Charlotte Gloves & Headband

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YARN

Cocoon

Gloves 1 x 100gm

Headband 1 x 100gm

(gloves photographed in Saturn 837, headband in Quarry Tile 818)

NEEDLES

Gloves: Set of 4 double-pointed 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles

Headband: 1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles

TENSION

17 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 6mm (US 10) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed gloves are 22 cm (8½ in) long and measure 18 cm (7 in) around hand.

Completed headband is 8 cm (3 in) wide and measures 50 cm (19½ in) all round.

Gloves

RIGHT GLOVE

Using set of 4 double-pointed 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 34 sts.

Distribute sts evenly over 3 of the 4 needles and, using 4th needle, work in rounds as follows:

Round 1 (RS): Knit.

Place marker on needle at end of last round to denote beg and end of rounds.

Round 2: Purl.

Rep last 2 rounds once more.**

Now work in patt as folls:

Round 5 (RS): K2, P2, yon, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K4, P2, K18.

Round 6 and every foll alt round: K2, P2, K10, P2, K18.

Round 7: K2, P2, K1, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K3, P2, K18.

Round 9: K2, P2, K2, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K2, P2, K18.

Round 11: K2, P2, K3, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P2, K18.

Round 13: K2, P2, K4, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, P2, K18.

Round 14: As round 6.

Rounds 5 to 14 form patt.

Cont in patt for a further 12 rounds, ending after a rep of round 6.

Shape thumb gusset

Round 27: Patt 18 sts, place marker on needle, M1, K2, M1, place another marker on needle, patt rem 14 sts. 36 sts.

***Sts between these 2 new markers form thumb gusset. Work these thumb gusset sts in st st (K every round) and all other sts in patt as set.

Work 1 round.

Round 29: Patt to first thumb gusset marker, slip marker onto right needle, M1, K to next thumb gusset marker, M1, slip marker onto right needle, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rounds twice more. 42 sts, and 10 sts between thumb gusset markers.

Work 3 rounds.

Round 37: Patt to first thumb gusset marker, remove marker, cast off next 10 sts (these are the thumb gusset sts), remove second thumb gusset marker, patt to end. 32 sts.

Cont in patt for a further 7 rounds, thereby repeating all 10 patt rounds 4 times.

Now rep rounds 1 to 3 once more.

Cast off **purlwise** (on **RS**).

LEFT GLOVE

Work as given for right glove to **.

Now work in patt as folls:

Round 5 (RS): K18, P2, K4, K2tog, K4, yfrn, P2, K2.

Round 6 and every foll alt round: K18, P2, K10, P2, K2.

Round 7: K18, P2, K3, K2tog, K4, yfwd, K1, P2, K2.

Round 9: K18, P2, K2, K2tog, K4, yfwd, K2, P2, K2.

Round 11: K18, P2, K1, K2tog, K4, yfwd, K3, P2, K2.

Round 13: K18, P2, K2tog, K4, yfwd, K4, P2, K2.

Round 14: As round 6.

Rounds 5 to 14 form patt.

Cont in patt for a further 12 rounds, ending after a rep of round 6.

Shape thumb gusset

Round 27: Patt 14 sts, place marker on needle, M1, K2, M1, place another marker on needle, patt rem 18 sts. 36 sts.

Complete as given for right glove from ***.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page in FAQ area.

Headband

HEADBAND

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 18 sts.

Work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): P4, yon, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K4, P4.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: P18.

Row 3: P4, K1, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K3, P4.

Row 5: P4, K2, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K2, P4.

Row 7: P4, K3, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P4.

Row 9: P4, K4, yfwd, K4, sl 1, K1, psso, P4.

Row 10: As row 2.

These 10 rows form patt.

Cont in patt for a further 90 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page in FAQ area.

Join cast-on and cast-off edges to form a loop.
