## NEEDLES

$33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (no 9) (US 5) circular needle at least
120 cm long
4 mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least
120 cm long

## TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patterned st st using 4 mm (US 6) needles.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed picnic blanket is 106 cm ( $41 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \mathrm{in}$ ) by 114 cm ( 45 in ).

## SMALL THROW

Using 4mm (US 6) circular needle, cast on as folls: ${ }^{\star} 20$ sts using yarn $\mathrm{E}, 20$ sts using yarn $\mathrm{D}, 20$ sts using yarn $\mathrm{C}, 20$ sts using yarn B , 20 sts using yarn A, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ once more. 200 sts.
Using the intarsia technique as described on the information page, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:
Row 1 (RS): (Work all 100 sts of row 1 of chart) twice.
Row 2: (Work all 100 sts of row 2 of chart) twice.
These 2 rows set the sts.
Cont as now set until all 189 rows of chart have been completed, ending with WS facing for next row.
Now rep chart rows 1 to 81 again, noting that, for this rep of chart, odd numbered rows are WS rows and even numbered rows are RS rows.
Once chart row 81 has been worked for the second time, ending with RS facing for next row, cast off all sts.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

## Border

With RS facing, using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 5) circular needle and yarn A, beg and ending at centre of cast-on edge, pick up and knit 100 sts evenly along cast-on edge to corner, and 1 st from corner, mark this st with a coloured thread, pick up and knit
192 sts evenly up first row-end edge to next corner, and 1 st from corner, mark this st with a coloured thread, pick up and knit 200 sts evenly along cast-off edge to next corner, and 1 st from corner, mark this st with a coloured thread, pick up and knit 192 sts evenly down other row-end edge to next corner, and 1 st from corner, mark this st with a coloured thread, then pick up and knit 100 sts evenly along rem section of cast-on edge. 788 sts.
Round 1 (RS): ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{K}$ to marked st, M1, K marked st, M1, rep from $\star 3$ times more, K to end.
Rep last round 5 times more. 836 sts.
Round 7: Knit.
Round 8: Purl (to form fold line).
Round 9: Knit.
Round 10: ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{K}$ to within 1 st of marked st, sl 1, K2tog (marked st is first of these 2 sts), psso and reposition marker on this st, rep from * 3 times more. K to end.

Rep last round 5 times more. 788 sts.
Cast off.
Fold border in half to inside along fold line round and neatly sew in place.
