

## Design R0264 Socks with Textured Pattern



Size: 38-39

## Materials: Regia 6-ply Digital Color,

150 g in Bit color #06966. 1 set (5) dpn (double-pointed needles) size US 4 (3.5 mm).

To have a matching pair of socks, begin each sock at the same color section of the yarn.

St st (Stockinette Stitch): in rounds, knit all sts.

**Border pattern:** in rounds: \*knit 2, purl 2; repeat from \* around.

## Textured pattern (for a cast on of 48 sts):

**Rnds 1-3:** \*Knit 6, purl 12, knit 6; repeat from \* once more.

Rnds 4-6: Knit all sts. Rnds 7-9: \*Knit 6, purl 12, knit 6; repeat from \* once more

**Rnds 10-12:** Purl all sts. Repeat rnds 1-12 for textured pat. **Note:** For the other sizes, refer to the stitch numbers and length on the size chart, changing the textured pattern as follows:

Cast on 32 sts: \*Knit 4, purl 8, knit 4; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 36 sts: \* knit 5, purl 9, knit 4; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 40 sts: \* knit 5, purl 10, knit 5; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 44 sts: \* knit 6, purl 11, knit 5; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 48 sts: \* knit 6, purl 12, knit 6; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 52 sts: \* knit 7, purl 13, knit 6; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 56 sts: \* knit 7, purl 14, knit 7; repeat from \* once more.

Cast on 60 sts: \* knit 8, purl 15, knit 7; repeat from \* once more.

**Gauge:** in St st: 22 sts and 30 rnds = 4 x 4 in/10 x 10 cm.

**Instructions: Cast on** 48 sts and divide sts evenly over 4 needles (12 sts per needle) and join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Work 3 rnds in St st, 7 rnds in border pat. For the leg, work 50 rnds in textured pat =  $5\frac{1}{2}$  in/ 14 cm above border.

<u>Note:</u> The leg length can be changed as desired, but the heel should begin after a rnd 2 of the textured pattern has been worked.

For the heel, work 4 rnds in St st over the 24 sts on needles 1 and 4, and continue textured pat over the 24 sts on needles 2 and 3.

After leg measures 7 in/18 cm from cast-on, work the **Boomerang heel** following the <u>"Sock Techniques"</u>.

Here, after the first half of heel, work 2 rnds over all sts of all needles, working sts on needles 1 and 4 in St st, on needles 2 and 3 (top of foot) in textured pat. Continue to work the foot in this way after the end of the heel.



When the foot length measures 8 in/20 cm, follow the <u>"Sock Techniques"</u> for the toe decreases, working the sts in St st. The total foot length measures 10 in/25 cm. Work both socks in the same way.

## Size Table for socks made with Regia 6-ply Digital Touch. Gauge with US sizes 3-6 (3-4 mm) needles in St st: 22 sts and 30 rows/rounds = $4 \times 4 \ln/10 \times 10$ cm.
