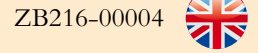
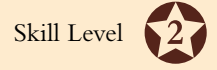

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

1 pair 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

Set of 4 double-pointed 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles (or very short circular needle)

TENSION

19 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over striped st st using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Row 1: Using yarn B.

Rows 2 to 5: Using yarn C.

Row 6: Using yarn B.

Rows 7 to 9: Using yarn A.

Row 10: Using yarn D.

Rows 11 to 14: Using yarn E.

Row 15: Using yarn D.

Rows 16 to 18: Using yarn A.

Row 19: Using yarn B.

Rows 20 to 23: Using yarn F.

Row 24: Using yarn B.

Rows 25 to 27: Using yarn A.

Row 28: Using yarn G.

Rows 29 to 32: Using yarn H.

Row 33: Using yarn G.

Rows 34 to 36: Using yarn A.

Row 37: Using yarn I.

Rows 38 to 41: Using yarn J.

Row 42: Using yarn I.

Rows 43 to 45: Using yarn A.

Row 46: Using yarn K.

Rows 47 to 50: Using yarn L.

Row 51: Using yarn K.

Rows 52 to 54: Using yarn A.

Row 55: Using yarn M.

Rows 56 to 59: Using yarn D.

Row 60: Using yarn M.

Rows 61 to 63: Using yarn A.

Row 64: Using yarn N.

Rows 65 to 68: Using yarn E.

Row 69: Using yarn N.

Rows 70 to 72: Using yarn A.

Row 73: Using yarn O.

Rows 74 to 77: Using yarn F.

Row 78: Using yarn O.

Rows 79 to 81: Using yarn A.

Row 82: Using yarn G.

Rows 83 to 86: Using yarn P.

Row 87: Using yarn G.

Rows 88 to 90: Using yarn A.

Row 91: Using yarn Q.

Rows 92 to 95: Using yarn R.

Row 96: Using yarn Q.

Rows 97 to 99: Using yarn A.

Row 100: Using yarn K.

Rows 101 to 104: Using yarn C.

Row 105: Using yarn K.

Rows 106 to 108: Using yarn A.

Row 109: Using yarn I.

Rows 110 to 113: Using yarn E.

Row 114: Using yarn I.

Rows 115 to 117: Using yarn A.

These 117 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated.

BODY (worked in one piece from cuff to cuff)

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 71 [73: 79: 79: 85] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for 1 row more, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Change to 4½mm (US 7) needles.

Row 4 (WS): Purl.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required and beg with stripe row 1, now work in st st, beg with a K row, in stripe sequence (see above) throughout as follows:

Work 6 [2: 4: 2: 4] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place marker on centre st of last row – this st forms shoulder “seam”.

Next row (RS): Inc in first st, K to within 1 st of marked st, M1, K3 (marked st is centre st of these 3 sts), M1, K to last st, inc in last st. Work 5 rows.

Rep last 6 rows 1 [2: 2: 3: 3] times more, and then first of these rows (the inc row) again. 83 [89: 95: 99: 105] sts.

Work 3 [3: 3: 1: 1] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at each end of next 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row, **and at same time** inc 1 [1: 1: 0: 0] st at each side of marked st as before on 3rd [3rd: 3rd: -: -] row. 93 [99: 105: 107: 113] sts.

Shape left side seam

Cast on 52 [52: 52: 53: 53] sts at beg of next 2 rows **and at same**

time inc 0 [0: 0: 1: 1] st at each side of marked st as before on first of these rows.

197 [203: 209: 215: 221] sts.

Inc 1 st at each side of marked st as before on

3rd [3rd: 3rd: 5th: 5th] and 6 [7: 8: 9: 10] foll 6th rows. 211 [219: 227: 235: 243] sts.

Work 4 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Divide for front and back

Next row (WS): P to within 3 [3: 3: 3: 4] sts of marked st and slip these 102 [106: 110: 114: 117] sts onto a holder (for front), P next 4 [4: 4: 4: 5] sts (last of these sts is the marked st) and slip these sts onto another holder (for neckband), P to end.

Work on this set of 105 [109: 113: 117: 121] sts only for back as follows: Dec 1 st at neck edge of next and foll alt row, then on foll 4th row. 102 [106: 110: 114: 118] sts.

Work 47 [49: 51: 49: 51] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Inc 1 st at neck edge of next and foll 4th row, then on foll alt row, ending with **WS** facing for next row. 105 [109: 113: 117: 121] sts.

Break yarns and leave these sts on another holder.

Rejoin appropriate yarns to 102 [106: 110: 114: 117] sts left on front holder with RS facing and cont as follows:

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 5 [5: 7: 7: 9] rows, then on foll 3 [3: 3: 3: 2] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 92 [96: 98: 102: 104] sts.

Work 23 [25: 23: 21: 23] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at neck edge of next and 2 foll 4th rows, then on foll 3 [3: 3: 3: 2] alt rows, then on foll 4 [4: 6: 6: 8] rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row. 102 [106: 110: 114: 117] sts.

Join sections

Next row (WS): P 102 [106: 110: 114: 117] sts of front section, turn and cast on 4 [4: 4: 4: 5] sts placing new shoulder “seam” marker on last of these cast-on sts, turn and P across all 105 [109: 113: 117: 121] sts left on back holder. 211 [219: 227: 235: 243] sts.

Work 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K to within 2 sts of marked st, K2tog, K marked st, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end.

Working all shoulder “seam” decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each side of marked st on 6th and 5 [6: 7: 8: 9] foll 6th rows. 197 [203: 209: 215: 221] sts.

Work 1 [1: 1: 3: 3] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape right side seam

Cast off 52 [52: 52: 53: 53] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 93 [99: 105: 109: 115] sts.

Work 1 row, dec 0 [0: 0: 1: 1] st at each side of marked st and ending with **WS** facing for next row. 93 [99: 105: 107: 113] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 4 rows, then on foll 4th [4th: 4th: alt: alt] row, then on 2 [3: 3: 4: 4] foll 6th rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at each side of marked st on 2nd [2nd: 2nd: 6th: 6th] and 3 [4: 4: 4: 4] foll 6th rows. 71 [73: 79: 79: 85] sts.

Work 6 [2: 4: 2: 4] rows, ending after 1 row using yarn A and with **WS** facing for next row.

Break off contrasts and cont using yarn A **only**.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for cast-on edge for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Neckband

With RS facing, using 4mm (US 6) double-pointed needles and yarn A, K across 4 [4: 4: 4: 5] sts on left shoulder holder, pick up and knit 16 [16: 18: 18: 19] sts down left side of front neck to last dec, 16 [17: 16: 15: 16] sts along straight row-end edge of front neck to first inc, 16 [16: 18: 18: 19] sts up right side of front neck to right shoulder, 4 [4: 4: 4: 5] sts from right shoulder cast-on sts, then 42 [43: 45: 43: 45] sts from back neck. 98 [100: 105: 102: 109] sts.

Round 1 (RS): Purl.

Round 2: Knit.

Cast off **purlwise** (on RS).

Hem borders (both alike)

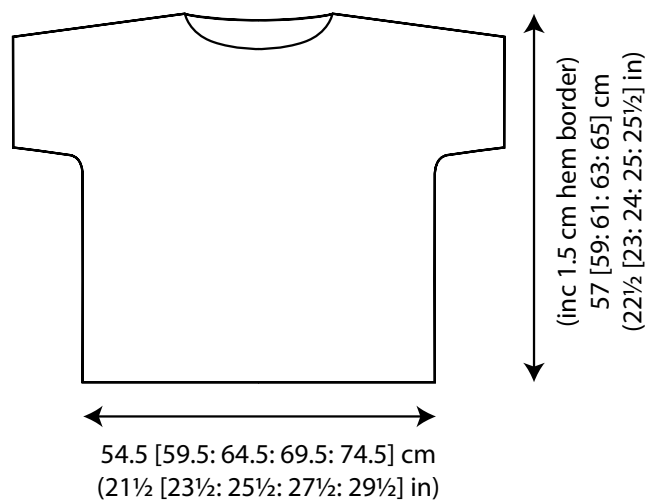
With RS facing, using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 103 [112: 122: 131: 141] sts evenly along row-end edge of back.

Work in g st for 4 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).

Work hem border along row-end edge of front in same way.
