Quantities of yarn are approximate as they are based on average requirements.

Check actual yarn colour as printing may not match yarn exactly. Check the yarn labels and use only balls of the same batch.

Requirements

Scarves: Pair each Milward 3mm (UK 11/USA 2/3) and 4.5mm (UK 7/USA 7) needles. Milward bodkin and Coats washable toy stuffing.

Mitts: Pair each Milward 3mm (UK 11/USA 2/3), Milward 3.25mm (UK 10/USA 3) and 4mm (UK 8/USA 6) needles. Milward bodkin and a small amount of Coats washable toy stuffing for Eyes.

TENSION

23 sts and 35 rows to 10cm (stocking st) on 3mm needles; 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm on 4mm needles and 21 sts and 28 rows to 10cm on 4.5mm needles or size needed to achieve correct tension. It is important to check your tension before starting your garment. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, your tension is tight and you should change to a larger size needle. If there are too few, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller size needle.

Caution

It is essential to work to the stated tension and we cannot accept liability for the finished product if any yarn other than the specified yarn is used.

Abbreviations

K=knit; **P**=purl; **st(s)**=stitch(es); **garter st**=K every row; **stocking st**=K 1 row, P 1 row; **sL1K**=slip 1 st knitways; **pss**=pass slipped st over; **inc**=increase 1 stitch by working into front and back of next st; **K2tog**=knit 2 sts together; **P2tog**=purl next 2 sts together; **dec**=decrease by working 2 sts together; **beg**=beginning; **alt**=alternate; **rep**=repeat; **cont**=continue; **meas**=measures; **fol**=following; **rem**=remain(ing); **cm**=centimetres; **in**=inches; **mm**=millimetres; **M1**=make a st by picking up horizontal loop lying before next st and working into back of it.

U.S.A. Glossary

Cast off=bind off; tension=gauge; pick up and knit=knit up; stocking st=stockinette st.

Instructions are given for the first size, with larger size(s) given in square brackets []. Where only one figure is given this applies

to both (all) sizes. Where [0] is given, no st, row or time will be worked for this size.

Before starting to knit, read the instructions carefully and circle all figures relating to your size with a coloured pencil.

NOTE: When using BLACK, the right side is the knit side. When using SNOW, the right side is the purl side, unless otherwise stated.

All increases and decreases are worked on K rows, regardless of whether the right side or wrong side is facing.

VERSION 1 SCARF WITH LEGS

Head (knitted upwards from chin)

With 3mm needles and **BLACK**, cast on 18 [20, 24, 24] sts, leaving a long end. Starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 2 rows.

Inc row – K3 [3, 4, 4], (inc in next st) 3 times, K6 [8, 10, 10], (inc in next st) 3 times, K3 [3, 4, 4]. (24 [26, 30, 30] sts).

Next row – P.

Inc row – K3 [3, 4, 4], (inc in next st, K1) 3 times, K7 [9, 11, 11], (inc in next st, K1) 3 times, K2 [2, 3, 3]. (30 [32, 36, 36] sts).

Next row – P.

Inc row – K3 [3, 4, 4], (inc in next st, K2) 3 times, K8 [10, 12, 12], (inc in next st, K2) 3 times, K1 [1, 2, 2]. (36 [38, 42, 42] sts).

Next row – P.

Inc row – K3 [3, 4, 4], (inc in next st, K3) 3 times, K9 [11, 13, 13], (inc in next st, K3) 3 times, K0 [0, 1, 1]. (42 [44, 48, 48] sts).

Next row – P.

6-9 yrs, 10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Inc row – K [3, 4, 4], (inc in next st, K4) 3 times, K [12, 14, 14], (inc in next st, K4) [2, 3, 3] times, (inc in next st, K3) [1, 0, 0] time. ([50, 54, 54] sts).

Next row – P.

15+ size only: K4, (inc in next st, K5) 3 times, K15, (inc in next st, K5) twice, inc in next st, K4. (60 sts).

Next row – P.

All sizes: Cont in stocking st for 6 [6, 8, 8] rows.

15+ size only: Dec row – K4, (K2tog, K5) 8 times. (52 sts).

Work in stocking st for 5 rows.

All sizes: Dec row – K2 [3, 5, 4], (K2tog, K4) 6 [7, 7, 7] times, K2tog, K2 [3, 5, 4]. (35 [42, 46, 44] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 [5, 5, 3] rows.

Dec row – K2 [3, 5, 4], (K2tog, K3) 6 [7, 7, 7] times, K2tog, K1 [2, 4, 3]. (28 [34, 38, 36] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 [5, 3, 3] rows.

Dec row – K2 [3, 5, 4], (K2tog, K2) 6 [7, 7, 7] times, K2tog, K0 [1, 3, 2]. (21 [26, 30, 28] sts). Work in stocking st for 5 [5, 3, 5] rows.

10-14 yrs size only: Dec row – K3, (K2tog, K5) 3 times, K2tog, K4. (26 sts). Work 5 rows, thus ending after a P row.

All sizes: Break BLACK, join in **SNOW** and K 1 row.

Head Top

Starting with a **K** row, work in stocking st for 2 rows.

Inc row – K1 [2, 2, 0], (inc in next st, K1) 10 [12, 12, 14] times. (31 [38, 38, 42] sts).

Work in stocking st for 5 [7, 11, 13] rows.

Dec row – K1 [2, 2, 0], (K2tog, K1) 10 [12, 12, 14] times. (21 [26, 26, 28] sts).

Next row – P.

Next row – K0 [2, 0, 1], (K2tog, K1) 7 [8, 8, 9] times, (K2tog) 0 [0, 1, 0] time. (14 [18, 17, 19] sts).

Next row – P.

Break yarn leaving a long end and thread through all stitches.

Ears (make 2)

With 3mm needles and **BLACK**, cast on 10 [10, 12, 12] sts.

Starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 4 rows.

Inc row – K1, inc in next st, K2 [2, 3, 3], (inc in next st) twice, K2 [2, 3, 3], inc in next st, K1. (14 [14, 16, 16] sts). Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 [1, 1, 1] rows.

Inc row – K1, inc in next st, K4 [4, 5, 5], (inc in next st) twice, K4 [4, 5, 5], inc in next st, K1. (18 [18, 20, 20] sts).

Next row – P.

6-9 yrs, 10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Inc row – K1, inc in next st, K [6, 7, 7], (inc in next st) twice, K [6, 7, 7], inc in next st, K1. ([22, 24, 24] sts).

All sizes: Work 5 [7, 9, 11] rows.

Dec row – K1, K2tog, K4 [6, 7, 7], (K2tog) twice, K4 [6, 7, 7], K2tog, K1. (14 [18, 20, 20] sts).

Next row – P.

Dec row – K1, K2tog, K2 [4, 5, 5], (K2tog) twice, K2 [4, 5, 5], K2tog, K1. (10 [14, 16, 16] sts).

Next row – P.

6-9 yrs, 10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Dec row – K1, K2tog, K [2, 3, 3], (K2tog) twice, K [2, 3, 3], K2tog, K1. ([10, 12, 12] sts).

Next row – P.

All sizes: Cast off.

Body (knitted from Head down to Tail)

With 4.5mm needles and **SNOW**, cast on 24 [28, 30, 34] sts.

Starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 4 rows.

Inc row – K4, (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K9 [9, 11, 11], (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (28 [34, 36, 42] sts). Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Inc row – K5 [5, 5, 6], (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K11 [13, 15, 15], (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (32 [40, 42, 50] sts). Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Inc row – K6 [6, 6, 8], (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K13 [17, 19, 19], (inc in next st, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (36 [46, 48, 58] sts).

10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Inc row – K [7, 10], (inc in next st, K1) [3, 4] times, K23, (inc in next st, K1) [3, 4] times, K to end. ([54, 66] sts).**

All sizes: Work in stocking st until Body meas 24 [29, 33, 38] cm from cast-on edge without stretching, ending with a P row.

*****Dec row** – K6 [6, 7, 10], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K13 [17, 23, 23], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (32 [40, 48, 58] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Dec row – K5 [5, 6, 8], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K11 [13, 19, 19], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (28 [34, 42, 50] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Dec row – K4 [4, 5, 6], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K9 [9, 15, 15], (K2tog, K1) 2 [3, 3, 4] times, K to end. (24 [28, 36, 42] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 rows.

10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Dec row – K4, (K2tog, K1) [3, 4] times, K11, (K2tog, K1) [3, 4] times, K to end. ([30, 34] sts). Work in stocking st for 3 rows.

All sizes: Break yarn, thread through all sts and draw up tightly. Fasten off securely.

Tail

With 3mm needles and **SNOW**, cast on 12 [12, 14, 16] sts and starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 4 rows.

Inc row – K1 [1, 0, 2], (inc in next st, K2 [2, 3, 3]) 3 times, inc in next st, K1. (16 [16, 18, 20] sts). Starting with a P row, work in

stocking st for 3 rows.

Inc row – K3 [3, 2, 4], (inc in next st, K2 [2, 3, 3]) 3 times, inc in next st, K3. (20 [20, 22, 24] sts).

6-9 yrs, 10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Inc row – K [5, 4, 6], (inc in next st, K [2, 3, 3]) 3 times, inc in next st, K5. ([24, 26, 28] sts).

All sizes: Work 13 [13, 17, 19] rows.

Dec row – (K2tog) 10 [12, 13, 14] times. (10 [12, 13, 14] sts).

Next row – P.

Break yarn, thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off.

Eyes (make 2)

With 3mm needles and **SNOW**, cast on 10 [12, 14, 16] sts.

Starting with a P [P, K, K] row, work in stocking st for 3 [3, 4, 4] rows.

Next row – (K2tog) 5 [6, 7, 8] times.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through all sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Right side is knit side. Join side seam using rem yarn.

Legs (make 2)

With 3mm needles and **BLACK**, cast on 12 [14, 14, 16] sts.

Starting with a K row, work in stocking st until Leg meas 21 [24, 27, 30] cm (or adjust to suit), ending after a P row.

Shape hoof

Inc row – (Inc in next st, K1) 6 [7, 7, 8] times. (18 [21, 21, 24] sts). Work 3 rows.

Inc row – (Inc in next st, K2) 6 [7, 7, 8] times. (24 [28, 28, 32] sts).

Next row – P.

Next 3 rows – K.

Next row – (P2tog) 12 [14, 14, 16] times. (12 [14, 14, 16] sts).

Next row – K.

Next row – (P2tog) 6 [7, 7, 8] times. (6 [7, 7, 8] sts).

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through all sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

MAKE UP

Body: Using the long end at cast-on edge, work a gathering st all around opening at neck. Draw up tightly and fasten off. Fold Body in half lengthways and join seam. Place seam to centre back.

Head: Join side edges of Head and Head Top. Flatten, with seam to centre back and join base seam. Stuff lightly, then draw up thread at Head Top and fasten off securely.

Work a gathering stitch all round yarn colour change between Head Top and Head, draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Attach Head to Head end of Body.

Eyes: Work a gathering stitch all round cast-off edge, stuff lightly then draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Position the Eyes towards the top of the Head and sew in place securely.

Pupils: Using **BLACK**, work a circle of 6 [6, 7, 8] small Chain Stitches.

Ears: Fold in half lengthways. Join side seam and over-sew cast-off sts. Sew Ears to Sides of Head, slightly towards the Back of the Head and in line with the Eyes.

Tail: Join seam and place to centre back. Stuff Tail and sew up opening across top. Attach to Tail end of Body.***

Legs: Join back seam of Legs, stuffing evenly as you work up to the top. Sew across opening. Sew Legs to underneath of Body, positioned slightly outside each side of Tail.

Fastening loop: With 3mm needles and **SNOW**, cast on 5 sts and work in garter st (K every row) for 8 [8, 9, 10] cm. Cast off. Mark position of Fastening on underside of Head with pins, first pin to come 3 [4, 4, 5] cm up from lower edge with the second

pin 6 [6, 7, 8] cm up from first pin. Sew each end of Fastening loop securely to underside of Head at pins. Thread Legs through Fastening loop to complete.

MITTS

Right Mitt (starting at Cuff)

With 3.25mm needles and **SNOW, cast on 27 [33, 37, 41] sts.

Rib row 1 – P1, *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Rib row 2 – K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end. These 2 rows form rib patt.

Cont in patt for a further 8 [8, 10, 10] rows.

Change to 4 mm needles and starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 11 [13, 15, 15] rows, thus ending with purl side facing for next row, inc 1 st at centre of last row. (28 [34, 38, 42] sts).

Break **SNOW**, join in **BLACK** and starting with a K row, work in stocking st for 2 [4, 6, 6] rows.**

Shape Thumb Gusset

Next row – K15 [18, 20, 22], M1, K1, M1, K12 [15, 17, 19]. (30 [36, 40, 44] sts).

Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Next row – K15 [18, 20, 22], M1, K3, M1, K12 [15, 17, 19]. (32 [38, 42, 46] sts).

Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Next row – K15 [18, 20, 22], M1, K5, M1, K12 [15, 17, 19]. (34 [40, 44, 48] sts).

Cont thus, inc 1 st at each side of thumb as set on every foll 4th row until there are 36 [42, 48, 52] sts. Work 1 [3, 1, 1] rows.

Thumb

Next row – K25 [28, 32, 34], turn.

Next row – P11 [11, 13, 13], cast on 3 sts, turn. (14 [14, 16, 16] sts). Work 8 [10, 12, 14] rows.

Shape top

Dec row – K2 [2, 1, 1], *K2tog, K1; rep from * to end. (10 [10, 11, 11] sts).

Next row – P.

Dec row – K1 [1, 2, 2], *K2tog, K1; rep from * to end. (7 [7, 8, 8] sts). Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through loops, draw up tightly and fasten off. Join Thumb seam.

With right side facing, return to sts at base of thumb. Rejoin **BLACK** to rem sts, pick up and knit 3 sts from the previous cast-on sts at base of thumb, K to end. (28 [34, 38, 42] sts).***

***Work 13 [15, 19, 23] rows (or adjust to suit) across all sts.

Shape top

Next row – (K1, sL1K, K1, pssso, K8 [11, 13, 15], K2tog, K1) twice. (24 [30, 34, 38] sts).

Next row – P.

Next row – (K1, sL1K, K1, pssso, K6 [9, 11, 13], K2tog, K1) twice. (20 [26, 30, 34] sts).

Next row – P.

Next row – (K1, sL1K, K1, pssso, K4 [7, 9, 11], K2tog, K1) twice. (16 [22, 26, 30] sts).

Next row – P.

6-9 yrs, 10-14 yrs and 15+ sizes only: Next row – (K1, sL1K, K1, pssso, K [5, 7, 9], K2tog, K1) twice. ([18, 22, 26] sts).

Next row – P.

All sizes: Cast off rem sts. Join top and side seam, using appropriate colour. Fold Cuff in half to **WS** so that the rib is invisible and over-sew loosely in place to last row of **SNOW**.

Left Mitt

Work as Right Mitt from ** to **.

*****Shape Thumb Gusset**

Next row – K12 [15, 17, 19], M1, K1, M1, K15 [18, 20, 22].

(30 [36, 40, 44] sts).

Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Next row – K12 [15, 17, 19], M1, K3, M1, K15 [18, 20, 22].

(32 [38, 42, 46] sts).

Starting with a P row, work in stocking st for 3 rows.

Next row – K12 [15, 17, 19], M1, K5, M1, K15 [18, 20, 22]. (34

[40, 44, 48] sts).

Cont thus, inc 1 st at each side of thumb as set on every foll 4th

row until there are 36 [42, 48, 52] sts. Work 1 [3, 1, 1] rows.

Thumb

Next row – K22 [25, 29, 31], turn, cast on 3 sts.

Next row – P across 3 cast-on sts, P11 [11, 13, 13]. (14 [14, 16, 16] sts).

Complete as Thumb for Right Mitt.

With right side facing, rejoin **BLACK** to rem sts, pick up and knit 3 sts from base of thumb, K to end. (28 [34, 38, 42] sts).***

Work as Right Mitt from **** to end.

Eyes (make 4)

Work as Eyes for Scarf and sew each pair to Front of Mitts, just below the Cuff.

VERSION 2

SCARF WITHOUT LEGS

Head, Head Top, Ears, Tail and Eyes

Work as for Version 1 Scarf with Legs.

Body

Work as Version 1 Body of Scarf with Legs to **.

All sizes: Work in stocking st until Body meas 58 [63, 70, 78] cm from cast-on edge without stretching (or adjust to suit), ending with a P row.

Work as Body of Scarf with Legs from *** to end.

MAKE UP

Work as Make Up of Scarf with Legs to ****.

Fastening Loop

With 3mm needles and **BLACK**, cast on 5 sts and work in garter st for 8 [8, 9, 10] cm. Cast off.

Mark position of Fastening on Body with pins, first pin to come 4cm up from base of Body with the second pin 7 [7, 8, 9] cm up from first pin. Sew each end of Fastening loop securely to underside of Body at pins.
