Knitting Needle & Crochet Hook Rolls

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YARN

Cotton Glace

Knitting needle roll 2 x 50gm

Crochet hook roll 1 x 50gm

(knitting needle roll photographed in Dark Forest 859, crochet hook roll in Cobalt 850)

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

Cable needle

3.00mm (no 11) (US C2) crochet hook (optional)

EXTRAS – piece of lining fabric: 40 cm by 30 cm for knitting needle roll, or 25 cm by 30 cm for crochet hook roll

TENSION

28 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed knitting needle roll is 35 cm (14 in) long and measures approx 9 cm (3½ in) deep when fastened.

Completed crochet hook needle roll is 18 cm (7 in) long and measures approx 9 cm (3½ in) deep when fastened.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C2B = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; **C2F** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; **C4B** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle; **C4F** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle; **MB** = K into front, back, front, back and front again of next st, (slip 5 sts now on right needle back onto left needle and K these 5 sts) twice, lift 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sts on right needle over first st and off right needle.

CROCHET ABBREVIATION

dc = double crochet.

Knitting needle roll

MAIN SECTION

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 99 sts.

Work in patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, P2, C2B, *P3, K8, P3, K1, yfwd, K3, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K3, yfwd, K1, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, K8, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: K3, P2, K3, P8, K3, *P11, K3, P8, K3, rep from * to last 5 sts, P2, K3.

Row 3: K1, P2, C2B, *P3, K8, P3, K2, yfwd, K2, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K2, yfwd, K2, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, K8, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Row 5: K1, P2, C2B, *P3, K8, P3, K3, yfwd, K1, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K1, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, K8, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Row 7: K1, P2, C2B, *P3, K8, P3, K4, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K4, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, K8, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Row 9: K1, P2, C2B, *P3, C4B, C4F, P3, K5, MB, K5, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, C4B, C4F, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Row 10: As row 2.

These 10 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work meas approx 17 cm, ending after patt row 8 and with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K1, P2, C2B, *P3, K3, MB, K4, P3, K5, MB, K5, rep from * to last 19 sts, P3, K3, MB, K4, P3, C2F, P2, K1.

Cast off all sts knitwise (on **WS**).

POCKET

With RS facing and using 3¼mm (US 3) needles, pick up and knit 88 sts along cast-on edge of main section.

Row 1 (WS): K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: K3, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until pocket meas 8 cm **from pick-up row**, ending with RS facing for next row.
Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page in FAQ area.

From lining fabric, cut a piece the same size as **complete** knitted section, adding seam allowance along all edges. Lay lining fabric against WS of knitted piece, turn under raw edges and neatly sew in place – make sure folded edge of fabric is just inside edge of knitting as you will be adding a crochet edging along the edges of the knitting.

Fold pocket up onto main section along pick-up row and join side seam edges.

Crochet edging (optional)

Using 3.00mm (US C2) crochet hook, attach yarn at folded pocket pick-up row and work 1 row of dc up side of pocket (working through both layers of knitting), all around flap, and then down other side of pocket (working through both layers of knitting), ending at folded pocket pick-up row, do NOT turn.

Now work 1 row of crab st (dc worked from left to right, instead of right to left) along these edges.

Fasten off.

Tie

Using 4 strands of yarn, make a twisted cord approx 50 cm long and knot ends (so they form tiny tassels). Close knitting needle roll, by folding flap down over pocket, and tie the tie around the closed roll, positioning the bow at centre of roll as in photograph. Now secure tie in place by stitching it to the folded lower edge.

Crochet hook roll

MAIN SECTION

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 50 sts.

Work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): K1, P1, C2B, P3, K1, yfwd, K3, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K3, yfwd, K1, P3, K8, P3, K1, yfwd, K3, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K3, yfwd, K1, P3, C2F, P1, K1.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: K2, P2, K3, P11, K3, P8, K3, P11, K3, P2, K2.

Row 3: K1, P1, C2B, P3, K2, yfwd, K2, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K2, yfwd, K2, P3, K8, P3, K2, yfwd, K2, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K2, yfwd, K2, P3, C2F, P1, K1.

Row 5: K1, P1, C2B, P3, K3, yfwd, K1, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, yfwd, K3, P3, K8, P3, K3, yfwd, K1, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, yfwd, K3, P3, C2F, P1, K1.

Row 7: K1, P1, C2B, P3, K4, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K4, P3, K8, P3, K4, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K4, P3, C2F, P1, K1.

Row 9: K1, P1, C2B, P3, K5, MB, K5, P3, C4B, C4F, P3, K5, MB, K5, P3, C2F, P1, K1.

Row 10: As row 2.

These 10 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work meas approx 17 cm, ending after patt row

8 and with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K1, P2, MB, P3, K1, (MB, K3) twice, MB, K1, P3, K1, MB, C4F, MB, K1, P3, K1, MB, (K3, MB) twice, K1, P3, MB, P2, K1.

Cast off all sts knitwise (on **WS**).

POCKET

With RS facing and using 3¼mm (US 3) needles, pick up and knit 44 sts along cast-on edge of main section.

Row 1 (WS): K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: K3, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until pocket meas 8 cm **from pick-up row**, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page in FAQ area.

From lining fabric, cut a piece the same size as **complete** knitted section, adding seam allowance along all edges. Lay lining fabric against WS of knitted piece, turn under raw edges and neatly sew in place – make sure folded edge of fabric is just inside edge of knitting as you will be adding a crochet edging along the edges of the knitting.

Fold pocket up onto main section along pick-up row and join side seam edges.

Crochet edging (optional)

Using 3.00mm (US C2) crochet hook, attach yarn at folded pocket pick-up row and work 1 row of dc up side of pocket (working through both layers of knitting), all around flap, and then down other side of pocket (working through both layers of knitting), ending at folded pocket pick-up row, do NOT turn.

Now work 1 row of crab st (dc worked from left to right, instead of right to left) along these edges.

Fasten off.

Tie

Using 4 strands of yarn, make a twisted cord approx 50 cm long and knot ends (so they form tiny tassels). Close crochet hook roll, by folding flap down over pocket, and tie the tie around the closed roll, positioning the bow at centre of roll as in photograph. Now secure tie in place by stitching it to the folded lower edge.



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
