## Design $5940 \cdot$ Sneaker Socks size 28/29 and 38/39

Directions for the smaller size are before the stroke, with larger sizes behind. If there is only one figure, it applies to all sizes.
All measurements are in centimeters (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54 ).

Materials: yarn Regia Cotton, 50 g each \#01 white and \#91 mottled pale gray; an oddment or $50 \mathrm{~g} \# 126$ mottled papaya.

## 2-3 mm [size 1-3] double-pointed needles, or size to obtain gauge.

Bi-colored half fisherman's rib: even no. of stitches.
Round 1, white: K all sts.
Round 2, mottled pale gray: $P$ all sts.

Round 3, white: |  |
| :--- |
| P1, then K1 inserting | needle into next st. 1 round below, rep from $\leqslant$. Work round 1 once, then rep rounds 2-3 throughout for patt.

Stockinet stitch (st-st): K RS rows; P WS rows; in rounds K all sts.

Gauge: 30 sts. and 42 rows/rounds st-st, each to 10 cm [4"].

## METHOD (make 2 alike)

Cast on 52(60) sts. mottled papaya and for mini roll edge work 3 rounds st-st, then 21 rounds white and mottled pale gray $=$ about 3.5 cm in bi-col half fisherman's rib.

Cont in st-st 1 round white, 2 rounds mottled papaya and 1 round mottled pale gray.

Then work the foot in st-st. Work round heel over sts. on needles 1 and 4 in mottled pale gray. Then work 1 round mottled pale gray, 2 rounds papaya, then alt 6 rounds white and 2 rounds mottled pale gray. When foot measures about $13.5(19.5) \mathrm{cm}$, after 6 rows white, work another 2 rounds papaya, then cont in mottled pale gray. When foot measures $14(20) \mathrm{cm}$ work toes in mottled pale gray.

Total length of foot $=18(25) \mathrm{cm}$.
