## Handknit Cotton

(Kit contains yarn for wrap only).

## Wrap Bed Runner

A Helium 011



## NEEDLES

1 pair $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (no 9) (US 5) needles
$333 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (no 9) (US 5) circular needle at least 120 cm long
4 mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least 120 cm long

## TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patterned st st using 4 mm (US 6) needles.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed wrap is 55 cm (21.5 in) wide and 148 cm ( 58 in ) long. Completed bed runner is $64 \mathrm{~cm}(25 \mathrm{in})$ wide and $182 \mathrm{~cm}\left(71 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{in}\right)$ long. WRAP [BEDRUNNER]
Using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 5) circular needle and yarn A cast on 289 [361] sts.
Work in g st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Change to 4 mm (US 6) circular needle.

Beg and ending rows as indicated, using the intarsia technique as described on the information page and repeating the 72 st patt repeat 4 [5] times across each row, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:
Work chart rows 1 to 155 [171] once ending with WS facing for next row.
Change to $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 5) circular needle.
Break off contrasts and cont using yarn A only.
Work in g st for 4 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast off knitwise (on WS).

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

## Side borders (both alike)

With RS facing, using $33 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 5) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 110 [128] sts evenly along row-end edge, between cast-on and cast-off edges.
Work in g st for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off knitwise.


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
