Contrast C Warm Brown (01130)
Size U.S. F/5 ( 3.75 mm )) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 8" [20.5 cm ] wide.

## GAUGE

16 sc and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Head
With A, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 18 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as last sl st. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sc .1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sc .
5th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 30 sc.
6th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as last sl st. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 4 sc . 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 4 sc .1 sc in each of last 4 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 36 sc .

7th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last 5 sc .1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc . 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 42 sc .
8th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in next sc. ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc$) 3$ times. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . ( 2 hdc in next sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc$) 5$ times. 2 hdc in last sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 52 sts.
9th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc$) 3$ times. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc .1 hdc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. ( 1 dc in next st. 2 dc in next st) 7 times. 2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. 65 sts.
10th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc$) 3$ times. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . 1 hdc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. ( 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 dc in next st) 7 times. 2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. 78 sts.
11th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc$) 3$ times. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc .1 hdc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. ( 1 dc in each of

REINDEER DISHCLOTH | CROCHET
next 2 sts. 2 dc in next st) 8 times. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 sc in each of last 4 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. 92 sts.
12th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st .1 sc in each of next 5 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc .1 sc in each of next 10 sc$) 3$ times. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc .1 hdc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. ( 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 2 dc in next st) 8 times. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 sc in each of last 4 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. 112 sts.
13th rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right, instead of from right to left as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Ears (make 2)
With A, ch 5 .
1st rnd: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch .3 sc in last ch. Working into opposite side of ch, 1 sc in each of next 2 ch .2 sc in last ch. Join with sl st to first sc. 10 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc .3 sc in last sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 14 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc .2 hdc in each of next 3 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 19 sts.

4th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc .2 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Antlers (make 2)
With C, ch 9.
1st row: Working into horizontal 'bump' at back of ch, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 3 ch .1 sc in each of next 4 ch . Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1 . SI st in each of first 5 sts. Ch 8. Working into horizontal 'bump' at back of ch, 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 6 ch .1 sc in each of next 5 sl sts. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1 . SI st in each of first 7 sts. Ch 8. Working into horizontal 'bump' at back of ch, 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 6 ch .1 sc in each of next 7 sl sts. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1 . SI st in each of first 5 sts. Ch 6. Working into horizontal 'bump' at back of ch, 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 4 ch .1 sc in each of next 5 sl sts. Sl st in next sc. Fasten off.

## Nose

With B, ch 4.
1st rnd: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. 3 sc in last ch. Working into opposite side of ch, 1 sc in next ch. 2 sc in last ch. Join with sl st to first sc. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st .1 sc in each of next 2 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .3 sc in last sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 1 hdc in next sc. (2 dc in next sc) twice. 1 hdc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc .1 sc in last sc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew Nose and Ears in position as shown in picture. Sew Antlers in position as shown in picture, noting 1 Antler will be flipped for mirror image effect. With C, embroider eyes with satin stitch and mouth with chain stitch.
