 dc.

**Row 2 (Right Side):** Ch 3, skip first st, tr in next st and each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, slip st in first tr, \* tr in next tr, slip st in next tr; repeat from \* across, working last slip st in top of beginning ch 3; turn.

**Rows 4-29:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3.

**Row 30:** Ch 3, skip first st, tr in next st and each st across, ch 10, slip st in last tr for button loop. Fasten off.

### BEAK

With B ch 6; tr in 3rd ch from hook, htr in next ch, dc in next ch, slip st in last ch. Fasten off.

### EYE (Make 2)

With C, ch 4; 11 tr in 3rd ch from hook; join with a slip st to top of beginning ch 3. Fasten off. Sew button to center of eye.

### FINISHING

Sew Beak and Eyes in place. Sew button to beginning edge to correspond to button loop. Sew first 3 sts of Row 24 to corresponding 3 sts of beginning ch. Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; htr = half treble crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = triple or treble crochet; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
