



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENT

Approx 4" [10 cm] in diameter.

GAUGE

21 sts and 27 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Warm Brown (01130) **1 ball**

Contrast B Jute (00082) **1 ball**

Contrast C Rose Pink (00046) **1 ball**

Contrast D Robin's Egg (01215) **1 ball**

Contrast E Soft Ecru (01004) **1 ball**

Note: 1 Donut requires 18 yds/17 m of Color 1 and 18 yds/17 m of Color 2.

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stuffing. **Optional:** Assorted colored beads for 'sprinkles'!

ABBREVIATIONS:

Alt = Alternate

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop



P = Purl

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Each Donut uses 2 different shades. Choose A or B for Color 1 and C, D or E for Color 2.

With Color 1, cast on 18 sts.

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd and alt rows: Purl.

3rd row: With A, K2. *M1. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 26 sts.

5th row: K2. *M1. K3. Rep from * to end of row. 34 sts.

7th row: K2. *M1. K4. Rep from * to end of row. 42 sts.

9th row: K2. *M1. K5. Rep from * to end of row. 50 sts.

11th row: K2. *M1. K6. Rep from * to end of row. 58 sts.

13th row: K2. *M1. K7. Rep from * to end of row. 66 sts.

14th row: Purl. Break Color 1.

With Color 2, proceed as follows:

1st row: (WS). Purl.

2nd and 3rd rows: Knit.

4th and alt rows: Purl.

5th row: K2. *K2tog. K6. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. 58 sts.

7th row: K2. *K2tog. K5. Rep from * to end of row. 50 sts.

9th row: K2. *K2tog. K4. Rep from * to end of row. 42 sts.

11th row: K2. *K2tog. K3. Rep from * to end of row. 34 sts.

13th row: K2. *K2tog. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 26 sts.

15th row: K2. *K2tog. K1. Rep from * to end of row. 18 sts.

16th and 17th rows: Knit. Cast off.

Finishing: Sew cast on and cast off edges tog to form tube, stuffing as you go. Sew open ends tog.

Optional: Sew beads to Donut for 'sprinkles'.
