Recommendet Yarn

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Christmas Stocking

V.1

Craft 

Skill Level 



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Materials:

Schachenmayr Regia 4-ply

(75% new wool, 25% polyamide, 230yds / 1³/₄oz [about 210m / 50g]), 100g #01992 ecru,
Five US 6-8 [4-5mm] dpn and one US G/6-7 [4-4.5mm] crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge, plus one Cable Needle.

Work with the double yarn!

Stockinette stitch:

K RS rows, P WS rows; in rnds K all sts.

Cable pattern:

work all rnds foll chart, rep 6-st rep throughout.

Note! In 12th patt rnd K2tog at beg of rnd, and at end of rnd cross the last two sts with the first two sts of foll rnd!

Work rnd 1 to 16 once, then rep rnds 17 to 21 throughout.

Gauge:

with the double yarn and St st 20 sts and 28 rows/ rnds; with cable patt 24 sts and 30 rnds, each to 4" [10cm].

METHOD

With the double yarn cast on 12 sts across each Needles 1 and 3, and 13 sts across each Needles 2 and 4 = 50 sts and K 3 rnds for roll edge. Cont with cable patt = 15 sts on each needle and 60 sts after 1st rnd.

When cable patt measures 6¹/₄" [16cm], slip last 2 sts on Needle 1 onto Needle 2, and the first 2 sts on Needle 4 onto Needle 3 = 13 sts each on Needles 1 and 4, and 17 sts each on Needles 2 and 3.

Now work foot.

Across the 26 sts on Needles 1 and 4 work heel with heel flap with St st. Work 20 rows even for heel turn.

Then arrange sts in 3 sections for gusset, with 8 sts across each outer edge, and 10 sts at center. Cont across the 10 sts of center panel as foll:

In foll RS row K to 1 from end of center panel. ★Work skp across last st of center panel tog with foll st of outer panel as foll: slip last st of center panel kwise, K next st of outer panel, pssso, turn. Slip 1st st of center panel pwise wyif, and P to last st of center panel. P the last stitch together with the foll st of the outer panel and turn. Slip 1st st of center panel pwise wyib, and K to last st of center panel. Rep these dec from ★ until all sts of outer panels have been used up and just 10 sts rem at center.

With rnds cont across all sts; work with St st across Needles 1 and 4, and with cable patt across Needles 2 and 3.

In 1st rnd arrange sts evenly across 2 needles (= 5 sts each across Needles 4 and 1), then with 1st needle pick up 13 sts across edge of heel flap and M1k between Needles 1 and 2, work in patt across Needles 2 and 3 (= upper foot), then with the free needle M1k between Needles 3 and 4, and pick up 13 sts across edge of heel flap, then work rem 5 sts in patt = 19 sts each on Needles 1 and 4 and 17 sts each on Needles 2 and 3.

With St st work across Needles 1 and 4, and with cable patt across Needles 2 and 3. For gusset on either side, in 2nd rnd and in every rnd 4 times work to 2 from end of Needle 1, then K2tog; at beg of Needle 4 work skp, work rem sts in patt = 14 sts each on Needles 1 and 4.


When foot measures 7¹/₂" [19cm] cont with St st across all sts; in 1st rnd K2tog across Cables on Needles 2 and 3 = 6 sts dec and 14 sts on each needle.

For paired decs work in foll rnd as foll: work to 3 from end of Needles 1 and 3, then K2tog, K1; across Needles 2 and 4 work K1, then skp. Rep these decs in 4th rnd once, in 3rd rnd once, in every 2nd rnd 2 times and in every rnd 7 times = 8 sts. With the double yarn

pull these stitches up firmly together, or graft the stitches of the decreases together using Kitchener Stitch.

With the double yarn crochet a hanger to cast-on edge of center back as foll: attach yarn and crochet 15 ch, and 1 sl-st back into edge, 1 turning ch, then crochet sc across the ch, end with 1 sl-st into edge.

Legend

- = K1
- ◻ = P1
- ◻ = M1k tbl
- ◻● = 1 crochet bobble (= insert crochet hook through the two P sts, fetch the loop through and pull up about ¾" [1.5cm], let both sts slide from the hook, then ◻yo, fetch thread through the two P sts and pull about ¾" [1.5cm] up, rep 3 times from ◻. Now pull thread through the 9 loops on the hook and slip this st onto left needle, then work alt K1, P1 into this st)
- ◻◻◻ = slip 2 onto a cn and leave at front of work, K2, then K2 from cn
- ◻◻◻ = slip 2 onto a cn and leave at front of work, P1, then K2 from cn
- ◻◻◻ = slip 1 onto a cn and leave at back of work, K2, then P1 from cn
