Version 1

NEEDLES

1 pair 6 (no 4) (US 10) needles

TENSION

13 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over moss stitch and 14 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm measured over garter stitch.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed moss stitch scarf is 19 cm

 $(7\frac{1}{2}$ in) wide and 200 cm (79 in) long and the completed garter stitch scarf is 18 cm

(7 in) wide and 200 cm (79 in) long.

SCARF

Version 1

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 25 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: As row 1.

These two rows from moss stitch patt. Cont in patt until almost all of the last ball has been used, leaving enough to cast off.

Cast off all sts.

Version 2

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 25 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: As row 1.

These two rows from garter stitch patt. Cont in patt until almost all of the last ball has been used, leaving enough to cast off.

Cast off all sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the ball band.
