## NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
Cable needle

BUTTONS - 5 [5:5:6:6] x shell buttons from Groves. Please see information page for contact details.

## TENSION

25 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm measured over rev st st using $3 \frac{1}{1 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}}$ (US 3) needles. Cable panel ( 8 sts) measures 2.5 cm .

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{C 4 B}=$ slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle; $\mathbf{C} 4 \mathbf{F}=$ slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

## BACK

## First leg

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles cast on 17 [19:19:21:21] sts.
Row 1 (RS): K1, ${ }^{\star}$ P1, K1, rep from $\star$ to end.
Row 2: $\mathrm{P} 1, \star \mathrm{~K} 1, \mathrm{P} 1$, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end.
These 2 rows form rib.
Work in rib for a further 8 rows, inc 1 st at centre of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 18 [20: 20: 22: 22] sts.
Now work in patt as folls:
Row 1 (RS): P5 [6: 6:7:7], K8, P5 [6: 6:7:7].
Row 2: K5 [6: 6:7:7], P8, K5 [6: 6:7:7].
Row 3: P5 [6: 6:7:7], C4B, C4F, P5 [6: 6:7:7].
Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: Inc in first st, P4 [5:5:6:6], K8, P4 [5:5:6:6], inc in last st. 20 [22: 22: 24: 24] sts.
Row 6: K6 [7:7:8:8], P8, K6 [7:7:8:8].
Row 7: P6 [7: 7: 8: 8], C4B, C4F, P6 [7:7:8:8].
Row 8: As row 6.
Row 9: (Inc in first st) $1[0: 0: 0: 0]$ times, P5 [7:7:8:8], K8, P5 [7: 7:8:8], (inc in last st) 1 [0:0:0:0] times. 22 [22:22:24:24] sts.
Row 10: K7 [7: 7: 8: 8], P8, K7 [7:7:8:8].
Row 11: (Inc in first st) 0 [1:1:0:0] times, P7 [6:6:8:8], C4F, C4B, P7 [6:6:8:8], (inc in last st) $0[1: 1: 0: 0]$ times. $22[24: 24: 24: 24]$ sts.
Row 12: K7 [8: 8: 8: 8], P8, K7 [8: 8: 8:8].
Row 13: (Inc in first st) 1 [ $0: 0: 0: 0]$ times, P6 [8:8:8:8], K8, P6 [8: 8:8:8], (inc in last st) 1 [0:0:0:0] times. 24 sts.
Row 14: K8, P8, K8.
Row 15: (Inc in first st) $0[0: 0: 1: 1]$ times, $P 8[8: 8: 7: 7]$, C4F, C4B, P8 [8: 8:7:7], (inc in last st) $0[0: 0: 1: 1]$ times. $24[24: 24: 26: 26]$ sts.
Row 16: K8 [8: 8: 9: 9], P8, K8 [8: 8: 9: 9].
These 16 rows form patt and beg leg shaping.
Keeping patt correct, inc 1 st at each end on next [next: next: 9th: 9th] and 2 [2:1:3:4] foll 4th [6th: 6th: 10th: 10th] rows, then on 1 [1:3:-:-] foll 6th [8th: 8th: -: -] rows, taking inc sts into rev st st. 32 [32: 34:34:36] sts.
Work 3 [3:3:5:5] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. ${ }^{\star \star}$
Inc 1 st at beg of next and foll alt row, then at same edge on foll row, ending with RS facing for next row. 35 [35:37:37:39] sts.
Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

## Second leg

Work as given for first leg to $\star \star$.
Inc 1 st at end of next and foll alt row, then at same edge on foll row, ending with RS facing for next row. 35 [35:37:37:39] sts.

## Join legs

Next row (RS): Patt 35 [35:37:37:39] sts of second leg, turn and cast on 3 [5:5:7:5] sts, turn and patt across all 35 [35:37:37:39] sts of first leg. 73 [75:79: 81:83] sts.
Now working in patt (of 2 cable panels with rev st st at sides and centre) across all sts, cont as folls: $\star \star \star$
Cont straight until back meas 16.5 [18: 19.5: 22: 23.5 ] cm from
joining row, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 65 [67:71: 73: 75] sts.
Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows.
49 [51: 55: 57: 59] sts.
Cont straight until armhole meas 10.5 [11: 11.5: 12: 12.5 ] cm,
ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulders and back neck

Next row (RS): Cast off 3 [3:3:3:4] sts, patt until there are 9 [9: 11:11:11] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.
Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows and at same time cast off 3 [3:4:4:4] sts at beg of 2 nd row.
Cast off rem 3 [3:4:4:4] sts.
With RS facing, slip centre 25 [27:27:29:29] sts onto a holder (for neckband), rejoin yarn and patt to end.
Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

## FRONT

Work as given for back to $\star \star \star$.
Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Divide for front opening

Next row (RS): Patt 35 [36: 38: 39: 40] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.
Work each side of front separately.
Cont straight until this side of front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armhole

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 sts at beg of next row. 31 [32: 34: 35: 36] sts.
Work 1 row.
Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 5 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows. 23 [24: 26: 27: 28] sts.
Cont straight until 10 [10: 10:12: 12] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Patt 15 [15: 17: 18: 19] sts and turn, leaving rem 8 [9:9:9:9] sts on a holder (for neckband).
Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows, then on foll 2 [2: 2: 3:3] alt rows. 9 [9:11:11:12] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulder

Cast off $3[3: 3: 3: 4]$ sts at beg of next row, then $3[3: 4: 4: 4]$ sts at beg of foll alt row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 3 [3:4:4:4] sts.
With RS facing, rejoin yarn to sts on first holder, cast off centre 3 sts, patt to end. 35 [36:38:39: 40] sts.
Complete to match first side, reversing shapings and working first row of neck shaping as folls:

## Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Patt 8 [9:9:9:9] sts and slip these sts onto a holder
(for neckband), patt to end. 15 [15:17:18:19] sts.

## SLEEVES

Using $31 / 1 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles cast on 31 [ $33: 33: 37: 37]$ sts.
Work in rib as given for first leg of back for 10 rows, inc 1 st at centre of last row and ending with RS facing for next row.

32 [34:34:38:38] sts.
Now work in patt as folls:
Row 1 (RS): (Inc in first st) 1 [1:0:0:0] times, P11 [12: 13: 15 : 15], K8, P11 [12: 13: 15: 15], (inc in last st) 1 [1:0:0:0] times. 34 [36:34:38:38] sts.
Row 2: K13 [14: 13: 15: 15], P8, K13 [14: 13: 15: 15].
Row 3: (Inc in first st) 1 [ $0: 1: 1: 1$ ] times, P12 [14: 12: 14:14], C4B, C4F, P12 [14: 12:14:14], (inc in last st) 1 [0:1:1:1] times.
36 [36: 36: 40: 40] sts.
Row 4: K14 [14: 14: 16: 16], P8, K14 [14: 14: 16: 16].
These 4 rows set position of patt as given for back.
Cont in patt as now set, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of next [next: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd] and foll 1 [0:0:0:0] alt row, then on 5 [7:8:5:5] foll 4th rows, then on $0[0: 0: 3: 4]$ foll 6th rows, taking inc sts into rev st st. 50 [52: 54:58: 60] sts.
Cont straight until sleeve meas 13 [15:17:19:21] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 42 [44: 46: 50: 52] sts.
Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on every foll alt row until 22 sts rem, then on foll 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off rem 12 sts.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.
Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

## Neckband

With RS facing and using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles, slip 8 [9: 9: 9: 9] sts on right front holder onto right needle, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit 11 [11:11:13:13] sts up right side of front neck, and 3 sts down right side of back neck, $K$ across 25 [27:27:29:29] sts on back holder, pick up and knit 3 sts up left side of back neck, and 11 [11:11:13:13] sts down left side of front neck, then patt across 8 [9:9:9:9] sts on left front holder. 69 [73:73:79:79] sts.
Row 1 (WS): K1, ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{~K} 1$, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end.
Row 2: K2, ^P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.
These 2 rows form rib.
Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast off in rib (on WS).

## Button band

With RS facing and using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles, pick up and knit 65 [69: 77: 81: 87] sts evenly along one front opening edge (left front for a girl, or right front for a boy), between top of neckband and base of front opening.
Work in rib as given for neckband for 4 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast off in rib (on WS).

## Buttonhole band

With RS facing and using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles, pick up and knit 65 [69: 77: 81: 87] sts evenly along rem front opening edge (right
front for a girl, or left front for a boy), between top of neckband and
base of front opening.
Work in rib as given for neckband for 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

## For a girl

 buttonhole), rib 11 [12: 14:11:12], rep from * 3 [3:3:4:4] times more, yrn, work 2 tog (to make 5th [5h: 5th: 6th: 6th] buttonhole), rib 3.

## For a boy

Row 2 (RS): Rib 3, ${ }^{\text {w work }} 2$ tog, yrn (to make a buttonhole), rib 11 [12:14:11:12], rep from * 3 [3:3:4:4] times more, work 2 tog, yrn (to make 5th [5h: 5th: 6th: 6th] buttonhole), rib 8 [8:8:11:12].


## For a girl or a boy

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast off in rib (on WS).
Lay buttonhole band over button band and neatly sew row-ends in place to cast-off sts at base of openings. See information page for finishing instructions, setting in sleeves using the set-in method.
