What you will need:
RED HEART® Softe: 6 balls 00001 White A, 8 balls 000012 Grey B

Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10.5]
Yarn needle
TENSION/GAUGE: 10 sts = 7.5 cm [3"]; 8 rows $=7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ [3"] in pattern stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

## Zigzag Post Stitch Throw

> Choose any two colours that please you to crochet this stunning throw! The interesting zigzag pattern is created by working the clusters into the rows below. Colour not being used is dropped to wrong side until needed again.

Afghan measures $112 \mathrm{~cm} \times 147 \mathrm{~cm}$ [44" x 58"].

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Dtrcl (double treble cluster) = [yo] twice, working all on right side of fabric insert hook into same st 3 rows below as last dtr and draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, skip next 3 sts 3 rows below, [yo] twice and draw up a loop in next ch-1 space, [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops.

## NOTES

To Change Color in Tr: Work last tr before color change until 2 loops remain on hook, drop color in use, with next color to be used yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; continue with new color.

Do not cut colors but drop to wrong side when not in use and pick up again as needed

## AFGHAN

With A, ch 144
Row 1 (Wrong Side): Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 143 dc .
Row 2 (Right Side): Ch 1, dc in first 3 dc, * ch 1 , skip next dc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * across; turn.
Row 3: Ch 3, skip first dc, tr in each dc and ch (work into the ch, not the space) across, changing to $\mathbf{B}$ in last tr; turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, dc in first tr, working all on right side of fabric, dtr in first skipped st 3 rows below, skip next tr, dc in next tr, ch 1, skip next tr, dc in next tr, * dtrcl in last and next skipped sts 3 rows below, skip next tr, dc in next tr, ch 1, skip next tr, dc in next tr; repeat from * to last 2 tr ; dtr in same st as 2nd leg of last dtrcl, skip next tr, dc in top of ch-3; turn.
Row 5: Ch 3, skip first dc, tr in each dc and ch across, changing to $\mathbf{A}$ in last dc; turn.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 for pattern, working 2 rows of each color, until piece measures 142 cm [56"] from beginning, end by working Row 4 with $A$.

Next Row: Ch 1, dc in each st across; turn to work edging.

## Edging

With right side facing, ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ in first st, * ch 2, skip 1 st, dc in next st; repeat from * to next corner; ch 2, dc in next dc row end down side, ** ch 2, dc in next dc row end; repeat from ** to corner; ch 2 ***, dc in first st on lower edge; repeat from * around, end at ${ }^{* * *}$; join with a slip st in first dc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; $\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{c m}=$ centimeters; $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet; $\mathrm{dtr}=$ double treble crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; st(s) $=$ stitch(es); tr = triple or treble crochet; $\mathbf{y o}=$ yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
