

## Cable Knit Throw

This is a knit throw that has it all-a graceful cable and lace design along with timeless textural qualities. The easy-care yarn ensures that you can use it often, wash it as often and it will keep its wonderfully good looks.

Throw measures 43" x 58".
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 4 skeins 661 Frosty Green.
Circular Knitting Needle: 6mm [US 10] - 36".
Cable needle, 2 stitch markers, yarn needle.

## Special Abbreviation

ssk (slip, slip, knit) = Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time, to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position.

## THROW

Cast on 155 sts. Do not join but work back and forth in rows.
Bottom Border-Row 1 (Right Side): K1, * P1, K1; repeat from * across.
Rows 2-5: Repeat Row 1.
Row 6: K1, [P1, K1] twice, place marker on needle, work to last 5 sts; place marker on needle, K1, $[P 1, \mathrm{~K} 1]$ twice. Continue to work first and last 5 sts of every row in Border pattern and begin working Cable pattern on sts between markers as follows:

Row 1: * K4, yo, ssk, P7, K2tog, yo, K3; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 2: * P6, K7, P5; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 3: * K3, [yo, ssk] twice, P5, [K2tog, yo] twice, K2; repeat from * to last st, K1.
Row 4: *P7, K5, P6; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 5: * K2, [yo, ssk] 3 times, P3, [K2tog, yo] 3 times, K1; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 6: * P8, K3, P7; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 7: K1, * [yo, ssk] 4 times, K1, [K2tog, yo] 4 times, K1; repeat from * across.
Row 8: * K2, P15, K1; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 9: * P2, [yo, ssk] 3 times, K3, [K2tog, yo] 3 times, P1; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 10: * K3, P13, K2; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 11: * P3, [yo, ssk] twice, K5, [K2tog, yo] twice, P2; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 12: *K4, P11, K3; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 13: * P4, yo ssk, K7, K2tog, yo, P3; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 14: * K5, P9, K4; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 15: * P5, K9, P4; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Rows 16 and 18: Repeat Row 14.
Row 17: Repeat Row 15.
Row 19: * P5; slip next 5 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K4, then K5 from cable needle - cable made; P4; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Rows 20, 22, and 24: Repeat Row 14.
Rows 21 and 23: Repeat Row 15.
Row 25: * P4, K2tog, yo, K7, yo, ssk, P3; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 26: * K4, P11, K3; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 27: * P3, [K2tog, yo] twice, K5, [yo, ssk] twice, P2; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 28: *K3, P13, K2; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 29: * P2, [K2tog, yo] 3 times, K3, [yo, ssk] 3 times,

P 1 ; repeat from * to last st; P 1 .
Row 30: * K2, P15, K1; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 31: K1, * [K2tog, yo] 4 times, K1, [yo, ssk] 4 times, K1; repeat from * across.
Row 32: * P8, K3, P7; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 33: * K2, [K2tog, yo] 3 times, P3, [yo, ssk] 3 times, K1; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 34: * P7, K5, P6; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 35: * K3, [K2tog, yo] twice, P5, [yo, ssk] twice, K2; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 36: * P6, K7, P5; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 37: * K4, K2tog, yo, P7, yo, ssk, K3; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Row 38: * P5, K9, P4; repeat from * to last st; P1.
Row 39: * K5, P9, K4; repeat from * to last st; K1.
Rows 40 and 42: Repeat Row 38.
Row 41: Repeat Row 39.
Row 43: K5, P9, * cable, P9; repeat to last 5 sts; K5.
Rows 44, 46, and 48: Repeat Row 38.
Rows 45 and 47: Repeat Row 39.

Repeat Rows 1-48 four more times, then repeat Rows 1-38 once more. Remove stitch markers on last row.

Top Border: Work 6 rows same as for Bottom Border. Bind off loosely in pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{K}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{P}=$ purl; rep = repeat; $\mathbf{s} \mathbf{I}=$ slip; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); $\boldsymbol{t o g}=$ together; yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.


[^0]:    GAUGE: 18 sts = $5^{\prime \prime}$; 25 rows $=5$ " in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.
