BASKET LINING | CROCHET



### **MATERIALS**

Lily<sup>®</sup> Sugar'n Cream<sup>®</sup> Scents (2 oz/56.7 g; 95 yds/86 m) Chamomile (24010) 615 m/673 yds or 6 balls

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## **MEASUREMENTS**

To fit round basket 18" [45.5 cm] diameter x 16" [40.5 cm] tall.

# **GAUGE**

12 sc and 13 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Notes:** Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as st throughout.

Join all rnds with sl st in first st.

Beg at bottom, ch 5. Join with sl st to form a rina.

**1st rnd:** Ch 2. 8 hdc in ring. Join. 8 hdc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 16 hdc.

hdc. Rep from \* around. Join.

24 hdc.

4th rnd: Ch 2. \*2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. Rep from \* around. Join. 32 hdc. **5th rnd**: Ch 2. \*2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from \* around. Join. 40 hdc. Cont inc 8 sts every rnd evenly spaced (as before) until there are 168 hdc (approx 18" [45.5 cm] diameter).

**Next rnd:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). Working in front loops only, 1 dc in each hdc around. Join. Place marker.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. Working in both loops, 1 sc in each dc around. Join.

**Next rnd:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc around. Join.

Rep last 2 rnds until work from marker measures 16" [40.5 cm], ending with sc rnd.

**Next rnd:** (Openings for handles). Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next sc. Ch 25. Miss next 24 sc. 1 dc in each of next 60 sc. Ch 25. Miss next 24 sc. 1 dc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st (working 1 sc in each ch) around. 170 sc. Join.

Proceed in Lace Pat as follows:

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. \*Ch 1. Miss next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Miss next 3 sc. (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in next sc – shell made. Miss next 3 sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around, ending with 1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Miss last sc. Join.

**2nd rnd:** SI st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in same sp. \*Ch 3. 1 sc in top of next Shell. Ch 3. (1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc) in next ch-1 sp - v-st made. Rep from \* around. Join to 2nd ch of ch 3.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 2. \*2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next **3rd rnd:** SI st in first ch-1 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in same sp. \*1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Shell in next V-st. Rep from \* around, ending with 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Join to top of ch 3.

> 4th rnd: SI st in each of next 2 dc and ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp. \*Ch 3. V-st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 3. 1 sc in top of next Shell. Rep from \* around. Join to first sc.

> **5th rnd:** SI st back in last ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp. \*Ch 1. Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Shell in next V-st. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* around, ending with Shell in last V-st. Join to first sc.

> Rep 2nd to 5th rnds for 4" [10 cm], ending with 3rd or 5th rnd. Fasten off.

> **Ties** (make 8). Ch 15. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Fasten off. Sew 2 ties at each side of openings (see photo).
