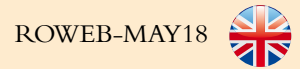
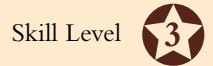

CROCHET HOOK

3.50mm (no 9) (US E4) crochet hook

TENSION

18 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over dc fabric using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook. Over lower patt, 3 patt reps (18 sts) meas 10.5 cm and 12 rows meas 11.5 cm. Over upper patt, 3 patt reps (16 sts) meas 9 cm and 8 rows meas 10 cm.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **dc2tog** = (insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **dtr** = double treble; **leaf cluster** = *(yoh) 3 times, insert hook as indicated for first “leg” and draw loop through, (yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, rep from * twice more, ******(yoh) 3 times, insert hook as indicated for second “leg” and draw loop through, (yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, rep from ****** twice more, yoh and draw through all 7 loops on hook; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble; **ttr2tog** = *(yoh) 3 times, insert hook as indicated and draw loop through, (yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, rep from * once more, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **ttr3tog** = *(yoh) 3 times, insert hook as indicated and draw loop through, (yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, rep from * twice more, yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook; **ttr4tog** = *(yoh) 3 times, insert hook as indicated and draw loop through, (yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, rep from * 3 times more, yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook; **yoh** = yarn over hook.

BACK and FRONT (both alike)

Using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook make 80 [92: 104: 110: 122] ch.

Foundation row (WS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc into each ch to end, turn. 79 [91: 103: 109: 121] sts.

Now work in lower patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.

Row 2: As row 1.

Row 3: 5 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 5 ch and next 2 dc, ttr3tog into next dc, *5 ch, 1 leaf cluster worked as follows: work first “leg” into dc already worked into, miss 5 dc and work second “leg” into next dc, rep from * to last 3 dc, 5 ch, ttr4tog working first 3 sts into same dc as used for second “leg” of last leaf cluster, miss next 2 dc and work last st into last dc, turn. 13 [15: 17: 18: 20] patt reps.

Row 4: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into ttr4tog at end of previous row, *5 dc into next ch sp**, 1 dc into top of next leaf cluster, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, 1 dc into top of ttr3tog at beg of previous row, turn.

These 4 rows form lower patt.

Cont in lower patt for a further 18 rows, ending after patt row 2 and with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 19 [10: 8: 26: 13] dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc, (1 dc into each of next 37 [21: 15: 53: 29] dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc) 1 [3: 5: 1: 3] times, 1 dc into each of last 19 [10: 8: 26: 13] dc, turn. 77 [87: 97: 107: 117] sts.

Next row: 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), miss (dc at base of 5 ch and next 2 dc), *(1 tr, 2 ch and 1 tr) into next st**, 3 ch, miss 4 sts, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, 2 ch, miss 2 dc, 1 tr into last dc, turn.

Now work in upper patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS): 4 ch (counts as first dtr), miss (tr at base of 4 ch, 2 ch and next tr), *5 dtr into next ch sp**, miss (1 tr, 3 ch and 1 tr), rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, miss (1 tr and 2 ch), 1 dtr into 3rd of 5 ch at beg of previous row, turn. 15 [17: 19: 21: 23] patt reps.

Row 2: 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), miss (dtr at base of 5 ch and next 2 dtr), *(1 tr, 2 ch and 1 tr) into next dtr**, 3 ch, miss 4 dtr, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, miss 2 dtr, 1 tr into top of 4 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

These 2 rows form upper patt.

Work in upper patt for a further 3 rows, ending after patt row 1 and with WS facing for next row.

Shape for cap sleeves

Next row (WS): 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), 1 tr into st at base

of 5 ch, 3 ch, miss 2 dtr, *(1 tr, 2 ch and 1 tr) into next dtr, 3 ch**, miss 4 dtr, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, miss 2 dtr, (1 tr, 2 ch and 1 tr) into top of 4 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Next row: 4 ch (counts as first dtr), miss tr at base of 4 ch, *5 dtr into next ch sp**, miss (1 tr, 3 ch and 1 tr), rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, miss (1 tr and 3 ch), 5 dtr into last ch sp, 1 dtr into 3rd of 5 ch at beg of previous row, turn. 17 [19: 21: 23: 25] patt reps.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 19 [21: 23: 25: 27] patt reps.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote base of armhole openings).

Work in patt for a further 14 [16: 16: 18: 18] rows, ending after patt row 1 and with **WS** facing for next row.

Next row (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 8 [8: 9: 7: 5] sts, 2 dc into next dtr, (1 dc into each of next 15 [17: 13: 15: 17] dtr, 2 dc into next dtr) 5 [5: 7: 7: 7] times, 1 dc into each of last 8 [8: 9: 7: 5] sts, working last dc into top of 4 ch at beg of previous row, turn. 103 [113: 125: 135: 145] sts.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.

Last row forms dc fabric.

Cont in dc fabric until work meas 20 [21.5: 23: 24.5: 26] cm from base of armhole openings.

Shape neck

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 38 [43: 49: 54: 59] dc and turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Work on this set of sts only for first side of neck.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), dc2tog over first 2 sts - 1 st decreased, 1 dc into each dc to end, turn. 37 [42: 48: 53: 58] sts.

Shape shoulder

Next row: Ss across and into 4th [5th: 6th: 6th: 7th] dc, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into dc at base of 1 ch - 3 [4: 5: 5: 6] sts decreased, 1 dc into each dc to last 2 sts, dc2tog over last 2 sts - 1 st decreased, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), dc2tog over first 2 sts - 1 st decreased, 1 dc into each dc to last 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] dc and turn, leaving rem 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] dc unworked - 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts decreased.

28 [32: 36: 40: 44] sts.

Working all decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts at shoulder edge of next 5 [2: 4: 5: 2] rows, then - [5: 6: -: 7] sts at same edge on foll - [3: 1: -: 3] rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows. 4 [5: 6: 6: 7] sts.

Fasten off.

Return to last complete row worked, miss next 27 dc, attach yarn to next dc and cont as folls:

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into dc where yarn was rejoined, 1 dc into each dc to end, turn. 38 [43: 49: 54: 59] sts.

Working all decreases as set by first side of neck, cont as folls:

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next row. 37 [42: 48: 53: 58] sts.

Shape shoulder

Dec 3 [4: 5: 5: 6] sts at shoulder edge of next 1 [4: 6: 1: 4] rows, then 4 [5: 6: 6: 7] sts at same edge on foll 6 [3: 1: 6: 3] rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows. 4 [5: 6: 6: 7] sts.

Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch.

Neckband

With RS facing and using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook, attach yarn at neck edge of left shoulder seam, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 10 dc evenly down left side of front neck, 1 dc into each of 27 dc left unworked at base of front neck, 10 dc evenly up right side of front neck, and 10 dc evenly down right side of back neck, 1 dc into each of 27 dc left unworked at base of back neck, and 10 dc evenly up left side of back neck, ss to first dc, turn. 94 sts.

Next round: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 9 dc, *dc2tog over next 2 dc, 1 dc into each of next 25 dc, dc2tog over next 2 dc*, 1 dc into each of next 18 dc, rep from * to * once more, 1 dc into each of next 9 dc, ss to first dc, turn. 90 sts.

Next round: 5 ch (does NOT count as st), ttr2tog into first dc, *5 ch, 1 leaf cluster worked as folls: work first "leg" into dc already worked into, miss 5 dc and work second "leg" into next dc, rep from * to last 5 dc, 5 ch, ttr3tog into dc already worked into, ss to top of ttr2tog at beg of round, turn.

Next round: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 5 dc into each ch sp to end, ss to first dc, turn. 75 sts.

Next round: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

Join side seams below markers denoting base of armhole openings.

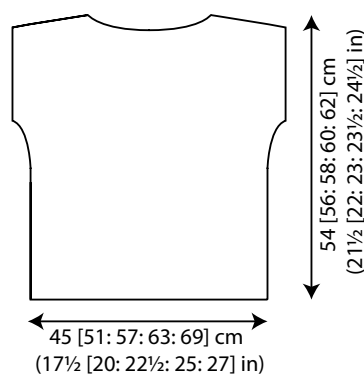
Armhole borders (both alike)

With RS facing and using 3.50mm (US E4) crochet hook, attach yarn to base of armhole opening, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), work 1 round of dc evenly around entire armhole opening edge, ending with ss to first dc, turn.

Next round: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.
