

Design S10213 is a variation of Maylin Tan's "Wingspan" to illustrate the mix&knit concept. The mix&knit shawl consists of 10 color segments which use different yarns and colors from the mix&knit collection.

SIZE

Length: approx. 142 cm Width: approx. 30 cm

The fan shape of the shawl is created with short-row

shaping.

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania, 50 g ball

Col 00426 (fox), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Corsica, 50 g ball Col 00086 (passion color), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Catania Denim, 50 g ball

Col 00147 (mauve), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Summer Ombré, 50 g ball

Col 00081 (plum dégradé), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Catania Flammé, 50 g ball

Col 00254 (taupe dégradé), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Catania, 50 g ball

Col 00423 (vintage), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Catania Flammé, 50 g ball

Col 00423 (vintage flammé), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Corsica, 50 g ball

Col 00080 (mood color), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Catania Denim, 50 g ball

Col 00110 (cinnamon), 1 ball

Schachenmayr Summer Ombré, 50 g ball

Col 00080 (sand dégradé), 1 ball

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your proiect.

Size 4.5 mm circular needle, 80 cm long Crochet hook Blunt yarn needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

In garter stitch:

20 sts and 36 rows = $10 \text{ cm} \times 10 \text{ cm}$

Note: Yarns are worked at a looser gauge than specified

on ball bands to create a drapey fabric.

THE BASICS

Garter stitch:

K every row.

Short rows with 'double st':

Turn work after having worked the number of sts indicated in pattern. Slip 1 st as if to purl with yarn in front of work, bring yarn to back of work over top of the needle and pull it very tightly; this will rotate the stitch to the back of the needle so that both 'legs' of the stitch from the row below are now on the needle.

On foll rows, work to 'double st' [= 2 loops on needle], insert right needle into both loops and knit as you would normally.

COLOR SEGMENTS

Shawl is knitted in one piece consisting of 10 segments in the following yarns and colors:

Color 1 = fox (Catania)

Color 2 = passion color (Corsica)

Color 3 = mauve (Catania Denim)

Color 4 = plum dégradé (Summer Ombré)

Color 5 = taupe flammé (Catania Flammé)

Color 6 = vintage (Catania)

Color 7 = vintage flammé (Catania Flammé)

Color 8 = mood color (Corsica)

Color 9 = cinnamon (Catania Denim)

Color 10 = sand dégradé (Summer Ombré)





INSTRUCTIONS

With color 1 cast on 95 sts.

Work in garter st for 2 rows.

- ** Next WS row: Knit to last 4 sts, turn, work double st, knit to end of RS row.
- * Next WS row: Knit to 2 sts before double st, turn, work double st, knit to end of RS row. Rep from * 28 times more. Knit last 4 sts, turn, work double st, knit last 3 sts.

Next WS row: Knit across all sts, knit the 2 loops of each double st tog.

Next RS row: Bind off first 17 sts knitwise, knit to end of row. Cut yarn.

With next color, cast on 17 sts at end of RS row = 95 sts. Repeat from ** 8 times more.

Last segment: Work as previous segments until 4 sts remain. Next row: Bind off all sts knitwise.

FINISHING

Pin shawl to measurements and block.

Carefully weave in all ends.

Make and attach fringe: For each fringe, cut 15 strands of yarn, each strand 30 cm long. Insert crochet hook into fabric from WS, fold 15 strands of yarn in half to form a loop, draw loop through fabric, then draw yarn ends through loop and tighten. Attach 1 fringe in tip of each segment, matching color of fringe to color of segment. Trim fringe to 13 cm.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side
