# Jaine Ponshawl Creative Melange DK

## Size

Ponshawl: length 156cm (61 ½ in) by 39 cm, 15 ¼ in. Button position to fit: S-M/L-XL/XXL

## Materials

Rico Design Creative Melange DK:
5 x 50g balls in shade 02
1 pair 4mm (UK8/US6) single pointed knitting needles
Cable needle
3.25mm crochet hook and three 1cm (1/2 in) buttons

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## **Gauge or Tension**

24 sts and 30 rows to a 10cm (4in) square in Cable Pattern with 4mm needles.

## Abbreviations

St/sts - stitch/stitches
K/p - knit/purl
Rep(s)/patt(s) - repeat(s)/pattern(s)
Cont - continue
RS/WS - right side/wrong side
K2tog - knit 2 sts together
Yfwd - yarn forward
SI 1 - slip 1 st purlwise
Psso - pass slipped stitch over
Ssk -slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time to the right needle.
Insert the left needle tip through these two slipped stitches
and knit together
C6B - slip the first 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold at the
back k3, then k3 from the cable needle

**C6F**– slip the first 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold at the front k3, then k3 from the cable needle

## **Pattern Stitches**

**Fountain Lace** 

## Panel of 17 sts and 8 rows.

Row 1 (RS): Ssk, yfwd, k2, k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yfwd, k1, yfwd, ssk, k2, yfwd, k2tog.
Row 2 and all even rows: Purl.
Row 3: Ssk, k3, yfwd, k2tog, yfwd, k3, yfwd, ssk, yfwd, k3, k2tog.
Row 5: Ssk, (k2, yfwd) twice, k2tog, k1, ssk, (yfwd, k2)

twice, k2tog.

**Row 7**: Ssk, k1, yfwd, k3, yfwd, k2tog, k1, ssk, yfwd, k3, yfwd, k1, k2tog. **Row 8**: Purl.

## **Little Blocks Pattern**

Over multiples of 4 sts plus 2 sts and 24 rows. Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2-6: Knit. Row 7: (K2, p2) to last 2 sts, k2. Row 8: (P2, k2) to last 2 sts, p2. Row 9: (P2, k2) to last 2 sts, p2. Row 10: (K2, p2) to last 2 sts, k2. Row 11 to 18: Rep rows 7 to 10 twice.

## **Cable Pattern**

Row 19 to 24: Knit.

Over 12 sts plus 10 sts and 12 rows. Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 and all even rows: Purl. Row 3: K2, \*C6F, k6: rep from \* to last 8 sts, C6F, k2. Row 5, 7 and 11: Knit. Row 9: K2, \*k6, C6B: rep from \* to last 8 sts, k8. Row 12: Purl.

## Instructions

Using 4mm knitting needles, cast on 86 sts. Knit 4 rows. **Set Up row**: K3, p17, k46, p17, k3.

#### Work the following pattern. \*\*

Work Fountain Lace and Little Blocks Pattern as follows: **Row 1 (RS)**: K3, Fountain Lace row 1, Little Blocks Pattern row 1 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 1, k3. **Row 2**: K3, Fountain Lace row 2, Little Blocks Pattern row 2 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 2, k3. These 2 rows set the position of the patts. Cont in Fountain Lace as set for 3 full patt reps and complete the Little Blocks 24 row patt. Total of 24 rows.

Work Fountain Lace and Cable Pattern as follows: **Row 25 (RS)**: K3, Fountain Lace row 1, Cable Pattern row 1 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 1, k3. **Row 26**: K3, Fountain Lace row 2, , Cable Pattern row 2 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 2, k3. These 2 rows set the position of the patt. Cont in Fountain lace as set for 6 full patt reps and Cable Pattern for 4 full patt reps. Total of 48 rows. \*\*

Work \*\* to \*\* a further 5 times.

Work Fountain Lace and Little Blocks Pattern as follows:
Row 1 (RS): K3, Fountain Lace row 1, Little Blocks Pattern row 1 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 1, k3.
Row 2: K3, Fountain Lace row 2, Little Blocks Pattern row 2 over 46 sts, Fountain Lace row 2, k3.
These 2 rows set the position of the patts. Cont in Fountain Lace as set for 3 full patt reps and complete the Little Blocks 24 row patt. Total of 24 rows.

Knit 4 rows, ending with a WS row. Cast off all sts.

**Making Up**. Block the Ponshawl. Using the 3.25mm crochet hook, crochet three 3 cm (1  $\frac{1}{4}$  in) chains . Fold Ponshawl in half lengthways so that the cast on and cast off edges meet. Measure 50[52:54] cm (19  $\frac{3}{20}$  (20  $\frac{1}{221}$   $\frac{1}{4}$ ] in) along one edge from the fold. This is the position of the first button and button loop. Sew one of the crochet chains to the far edge of the Ponshawl, and the button to the nearer edge. The next button and button loop are positioned 2 cm ( $\frac{3}{4}$  in) from the first button/button loop, closer to the cast on/cast off edge. Sew in place. The final button and button loop, closer to the cast on/cast off edge. Sew in place. Weave in ends.
