#### TENSION

21 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

# SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**sl 2** = slip 2 sts; **wyab** = with yarn at back (**WS**) of work; **wyaf** = with yarn at front (**WS**) of work.

#### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Rows 1 to 6: Using yarn B. Rows 7 to 16: Using yarn C. Rows 17 to 22: Using yarn A. Rows 23 to 32: Using yarn B. Rows 33 to 38: Using yarn C. Rows 39 to 48: Using yarn A. These 48 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated.

#### BACK

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 98 [106: 110: 118: 122: 130: 134: 142] sts. **Row 1 (RS):** P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end. These 2 rows form rib. Work in rib for a further 18 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 41/2mm (US 7) needles. Beg with stripe sequence row 1 (see above), now work in patt as folls: Row 1 (RS): K2, \*sl 2 wyab, K2, rep from \* to end. Row 2: P2, \*sl 2 wyaf, P2, rep from \* to end. Row 3: Knit. **Row 4**: P2, **\***K2, P2, rep from **\*** to end. **Row 5**: K2, **\***P2, K2, rep from **\*** to end. Row 6: As row 4. Row 7: K1, sl 1 wyab, \*K2, sl 2 wyab, rep from \* to last 4 sts, K2, sl 1 wyab, K1. Row 8: P1, sl 1 wyaf, \*P2, sl 2 wyaf, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P2, sl 1 wyaf, P1. Row 9: Knit. **Row 10**: K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end. **Row 11**: P2, **\***K2, P2, rep from **\*** to end. Rows 12 to 15: As rows 10 and 11, twice. Row 16: As row 10. These 16 rows form patt (and rows 1 to 16 of stripe sequence). Note: Full patt is basically a striped rib patt of 6 rows in one colour and 10 rows in next colour. At beg of each new stripe, the rib is

reversed by working 3 fancy rows (patt rows 1 to 3, and patt rows 7 to 9). On the first 2 of these rows, the st st st so of the previous rib section are slipped with the yarn held at the **WS** of the work and the rev st st sts are worked in st st. The 3rd stripe-change row is a knit row. After these 3 rows have been worked, the patt continues in rib in the reverse position to previous rib section.

Cont in patt and stripe sequence as now set until back meas 38 [40: 41: 43: 41: 41: 40: 42] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape raglan armholes

Keeping patt and stripes correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 92 [100: 104: 112: 116: 124: 128: 136] sts.\*\*

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [1: 1: 3: 1: 1: 1: 5] rows, then on 2 [0: 2: 0: 1: 0: 0: 0] foll 4th rows, then on foll 27 [33: 32: 36: 38: 43: 44: 44] alt rows. 32 [32: 34: 34: 36: 36: 38: 38] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave rem sts on a holder.

# FRONT

Work as given for back to **\*\***.

Remembering to keep patt and stripes correct throughout, cont as folls:

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [1:1:3:1:1:5] rows, then on 1 [0: 2:0:1:0:0:0] foll 4th rows, then on foll 0 [5:4:8:10:15:16:16] alt rows. 88 [88:90:90:92:92:94:94] sts.

Work 3 [1: 1: 1: 1: 1: 1] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Place marker at end of last row (to denote base of left raglan seam opening).

Next row (RS): K2tog tbl, patt to last 2 sts, work 2 tog.

**Next row**: Patt to last st, K1.

Last 2 rows set the sts and raglan armhole decreases – right raglan armhole decreases worked as before but left raglan armhole edge now with edge st worked as a K st on every row.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. 82 [82: 84: 84: 86: 86: 88: 88] sts.

**Next row (RS)**: K2tog tbl, patt 1 st, work 2 tog tbl, yrn (to make a buttonhole), patt to last 2 sts, work 2 tog.

Making a further 3 buttonholes as set by previous row on every foll 12th row and noting that no further reference will be made to buttonholes, cont as folls:

Working all raglan armhole decreases as now set, dec 1 st at each end of 2nd and foll 17 [17: 17: 16: 16: 15: 15] alt rows.

44 [44: 46: 46: 50: 50: 54: 54] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

# Shape front neck

**Next row (RS):** K2tog tbl, patt 7 [7:7:7:9:9:11:11] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. 8 [8: 8: 8: 10: 10: 12: 12] sts.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows, then on foll 0 [0: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2: 2] alt rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at raglan armhole edge of 2nd and foll 1 [1: 1: 1: 2: 2: 3: 3] alt rows. 2 sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

# Next row (RS): K2tog and fasten off.

With RS facing, slip centre 26 [26: 28: 28: 28: 28: 28: 28] sts onto a holder, rejoin appropriate yarn, patt to last 2 sts, work 2 tog. 8 [8: 8: 8: 10: 10: 12: 12] sts.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

# RIGHT SLEEVE

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 44 [46: 48: 50: 50: 52: 52: 54] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** P1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0], K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last

1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0] st, P1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0].

**Row 2:** K1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0], P2, **\***K2, P2, rep from **\*** to last 1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0] st, K1 [0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 18 [14: 18: 18: 14: 16: 20: 18] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4 1/2mm (US 7) needles.

Beg with stripe sequence row 33 [23: 23: 23: 7: 7: 7: 7] and the 3 fancy rows (to change position of rib), now work in stripe sequence and patt as given for back as folls:

Inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: 3rd: 5th: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd] and 8 [4: 2: 0: 3: 4: 7: 9] foll 4th rows, then on every foll 6th row until there are 80 [82: 86: 88: 92: 96: 98: 102] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until sleeve meas approx 44 [47: 50: 52: 54: 55: 55: 56] cm, ending after same stripe row as on back to beg of raglan armhole shaping and with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape raglan

Keeping patt and stripes correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 74 [76: 80: 82: 86: 90: 92: 96] sts.\*\*

Dec 1 st at each end of next and 2 [3: 4: 4: 5: 6: 6: 6] foll 4th rows, then on every foll alt row until 20 sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape front neck

Keeping patt and stripes correct, cont as folls:

Cast off 5 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. 14 sts.

Work 1 row.

Cast off 4 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. 9 sts.

Work 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Cast off rem 4 sts.

# LEFT SLEEVE

Work as given for right sleeve to \*\*.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and 1 [2: 4: 4: 5: 6: 6: 6] foll 4th rows, then on foll 0 [0: 0: 1: 2: 3: 4: 6] alt rows. 70 sts.

Work 2 [2:0:0:0:0:0:0] rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row. Keeping patt and stripes correct, cont as folls:

**Next row (WS):** Cast on 7 sts (for raglan opening underlay) and work across these sts as folls: K1, P6, place marker on last st (to denote base of raglan opening) then patt to end. 77 sts.

Next row: Work 2 tog, patt to last 9 sts, work 2 tog tbl, K7.

Next row: K1, P6, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows 24 times more. 27 sts.

# Shape front neck

**Next row (RS):** Work 2 tog, patt to last 9 sts, work 2 tog tbl and turn, leaving rem 7 sts on a holder (for collar). 18 sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row. 14 sts.

Dec 1 st at beg of next row, then cast off 4 sts at beg of foll row. 9 sts. Rep last 2 rows once more.

Cast off rem 4 sts.

# MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both back and right front raglan seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

# Collar

With RS facing, using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 5 [5: 5: 5: 7: 7: 9: 9] sts down left side of front neck, K across 26 [26: 28: 28: 28: 28: 28: 28] sts on front holder, pick up and knit 5 [5: 5: 5: 7: 7: 9: 9] sts up right side of front neck, and 14 sts

from top of right sleeve, K across 32 [32: 34: 34: 36: 36: 38: 38] sts on back holder dec [dec: dec: inc: inc: dec: dec] 1 st at centre, pick up and knit 14 sts from top of left sleeve, then K across 7 sts on left sleeve holder. 102 [102: 106: 106: 114: 114: 118: 118] sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, P8, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Row 2**: K3, **\***P2, K2, rep from **\*** to last 7 sts, K7.

These 2 rows set the sts.

Keeping sts correct as now set, cont as folls:

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 4 (RS): K2, K2tog tbl, yfrn (to make a buttonhole), patt to end.

Work 11 rows.


Row 16: As row 4. (All 6 buttonholes have now been worked.)

Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in patt.

Join left front raglan seam below markers, then neatly sew cast-on edge of underlay in place on inside.
