## Socks with Honeycomb Pattern -



Sizes: 26/27 (38/39, 46/47).
Directions for sizes are given in ascending order, separated by commas. Only one figure applies to all sizes.

## Materials: Schachenmayr Regia 4-ply Countrylife Color, 100g \#04767 sage. <br> Five US 1-3 [2-3mm] dpn, and one cable needle.

If both socks are to look the same, please always start with the same col rep and take yarn either from the outside or the inside of the ball, since these can be wrapped differently during production.

Rib pattern: $\star \mathrm{Kl}, \mathrm{Pl}, \mathrm{Kl}$, rep from $\star$, see also chart below the broken line.

Honeycomb pattern: work all rows foll chart above the broken line. Rep rnds 1 to 12 .

Stockinette stitch: in rnds K all sts; in rows K RS rows; P WS rows.

Gauge: in honeycomb patt (stretched lightly) and St st 30 sts and 42 rows $/ \mathrm{rnds}=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

INSTRUCTIONS: With four dpn cast on 48 $(60,72)$ sts evenly across $(=12(15,18)$ sts on each needle) and for the cuff work $11 / 8$ " [3cm] rib patt. Cont in honeycomb patt. Work 6 -st rep 8 $(10,12)$ times even until leg measures about $31 / 2$ [ $51 / 2,71 / 2$ )" $[9(14,19) \mathrm{cm}]$. Work 4 more rnds St st across Needles 1 and 4, and honeycomb patt across Needles 2 and 3 until leg measures about $4(6,73 / 4)$ " $[10(15,20) \mathrm{cm}]$.
Now work foot with boomerang heel as given in the Sock Guide.
Work the boomerang heel in rows in St st across the $24(30,36)$ sts on Needles 1 and 4, leave sts on Needles 2 and 3 on a holder. After the first half of heel work 2 rnds St st across needles 1 and 4, and honeycomb patt across Needles 2 and 3.
At the end of the heel cont again in rnds, in St st across Needles 1 and 4, and in honeycomb patt across Needles 2 and 3 until foot measures $51 / 2$ $\left(73 / 4,9^{1 / 2}\right)$ )" $[14(20,24) \mathrm{cm}]$.

## Work toes in St st.

Total length of foot about $63 / 4(97 / 8,113 / 4)$ " $[17(25$, $30) \mathrm{cm}]$. Work both socks in the same manner.

Note: The socks can also be made up in sizes $24 / 25$ and $36 / 37$ following the above instructions, our Sock guide and the table.
Where the number of sts cast on is not a multiple of 6 , increase the required number of sts after the cuff evenly across until you have the number of sts necessary. These extra sts are decreased again before working the heel and/or before the toe shaping.
