### NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼ mm (no 10) (US 3) needles  
4.00mm (no 8) (US G6) crochet hook

**EXTRAS** – Waist length of 2.5 cm wide elastic

### TENSION

**Kidsilk Haze:** 30 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 3¼ mm (US 3) needles.

**Kid Classic:** 20 sts and 15 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook.

### CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **ss** = slip stitch;  
**tr** = treble.

### Underskirt

BACK and FRONT (both alike)

Using 3¼ mm (US 3) needles and yarn G cast on 242 [256: 274] sts.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 12 [13: 14] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and 5 foll 4th rows, then on every foll alt row until 118 [132: 150] sts rem.

Cont straight until work meas 76 [77: 78] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off.

### MAKING UP

Join both side seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred. Fold 4 cm to inside around upper edge and slip st in place, leaving a small opening. Thread elastic through this waist casing, join ends, then sew opening closed.

### Hem edging

With RS facing, using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook and yarn H, attach yarn at base of one side seam, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), work 1 round of dc evenly around entire cast-on hem edge, ending with ss to first dc.

Break off yarn H and join in yarn F.

**Next round (RS):** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

### Apron

#### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work in patt as below using colours as folls:

**Row 1:** Using yarn A.

**Row 2:** Using yarn B.

**Row 3:** Using yarn C.

**Row 4:** Using yarn D.

**Row 5:** Using yarn B.

**Row 6:** using yarn E.

**Row 7:** Using yarn A.

**Row 8:** Using yarn C.

**Row 9:** Using yarn F.

**Row 10:** Using yarn E.

**Row 11:** Using yarn D.

These 11 rows form stripe sequence. (**Note:** stripe sequence is an 11 row rep but patt is a 4 row rep so colours used for each patt row

will change on every rep.)

## APRON

Using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook and yarn A make 269 [297: 311] ch.

Working in stripe sequence (as given above) throughout, cont as folls:

**Foundation row (RS):** 3 tr into 3rd ch from hook, \*miss 3 ch, 1 dc into each of next 7 ch, miss 3 ch\*\*, 7 tr into next ch, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, 4 tr into last ch, turn. 267 [295: 309] sts.

Cont in patt as folls:

**Row 1 (WS):** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each tr and dc to end, working last dc into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

**Row 2:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 4 dc, \*miss 3 dc, 7 tr into next dc, miss 3 dc\*\*, 1 dc into each of next 7 dc, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, 1 dc into each of last 4 dc, turn.

**Row 3:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc and tr to end, turn.

**Row 4:** 3 ch (counts as first tr), 3 tr into dc at base of 3 ch, \*miss 3 dc, 1 dc into each of next 7 dc, miss 3 dc\*\*, 7 tr into next dc, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, 4 tr into last dc, turn.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until apron meas 63 [64: 65] cm.

Fasten off.

## MAKING UP

### Hem edging

With RS facing, using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook and yarn E, attach yarn at one end of foundation ch edge, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), work 1 row of dc evenly across entire foundation ch edge, ensuring number of dc worked in a multiple of 6 sts plus 1, turn.

**Next row (WS):** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to

end, turn.

Break off yarn E and join in yarn F.

Rep last row once more.

Break off yarn F and join in yarn D.

Rep last row once more.

**Next row (RS):** 3 ch (counts as first tr), 2 tr into dc at base of 3 ch, \*miss 2 dc, 1 dc into next dc, miss

2 dc\*\*, 5 tr into next dc, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, 3 tr into last dc, turn.

Break off yarn D and join in yarn C.

**Next row:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into tr at base of 1 ch, \*3 ch, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next tr, rep from \* to end, working dc at end of last rep into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row.

Fasten off.

### Front edgings (both alike)

Work as given for hem edging, working along entire front opening (row-end) edge, between top of last row of hem edging and top of last row of main section.

### Waistband and ties

With RS facing, using 4.00mm (US G6) crochet hook and yarn E, make 60 ch (for first tie), work 74 [92: 116] dc evenly across entire top of main section (this is approx 1 dc for every 3-4 sts), make another 61 ch (for second tie) and turn.

**Next row:** 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc into each ch and dc to end, turn. 194 [212: 236] sts.

**Next row:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.

Break off yarn E and join in yarn F.

Rep last row once more.

Break off yarn F and join in yarn D.

Rep last row once more.

Fasten off.
