

NEEDLES

1 pair 2³/mm (no 12) (US 2) needles 1 pair 3¹/mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

TENSION

23 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3½mm (US 3) needles.

BACK

Using 24mm (US 2) needles and yarn B, cast on 105 [117: 131: 145: 161] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3½mm (US 3) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 20 rows, dec 1 [1: 1: -: -] st at each end of 15th [17th: 19th: -: -] of these rows and ending with RS facing for next row. 103 [115: 129: 145: 161] sts.

Break off yarn B and join in yarn C.

Dec 1 st at each end of 5th [7th: 9th: next: 3rd] and foll 8th [8th: -: 10th: 10th] row. 99 [111: 127: 141: 157] sts.

Work 3 [1:7:5:3] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn C and join in yarn A.

Dec 1 st at each end of 3rd [5th: next: 3rd: 5th] and 2 [2: 3: 3: 3]

foll 6th rows. 93 [105: 119: 133: 149] sts.**

Work 9 [11: 11: 13: 13] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

***Inc 1 st at each end of next and 4 foll 10th rows.

103 [115: 129: 143: 159] sts.

Work 11 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Back should meas approx 38 [39: 40: 41: 42] cm.)

Shape armholes

Cast off 6 [7: 8: 9: 10] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

91 [101: 113: 125: 139] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [5: 7: 9: 11] rows, then on foll 3 [4: 4: 3: 6] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows.

75 [79: 87: 97: 101] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [21: 22: 23: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

67 [69: 75: 83: 85] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts, K until there are 8 [8: 9: 12: 11] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 4 [4: 5: 8: 7] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 43 [43: 45: 45: 47] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Work 3 [5: 5: 7: 7] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place motif chart

Using the **intarsia** technique as described on the information page, now place motif chart, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:

Next row (RS): Using yarn A K52 [60: 71: 83: 93], work next 32 sts as row 1 of motif chart, using yarn A K9 [13: 16: 18: 24].

Next row: Using yarn A P9 [13: 16: 18: 24], work next 32 sts as row 2 of motif chart, using yarn A P52 [60: 71: 83: 93].

These 2 rows set the sts - 32 sts worked from chart with edge sts in st st using yarn A.

Working rem 74 rows of chart and then completing front in st st using yarn A only, cont as folls:

Work 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Keeping chart correct, now work as given for back from *** until 12 [12: 14: 14: 16] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K23 [25: 29: 34: 36] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row. 19 [21: 25: 30: 32] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 5 rows, then on foll 2 [2: 3: 3: 4] alt rows. 12 [14: 17: 22: 23] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [4: 5: 8: 7] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 29 sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 2½mm (US 2) needles and yarn B, cast on 53 [55: 57: 57: 59] sts.

Work in rib as given for back for 10 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 34mm (US 3) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 11th and foll - [-: 8th: 8th: 6th] row.

55 [57: 61: 61: 63] sts.

Work 9 [9: 1: 1: 3] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break off yarn B and join in yarn C.

Inc 1 st at each end of next [next: 7th: 7th: 3rd] and foll 10th [10th: 8th: 8th: 6th] row. 59 [61: 65: 65: 67] sts.

Work 5 [5: 1: 1: 7] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break off yarn C and join in yarn A.

Inc 1 st at each end of 5th [5th: 9th: 7th: next] and every foll 10th [10th: 10th: 8th: 8th] row to 67 [77: 83: 85: 91] sts, then on every foll 12th [12th: -: 10th: -] row until there are 75 [79: -: 87: -] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [46: 47: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 6 [7: 8: 9: 10] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

63 [65: 67: 69: 71] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on 6 foll 4th rows. 39 [41: 43: 45: 47] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 29 sts, then on foll 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off rem 23 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing, using 2\mm (US 2) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 20 [20: 22: 22: 24] sts down left side of neck, 29 sts from front, 20 [20: 22: 22: 24] sts up right side of neck, then 52 [52: 54: 54: 56] sts from back. 121 [121: 127: 127: 133] sts. Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

See information page for finishing instructions, setting in sleeves using the set-in method.
