NEEDLES

1 pair 23/mm (no 12) (US 2) needles

1 pair 31/4mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

25 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3¼mm (US 3) needles. 32 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm measured over sleeve patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

BACK

Using 2¾mm (US 2) needles cast on 107 [113: 116: 125: 134: 140: 146: 155: 158: 167] sts **loosely**.

Row 1 (RS): P2, *K1, P2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2, *P1, K2, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, - [-: inc: -: dec: dec: inc: -: inc: -] 1 st at end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 107 [113: 117: 125: 133: 139: 147: 155: 159: 167] sts.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Beg with a K row, now cont in st st throughout as folls:

Cont straight until back meas 5 [5:5:6:6:8:8:10:8:10] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.

Working all side seam decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each end of 8th and foll 8th row, then on 3 foll 6th rows.

95 [101: 105: 113: 121: 127: 135: 143: 147: 155] sts.

Work 15 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K2, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

Working all side seam increases as set by last row, inc 1 st at each end of 10th and 3 foll 10th rows.

105 [111: 115: 123: 131: 137: 145: 153: 157: 165] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 36 [36: 35: 38: 37: 39: 38: 40: 39: 41] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8: 9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

97 [101: 105: 111: 119: 123: 131: 137: 141: 147] sts.

Next row (RS): K2, K2tog, K to last 4 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K2.

Next row: P2, P2tog tbl, P to last 4 sts, P2tog, P2.

Working all armhole decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [1: 3: 3: 5: 5: 7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 4 [5: 4: 5: 5: 5: 5: 7: 5: 6] alt rows, then on foll 4th row.

81 [83: 85: 89: 93: 97: 101: 103: 107: 111] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [19: 20: 20: 21: 21: 22: 22: 23: 23] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [5: 5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 7: 8] sts, K until there are 19 [19: 20: 22: 22: 24: 25: 26: 27: 28] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Working all neck decreases in same way as armhole decreases, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows **and at same time** cast off 5 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 7: 8] sts at beg of 2nd row and 5 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts at beg of foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 [5: 6: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8: 8] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 35 [35: 35: 37: 37: 37: 37: 39: 39] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back until

18 [18: 18: 22: 22: 24: 24: 24: 24] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K29 [30: 31: 34: 35: 37: 40: 41: 42: 44] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Working all neck decreases in same way as armhole decreases, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 3 [3: 3: 3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 4] alt rows, then on 1 [1: 1: 2: 2: 2: 2: 2: 2: 2] foll 4th rows.

19 [20: 21: 23: 24: 26: 28: 29: 30: 32] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 5: 6: 6: 7: 7: 7: 8] sts at beg of next and foll 0 [2: 2: 0: 2: 1: 2: 2: 1: 2] alt rows, then 5 [-: -: 6: -: 7: -: -: 8: -] sts at beg of foll



2 [-: -: 2: -: 1: -: -: 1: -] alt rows.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 [5: 6: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8: 8] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 23 [23: 23: 21: 23: 23: 21: 21: 23: 23] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 58 [58: 62: 62: 66: 66: 70: 70: 70: 70] sts **loosely**.

Work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Purl.

Row 2: P1, *(K1, P1, K1) all into next st, P3tog, rep from * to last st, P1.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: P1, *P3tog, (K1, P1, K1) all into next st, rep from * to last st, P1.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: next] and every foll 6th row to 86 [94: 88: 96: 88: 96: 92: 100: 106: 112] sts, then on every foll 8th [8th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 9c: 98: 100: 102: 104: 106: 108: 110: –] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [45: 46: 46: 47: 47: 47: 47: 48: 48] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 5 [6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8: 9: 9: 10] sts at beg of

next 2 rows.

84 [84: 86: 86: 88: 88: 90: 90: 92: 92] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 64 sts rem, then on foll 13 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 38 sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 22 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband


With RS facing and using 2¾mm (US 2) needles, pick up and knit 20 [20: 20: 23: 23: 23: 26: 26: 26: 26] sts down left side of front neck, K across 23 [23: 23: 21: 23: 23: 21: 21: 23: 23] sts on front holder, pick up and knit 20 [20: 20: 23: 23: 26: 26: 26: 26: 26] sts up right side of front neck, and 5 sts down right side of back neck, K across 35 [35: 35: 35: 37: 37: 37: 37: 39: 39] sts on back holder dec [dec: dec: inc: -: -: dec: dec: inc: inc] 1 st at centre, then pick up and knit 5 sts up left side of back neck.


107 [107: 107: 113: 116: 116: 119: 119: 125: 125] sts.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off very loosely in rib.
