#### **NEEDLES**

1 pair 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles 1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles 5mm (no 6) (US 8) circular needle, 40 cm long

## **TENSION**

14 sts and 21 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 6mm (US 10) needles.

# SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sl 2=slip 2 sts; p2sso= pass 2 slipped sts over.

## BACK

Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 75 [83: 91: 99: 109] sts. Work 2 rows in g st, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

**Row3:**K3[1:2:3:2],\*yfwd,sl2,K1,p2sso,yfwd,K3,repfrom\*tolast0[4:5: 0:5] sts, (yfwd, sl 2, K1, p2sso, yfwd) 0 [1:1:0:1] times, K0 [1:2:0:2].

Row 4: Knit.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until back meas 23 [24: 25:26: 27] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at each end of next and 3 foll  $12^{th}$  rows. 67 [75: 83: 91: 101] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 50 [51: 52: 53: 54] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4: 5: 6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 61 [67: 73: 79: 87] sts.\*\*

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 [5: 5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll 1 [2: 3: 2: 2] alt rows, then on foll 4<sup>th</sup> row. 47 [51: 55: 59: 63] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [21: 22: 23: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

# Shape shoulders and back neck

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 5 [6: 6: 7: 8] sts, patt until there are 8 [9: 10: 11: 11] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 5 [6:7:8:8] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 21 [21: 23: 23: 25] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to end.

Complete to match first side reversing shapings.

#### **FRONT**

Work as given for back to \*\*.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 4 [4: 5: 6: 8] rows.

Work 0 [0: 1: 0: 0] row, ending with RS facing for next row. 53 [59: 63: 67: 71] sts.

## Shape neck

**Next row (RS):** Patt 2tog, patt 20 [23: 25: 27: 29] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. 21 [24: 26: 28: 30] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then on 3 [3: 4: 4: 5] foll alt rows, then on 2 foll  $4^{th}$  rows, then on 2 foll  $6^{th}$  rows **at the same time** dec 1 st at armhole edge on  $2^{nd}$  row, then on 0 [1: 1: 1: 1] foll alt row, then on foll  $4^{th}$  row. 10 [12: 13: 15: 16] sts.

Cont straight until front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulder

Next row (RS): Cast off 5 [6: 6: 7: 8] sts, patt to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 [6: 7: 8: 8] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 9 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog.

Complete to match first side reversing shapings.

#### **SLEEVES**

Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 33 [33: 35: 35: 37] sts. Work 2 rows in g st, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

**Row3:**K3[3:1:1:2],\*yfwd,sl2,K1,p2sso,yfwd,K3,repfrom\*tolast0[0:4: 4: 5] sts, (yfwd, sl 2, K1, p2sso, yfwd) 0 [0: 1: 1: 1] times, K0 [0: 1: 1: 2].



#### Row 4: Knit.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of  $5^{th}$  [ $3^{rd}$ :  $3^{rd}$ :  $3^{rd}$ :  $3^{rd}$ ] row, then on every foll  $12^{th}$  [ $8^{th}$ :  $8^{th}$ :  $8^{th}$ :  $6^{th}$ ] row to 47 [39: 39: 49: 41] sts, then on every foll – [ $10^{th}$ :  $10^{th}$ :  $10^{th}$ :  $8^{th}$ ] row until there are – [51: 53: 55: 59] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [46: 47: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4: 5: 6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 41 [43: 43: 43: 45] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on 4 [4: 5: 5: 5] foll 4<sup>th</sup> rows, then foll 2 [3: 2: 4: 5] alt rows, then on every row until 13 sts rem.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the ball band.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

#### Collar

With RS facing and using 5mm (US 8) circular needle, pick up and knit 28 [28: 29: 29: 30] sts down left side of front neck, K across 9 sts from front holder, pick up and knit 28 [28: 29: 29: 30] sts up right side of neck, and 3 sts from right side of back neck, knit across 21 [21: 23: 23: 25] sts from back holder and pick up and knit 3 sts from left side of back neck. 92 [92: 96: 96: 100] sts.


**Round 1 (RS):** \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end.


This round forms rib.

Cont in rib until collar meas 33 cm from pick up round.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Setting in sleeves using the set-in method.
