NEEDLES

1 pair 2¾mm (no 12) (US 2) needles

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

BEADS - 304 beads (no. 563) by Debbie Abraham (size 8).

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is approx 15 cm (6 in) wide and approx 177 cm (69½ in) long.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

bead 1 = place a bead by taking yarn to RS of work and slipping bead up next to st just worked, slip next st purlwise from left needle to right needle and take yarn back to WS of work, leaving bead sitting in front of slipped st on RS.

Beading note: Before starting to knit, thread beads onto yarn. To do this, thread a fine sewing needle (one that will easily pass through the beads) with sewing thread. Knot ends of thread and then pass end of yarn through this loop. Thread a bead onto sewing thread and then gently slide it along and onto knitting yarn. Continue in this way until required number of beads are on yarn.

SCARF

Thread 304 beads onto yarn.

Using 2¾mm (US 2) needles cast on 42 sts.

Noting that first row is a **WS** row, work in g st for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and every foll alt row to row 20: K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 3: K12, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K15, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K11.

Row 5: K10, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K12, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K10.

Row 7: K9, K2tog, yfwd, K1, bead 1, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K10, K2tog, yfwd, K1, bead 1, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K9.

Row 9: *K8, K2tog, yfwd, (K1, bead 1) twice, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * once more, K8.

Row 11: K7, K2tog, yfwd, (K1, bead 1) 3 times, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K6, K2tog, yfwd, (K1, bead 1) 3 times, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K7.

Row 13: K6, K2tog, yfwd, K1, bead 1, K2, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, bead 1, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K4, K2tog, yfwd, K1, bead 1, K2, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, bead 1, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K6.

Row 15: K7, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K6, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K7.

Row 17: (K8, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd) twice, K8.

Row 19: Knit.

Row 20: As row 2.

Row 21: K5, *yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 22: K2, P3, *yfn, P2tog, rep from * to last 3 sts, P1, K2.

Rows 23 to 34: As rows 21 and 22, 6 times.

Last 34 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until scarf meas approx 176 cm, ending after patt row 20 and with RS facing for next row.

Change to 2¾mm (US 2) needles.

Work in g st for 3 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).
