Crochet Beginner 

SIZES

Eggs: Approx. 7 cm tall

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania, 50 g ball

Color 00106 (white)	ball	1
Color 00410 (coral)	ball	1
Color 00263 (soft apricot)	ball	1
Color 00399 (hollyhock)	ball	1
Color 00392 (yellow-green)	ball	1
Color 00385 (mint)	ball	1
or small amount of each color		

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project.

NEEDLES AND TOOLS

Size 3 mm crochet hook
5 wooden craft sticks, approx. 20 cm long
50 cm x 6 mm satin band in orange, spring green and white
[by Rayher Hobby, item 51509, col 34, 85 and 02].
Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Single crochet in rnds: 6 rnds = 5 cm in diameter.

Take time to check your gauge. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger hook. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller hook.

THE BASICS

Main pattern: Work sc in a continuous spiral without working a chain at beg of rnd or a slip st at end of rnd. Make sure to place beg of rnd marker.

Increasing 1 stitch: Work 2 sc in 1 sc on rnd below.

Chart B:

Beg rnds with ch1 (count as 1 sc), join rnds with a sl st in first ch. Work rnds 1 – 3 once.

INSTRUCTIONS

For each egg, crochet 2 pieces according to chart B.

Version A: Work rnd 1 with col 1, rnds 2 and 3 with col 2, rnd 4 with col 3 (see eggs with coral and hollyhook center).

Version B: Work rnd 1 with col 1, rnd 2 with color 2, rnds 3 and 4 with col 3 (see egg with mint center).

When changing colors, join rnds with new color.

Ch9 + ch1. Working first sc in 2nd ch from hook, work rnd 1 of chart.

Work rnds 2 and 3 of chart, working increases as shown, end with 1 sc in sl st on rnd below.

Work 1 more rnd of sc, end with 1 sc in sl st on rnd below.

Cut yarn and fasten off.

Thread tapestry needle with yarn tail. Insert tapestry needle from front to back in first st at beg of rnd, pull yarn through.

Insert tapestry needle from the top in last st, pull yarn through and carefully weave in end.

FINISHING

With wrong sides facing and right sides facing out, join the 2 halves of each egg with running stitches in desired color.

Cover 1 stitch with each running stitch between rnds 3 and 4. Leave a small opening at bottom of egg.

Insert wooden stick into opening, secure opening with a few stitches.

Tie satin band with a bow to wooden stick.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
dc = double crochet
rnd(s) = round(s)
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch

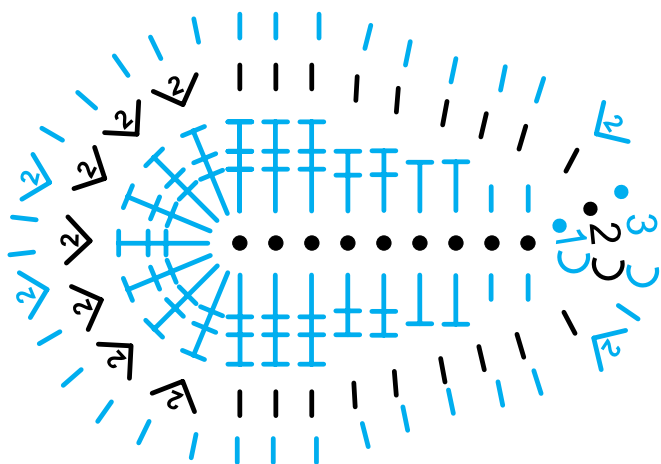


Chart key

- T = 1 half double crochet [hdc]
- ⊥ = 1 double crochet [dc]
- ⊥⊥ = 1 treble crochet [trc]
- ∪ = 1 slip stitch [sl st]
- △ = 1 picot
- ∨ = 2 sc in same st
