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Plant Pot Cosy

Design & pattern by Dayana Krawchuk



This stretchy leafy cosy will fit a wide range of pots. The stems can be horizontal or diagonal just by twisting the cosy on the pot. It can be easily moved upward or folded when watering.

DIMENSIONS

The cozy will fit pots that are between 14-16.5 cm (5.5-6.5") height with a top circumference between 40-59 cm (16-23").

YARN

Pure Wool Worsted

1 x 100g

(photographed in Mallard 144)

NEEDLES

1 pair 4.5mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

TENSION

17 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm/4 in measured over p3, k1tbl twisted rib

STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

K1tbl: knit st through the back loop to twist it P1tbl: purl st through the back loop to twist it

M1: make 1 st

K2tog: knit two together

SSK: slip knitwise, slip knitwise, knit two slipped sts together

P2tog: purl two together

SSP: slip knitwise, slip knitwise, purl two slipped sts together

COVER

Cast on 54 sts. Begin body:

Row 1 (RS): P1, (P3, K1tbl) to last st, P1.

Row 2: K1, (P1tbl, K3) to last st, K1.

Row 3: As Row 1.

Row 4 (WS inc row): K1, (P1tbl, M1, K3, P1tbl, K3) to last 5 sts, P1tbl, M1, K4. 61 sts.

Row 5: P1, (P4, K1tbl, P3, K1tbl) to last 6 sts, P4, K1tbl, P1.

Row 6: K1, (P1tbl, K4, P1tbl, K3) to last 6 sts, P1tbl, K5.

Row 7, 9 and 11: As Row 5.

Row 8 and 10: As Row 6.

Row 12 (WS inc row): K1, (P1tbl, K4, P1tbl, M1, K3) to last 6 sts, P1tbl, K5. 67 sts.

Row 13: P1, (P4, K1tbl) to last st, P1.

Row 14: K1, (P1tbl, K4) to last st, K1.

Row 15, 17 and 19: As Row 13.

Row 16 and 18: As Row 14.

Row 20 (WS inc row): K1, (P1tbl, M1, K4, P1tbl, K4) to last 6 sts, P1tbl, M1, K5. 74 sts.

Row 21: P1, (P5, K1tbl, P4, K1tbl) to last 7 sts, P5, K1tbl, P1.

Row 22: K1, (P1tbl, K5, P1tbl, K4) to last 7 sts, P1tbl, K6.

Row 23, 25 and 27: As Row 21.

Row 24 and 26: As Row 22.

Row 28 (WS inc row): K1, (P1tbl, K5, P1tbl, M1, K4) to last 7 sts, P1tbl, K6. 80 sts.

Row 29: P1, (P5, K1tbl) to last st, P1.

Row 30: K1, (P1tbl, K5) to last st, K1.

Row 31: As Row 29.

Row 32: As Row 30.

Begin leaf border:

Row 1 (RS): P6, [(K1, yo, K1) in next st, P5] to last 2 sts, (K1, yo, K1) in next st, P1. 106 sts.

Row 2: K1, (P1, P1tbl, P1, K5) to last st, K1.

Row 3: P1, (P5, K1, yo, K1tbl, yo, K1) to last st, P1. 132 sts

Row 4: K1, (P2, P1tbl, P2, K5) to last st, K1.

Row 5: P1, (P5, K2, yo, K1tbl, yo, K2) to last st, P1. 158 sts.

Row 6: K1, (P3, P1tbl, P3, K5) to last st, K1.

Row 7: P1, (P5, K3, yo, K1tbl, yo, K3) to last st. P1. 184 sts.

Row 8: K1, (P4, P1tbl, P4, K5) to last st, K1.

Row 9: P1, (P5, SSK, K2, K1tbl, K2, K2tog) to last st, P1. 158 sts.

Row 10: K1, (P2tog, P1, P1tbl, P1, SSP, K5) to last st, K1. 132 sts.

Row 11: P1, (P5, SSK, K1tbl, K2tog) to last st, P1. 106 sts.

Row 12: K1, (p3tog, K5) to last st, K1. 80 sts.

Bind off in purl. If using wide circumference pots, bind off loosely.

Using mattress stitch, sew seam exactly 1 st away from edges, making sure the nearest stem/leaf remains outside the seam. For a diagonal effect, twist cosy while fitted onto plant pot.
