#### NEEDLES

1 pair 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles 1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles

#### TENSION

17 sts and 26 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 6mm (US 10) needles and 2 strands of yarn held together.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

ytb = take yarn to back (WS) of work; ytf = bring yarn to front (RS) of work.

#### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Rows 1 to 6: Using yarns A and B. Rows 7 to 16: Using yarns A and C. Rows 17 to 20: Using yarns A and D. Rows 21 to 26: Using yarns A and E. Rows 27 to 30: Using yarns A and F.

Rows 31 to 34: Using yarns A and D. Rows 35 to 40: Using yarns A and C. These 40 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated. BACK Using 5mm (US 8) needles and yarn A DOUBLE cast on 79 [87: 95: 105: 113] sts. **Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** P1, **\***K1, P1, rep from **\*** to end. These 2 rows form rib. Cont in rib until back meas 8 [9: 10: 10: 10] cm, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 6mm (US 10) needles. Break off one strand of yarn A and join in one strand of yarn B. Using one strand each of yarns A and B held together, now work in patt as folls: **Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*ytf, sl 1, ytb, K1, rep from \* to end. Row 2: Purl. Row 3: K2, \*ytf, sl 1, ytb, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1. Row 4: Purl. These 4 rows form patt, and rows 1 to 4 of stripe sequence. Beg with stripe sequence row 5 (see above), cont in patt in stripe sequence throughout as folls: Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at each end of 15th and foll 20th row. 75 [83: 91: 101: 109] sts. Cont straight until back meas 32 [32.5: 33: 33.5: 34] cm, ending with RS facing for next row. Shape armholes Keeping patt and stripes correct, cast off 2 [3: 3: 4: 4] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 71 [77: 85: 93: 101] sts. Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3: 5: 5: 7] rows, then on foll 2 [3: 3: 4:3] alt rows. 61 [65:69:75:81] sts. Cont straight until armhole meas 18 [19.5: 21: 22.5: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row. Shape shoulders Keeping patt and stripes correct, cast off 2 [2: 3: 3: 3] sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 2 [3: 3: 3: 4] sts at beg of foll 2 rows. 53 [55: 57: 63: 67] sts. Shape back neck **Next row (RS):** Cast off 2 [3: 3: 3: 4] sts, patt until there are 13 [13: 13: 16: 16] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately. Keeping patt and stripes correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows and at same time cast off 3 [3: 3: 4: 4] sts at beg of 2nd and foll alt row.



#### Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 [3: 3: 4: 4] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 23 [23: 25: 25: 27] sts onto a holder, rejoin appropriate yarns and patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

#### FRONT

Work as given for back until 10 [10: 12: 12: 14] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Patt 25 [27: 29: 32: 35] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt and stripes correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 1 [1: 2: 2: 3] alt rows. 18 [20: 21: 24: 26] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape shoulder

Keeping patt and stripes correct, cast off 2 [2: 3: 3: 3] sts at beg of next and foll 2 [0: 4: 2: 0] alt rows, then 3 [3: -: 4: 4] sts at beg of foll 2 [4: -: 2: 4] alt rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at neck edge of next and foll alt row, then on foll 4th row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 [3: 3: 4: 4] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 11 sts onto a holder, rejoin appropriate yarns and patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

#### SLEEVES

Using 5mm (US 8) needles and yarn A DOUBLE cast on 45 [47: 49: 49: 51] sts.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for back for 3 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Beg with stripe sequence row 33 [33: 29: 31: 31] and patt row 1, cont in patt and stripe sequence as given for back as folls:

Inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and foll 2 [4: 2: 6: 6] alt rows, then on 3 [2: 4: 2: 2] foll 4th rows, taking inc sts into patt. 57 [61: 63: 67: 69] sts. Cont straight until sleeve meas approx 14 [14: 15: 15: 15] cm, ending after same stripe sequence row as on back to beg of armhole shaping and with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 [3: 3: 4: 4] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 53 [55: 57: 59: 61] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on every foll alt row until 27 sts rem, then on foll 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off rem 13 sts.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.


#### Neckband


With RS facing, using 5mm (US 8) needles and yarn A DOUBLE, pick up and knit 16 [16: 18: 18: 20] sts down left side of front neck, K across 11 sts on front holder, pick up and knit 16 [16: 18: 18: 20] sts up right side of front neck, and 5 sts down right side of back neck, K across 23 [23: 25: 25: 27] sts on back holder dec 1 st at centre, then pick up and knit 5 sts up left side of back neck. 75 [75: 81: 87] sts.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.
