



LILY® SUGAR'N CREAM® LADYBUG DISHCLOTH (TO CROCHET)

MEASUREMENT

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] diameter, excluding Head and Legs.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar 'n Cream® (70.9 g/2.5 oz; 109 m/120 yds)

 Main Color (MC) Red (00095)
 (65 m/72 yds) or 1 ball

 Contrast A Black (00002)
 (30 m/35 yds) or 1 ball

Size 5 mm (U.S. H or 8) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 stitch markers.

GAUGE

13 hdc and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st.

With MC, ch 3 (See Diagram 1 on page 2).

1st rnd: 10 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first hdc. 10 hdc. 2nd rnd: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 20 hdc. 3rd rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 30 hdc.

4th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 40 hdc.

5th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 50 hdc.

6th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 60 hdc.

7th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sI st to first hdc. 70 hdc.

8th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 80 hdc.

9th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. Rep from * around. Join A with sI st to first hdc. 90 hdc. Fasten off.

Place markers on 18th, 34th, 56th and 72nd hdc of last rnd for Legs.

Head: With A, ch 1. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.

**1st row: 5 sc in same sp as last sl st. Miss next hdc of 9th rnd. Sl st in next hdc. Ch 1. Sl st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.

2nd row: 2 sc in each of next 5 sc. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Ch 1. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.

3rd row: 1 sc in first sc. (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 4 times. 1 sc in next sc. Sl st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Ch 1. Sl st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.**

4th row: 1 sc in first sc. (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc) 4 times. 1 sc in next sc. Sl st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Ch 1. Sl st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.

5th row: 1 sc in first sc. (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc) 4 times. 1 sc in next sc. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Ch 1. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn. **6th row:** 1 sc in first sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Ch 9. 3 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. SI st in each of next 5 ch — antennae made. 1 sc in next sc. (1 sc. Antennae. 1 sc) in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 5 sc. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Fasten off.

Legs: With RS of Body facing, join A with sI st to next marked hdc. Ch 1. SI st in next hdc of 9th rnd. Turn.

Work from ** to ** as given for Head. Fasten off.


Dots: (make 6).

With A, ch 3 (See Diagram 2 on page 2).


10 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Join with sI st to first hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long end to sew on Dot.

Sew Dots to Body, as shown in picture.

With A, work chain st embroidery across Body as shown in diagram.

= slip st (sl st)

= single crochet (sc)

= half double crochet (hdc)

* = marker
