Instructions are for smallest size with larger sizes in parentheses. If there is only one number, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: Schachenmayr Catania, 300 (300, 350, 350) g color #00385 mint. Knitting needles, one pair each sizes US 4 and 6 (3.5 and 4mm). From Dill 5 buttons (Art. 231433, color #20 turquoise, 15 mm). One wool needle for seaming.

Border Pattern: Knit 1, purl 1 Ribbing.

Texture Pattern: Both RS and WS rows are shown. The stitches are shown as they appear on the right side. Read the RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. Repeat rows 1 to 8.

Gauge: With US 6 (4mm) needles in Texture Pat: 24 sts and 32 rows = 4 x 4"/10 x 10 cm.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: With US 4 (3.5mm) needles, cast on 81 (89, 95, 103) sts and work 10 rows = approx. 1¼"/3 cm in Border Pattern. Then purl 1 row on WS. Change to US 6 (4 mm) needles and work in Texture Pattern, working the first row on RS as follows: K1 (selvage st), work 0 (1, 1, 2) sts before the repeat, work the 6-st rep 13 (14, 15, 16) times, work 1 (2, 2, 3) sts after the repeat, k1 (selvage st).

Work in pats as established until piece measures 10 (11, 12¼, 13½)"/25 (28, 31, 34) cm above border. For the armhole shaping, bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, dec 1 st each side every 2nd row 5 times = 63 (71, 77, 85) sts.

Work even until piece measures 15¾ (17½, 19, 20½)"/40 (44, 48, 52) cm from beg. For the neck shaping, bind off the center 25 (29, 31, 33) sts and working both sides at once, bind off from each neck edge 2 sts once and 1 st once.

When piece measures 16½ (18, 19½, 21¼)"/42 (46, 50, 54) cm from beg, bind off remaining 16 (18, 20, 23) sts each side for shoulders.

Left Front: With US 4 (3.5mm) needles, cast on 41 (45, 47, 51) sts and work 10 rows = approx. 1¼"/3 cm in Border Pattern. Purl 1 row on WS. Change to US 6 (4 mm) needles and work in Texture Pattern as follows: K1 (selvage st), work 0 (1, 1, 2) sts before the repeat, work the 6-st rep 6 (7, 7, 7) times, work 3 sts after rep (0, 2 sts after rep, first 5 sts of rep), k1 (selvage st). Work in pats as established until piece measures 10 (11, 12¼, 13½)"/25 (28, 31, 34) cm

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above border. For the armhole shaping, bind off at beg of RS rows 4 sts once, dec 1 st each side every 2nd row 5 times = 32 (36, 38, 42) sts.

Work even until piece measures 13 (14½, 16, 17¾)"/33 (37, 41, 45) cm above border. For the neck shaping, bind off from neck edge (beg of WS rows) 6 (8, 8, 9) sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and dec 1 st every 2nd row 5 times.

When piece measures 16½ (18, 19½, 21¼)"/42 (46, 50, 54) cm from beg, bind off remaining 16 (18, 20, 23) sts for shoulder.

Work right front to correspond, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves: With US 4 (3.5mm) needles, cast on 41 (43, 45, 47) sts and work 10 rows = approx. 1¼"/3 cm in Border Pattern. Purl 1 row on WS. Change to US 6 (4 mm) and work in Texture Pattern as follows: K1 (selvage st), work 1 (2, 0, 1) sts before the repeat, work 6-st rep 6 (6, 7, 7) times, work 2 (3, 1, 2) sts after the repeat, k1 (selvage st).

For the side shaping, inc 1 st each side every 6th (6th, 8th, 8th) row 12 (15, 2, 7) times and every 4th (4th, 6th, 6th) row 2 (1, 15, 11) times = 69 (75, 79, 83) sts. Work the inc sts into pat.

Work even until piece measures 10½ (12¼, 13¾, 15¾)"/27 (31, 35, 40) cm above border. For the cap shaping, bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 10 (10, 14, 14) rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 21 (27, 23, 27) sts.

Total length = 14 (15¾, 17¾, 19½)"/36 (40, 45, 50) cm.

Finishing: Block pieces to measurements.

Sew shoulder seams.

For the neckband, with RS facing and US 4 (3.5 mm) needles, pick up 75 (83, 85, 89) sts around neck edge as follows: 22 (24, 24, 25) sts along right front neck, 31 (35, 37, 39) sts along back neck and 22 (24, 24, 25) sts along left front neck. Knit next row on WS, then work 6 rows = approx. ¾"/2 cm in Border Pattern. Bind off all sts on next row.

For the button band, with RS facing and US 4 (3.5 mm) needles, beg at first neck bind off, pick up 87 (97, 107, 117) sts along straight edge of left front. Knit next row on WS, then work 6 rows = approx. ¾"/2 cm in Border Pattern. Bind off all sts on next row.

For the buttonhole band, with RS facing and US 4 (3.5mm) needles, beg at lower right front edge, pick up 87 (97, 107, 117) sts along straight edge of left front. Knit next row on WS, then work 3 rows in Border Pattern. Work 5 buttonholes on next RS row as follows: Work 5 (6, 5, 6) sts, ★ yarn over, k2 sts together, work 17 (19, 22, 24) sts; rep from ★ 3 times more, yarn over, k2 sts together, work last 4 (5, 4, 5) sts. On the next WS row, work in Border Pattern, working k1 or p1 into yo to keep to pattern. Work 2 more rows in pattern, then bind off.

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.
