#### MATERIALS

Lily <sup>®</sup> Sugar'n Cream <sup>®</sup> (2.5 oz/70.9 g;	120 yds/109 m)
Main Color (MC) Soft Ecru (01004)	1 ball (14 m/15 yds)
Contrast A Red (00095)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast B Hot Orange (01628)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast C Yellow (00010)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast D Sunshine (00073)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast E Hot Green (01712)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast F Mod Green (01223)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast G Hot Blue (01742)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast H Hot Purple (01317)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Contrast I Grape (00071)	1 ball (12 m/13 yds)
Note: 1 ball makes approx 9 Bulbs.	

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stuffing. Narrow ribbon.

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### **MEASUREMENT**

Each bulb is approx 3" [7.5 cm] tall.

# GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Bulb (Front and Back make alike). With color of choice, ch 2. **1st row:** (RS). 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd and alt rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

sc. 2 sc

in last sc. Turn. 5 sc.

5th and 7th rows: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 9 sc at end of last row.

8th to 10th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

11th and 12th rows: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. 5 sts at end of 12th row. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Sew sides of Front and Back, leaving top open. Stuff lightly.

Bulb Top: 1st row: Join MC with sl st to first st at top right corner. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, 1 long sc in first st 2 rows below. (1 sc in next sc. 1 long sc in next st 2 rows below) twice. Turn. 5 sc. 2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

Cord: With MC, ch 110. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

Cut ribbon into 4" [10 cm] long pieces. 3rd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next Attach ribbon to each Bulb Top. Tie ribbons to Cord, spacing evenly as shown in picture.

## **ABBREVIATIONS:**

**Alt** = Alternate(ing) **Approx** = Approximately Ch = Chain(s)**RS** = Right side **Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop St(s) = Stitch(es) **Yoh** = Yarn over hook in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook. **SI st** = Slip stitch
