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# Granny Square Crochet Blanket

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## FINISHED SIZE

Approx – 129cm (50¾in) x 165cm (65in). Each square should measure approx 12cm (4¾in)

Once you have worked your first square if your square feels too dense and stiff for your liking please go up a hook size. This may slightly affect the size of your blanket but will give the blanket a more pleasing fabric.

## YARN

### Rowan Pure Wool Superwash Worsted

A Soft Cream 102	7x 100gm
B Bottle 140	2x 100gm
C Vintage 158	2x 100gm
D Seville 134	2x 100gm
E Mallard 144	2x 100gm
F Rosy 115	2x 100gm
G Gold 133	2x 100gm
H Rich Red 124	2x 100gm
I Mustard 131	2x 100gm
J Electric 143	2x 100gm
K Satin 116	2x 100gm

## CROCHET HOOK

4mm (no 8) (US G6) crochet hook or size required to achieve correct square size.

## CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble;  
**beg** = beginning; **ch sp** = chain space.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Using 4mm crochet hook and colour 1 make 4 ch, ss into first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 3 ch, 2 tr, (2 ch, 3 tr) 3 times, 2 ch, ss into 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch at beg of round to join, turn. Break yarn and fasten off.

**Round 2:** Join colour 2 into nearest ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1tr), (2tr, 2ch, 3 tr) into same ch sp, \* 2 ch, (3tr, 2 ch, 3tr) into next ch sp,

rep from \* twice more, 2 ch, sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch at beg of round, turn. Break yarn and fasten off.

**Round 3:** Join colour 3 into nearest ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1tr), 2 tr into same ch sp, \* 2 ch, (3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr) into corner ch sp, 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp, rep from \* twice more, 2 ch, (3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr) into corner ch sp, 2ch, sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch at beg of round, turn. Break yarn and fasten off.

**Round 4:** Join colour 2 into nearest ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1tr), 2 tr into same ch sp, \* 2 ch, (3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr) into corner ch sp, (2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp) twice, rep from \* twice more, 2 ch, (3 tr, ch, 3tr) into corner ch sp, 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp, 2 ch, sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch at beg of round, turn. Break yarn and fasten off.

**Round 5:** Join colour 1 into nearest ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1tr), 2 tr into same ch sp, \* 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp, 2 ch, (3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr) into corner ch sp, (2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp) 3 times, rep from \* twice more, 2 ch, (3 tr, ch, 3tr) into corner ch sp, 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp, 2 ch, sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of 3 at beg of round. Fasten off. Sew in all ends and press lightly.

## Colourway 1

Make 18 squares using B as colour 1, A as colour 2 and C as colour 3.

## Colourway 2

Make 18 squares using D as colour 1, A as colour 2 and E as colour 3.

## Colourway 3

Make 18 squares using F as colour 1, A as colour 2 and G as colour 3.

## Colourway 4

Make 17 squares using H as colour 1, A as colour 2 and I as colour 3.

## Colourway 5

Make 17 squares using J as colour 1, A as colour 2 and K as colour 3.

## MAKING UP

Join all squares as shown using slip stitch crochet or sew together.

## Edging

**Round 1:** Using A, join yarn to a corner ch sp of joined work, 3 ch (counts as 1tr), (2 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr) into same corner ch sp, \* 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch sp, rep from \* to next corner ch sp, working 1 tr into corner sp, 1 tr into join and 1 tr into next corner sp at each point one colourway joins another, 2 ch, (3 tr, 2ch, 3tr) into corner sp, rep from \* twice more, \*\* 2 ch, 3 tr into ch sp rep from \*\* until last ch sp has been worked into, 2 ch, sl st into 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch at beg of round, turn. Break yarn and fasten off.

**Round 2:** Join H into nearest ch sp, 3 ch, 2 tr into same ch sp, \* 2 ch, 3tr into ch sp, rep from \* to next corner ch sp (3 tr, 2ch, 3tr) into corner ch sp, rep from \* twice more, \*\* 2 ch, 3 tr into ch sp, rep from \*\* until last ch sp has been worked into, 2 ch, sl st into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch at beg of round, turn.

**Round 3:** Using A, work as given for round 2.

**Round 4:** Using I, work as given for round 2.

**Round 5:** Using A, work as given for round 2.

**Round 6:** Using K, work as given for round 2.

**Round 7:** Using A, work as given for round 2. Fasten off.

Sew in all ends and press lightly.

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
