



LILY® SUGAR'N CREAM®
PENCIL HOLDER (TO CROCHET)

MEASUREMENT

Approx 7" [18 cm] long, excluding tie.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (**Solids:** 70.9 g/2.5 oz; 109 m/120 yds;

Ombre: 56.7 g/2 oz; 86 m/95 yds)

Hippi (02122) **1 ball**

or

Hot Pink (01740) **1 ball**

or

Mod Green (01223) 1 ball

Note: 1 Solid ball will make 3 Pencil Holders. 1 Ombre ball will make 2

Pencil Holders.

Size 4 mm (U.S. G or 6) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 1 button.

GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

Approx = ApproximatelySI st = Slip stitchBeg = Begin(ing)St(s) = Stitch(es)Ch(s) = Chain(s)Tog = TogetherRem = RemainingWS = Wrong sideRnd(s) = Round(s)Yoh = Yarn over hook

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 5.

1st row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 4 sc.

2nd to 5th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.

Beg working in rnds: 1st rnd: Ch 1. Working in front loops only, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Turn. Working in rem loops, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 8 sc.

2nd to 21st rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Beg working in rows: 1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

and row Ch 1 1 se in each se

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc across. Turn. 4 sc. **3rd row:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.


4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew button to bottom of Pencil Holder as shown in picture.

Twisted Cord: Cut 2 strands of yarn 75" [190.5 cm] long. With both strands tog, hold one end and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Sew to top of pencil holder as shown in picture.



Pom-pom: Wind yarn around 3 fingers approx 50 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Attach to cord end.
