RIPPLE STITCH DISHCLOTH | KNIT





MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 10" [20.5 x 25.5 cm].

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 50 sts.

1st to 5th rows: yf. SI1P. yb. Knit to

end of row.

6th row: (RS). yf. Sl1P. yb. K2.

*K2tog. K2. M1. K3. M1. K2. ssk. Rep

from * to last 3 sts. K3.

7th row: yf. SI1P. yb. K2. Purl to

last 3 sts. K3.

8th to 11th rows: As 6th and 7th

rows twice more. **12th row:** As 6th row.

Rep last 12 rows 3 times more.

Next 5 rows: yf. SI1P. yb. Knit to

end of row.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

MATERIALS

Lily[®] **Sugar'n Cream**[®] (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Robin's Egg (01215)

1 ball or 33 yds/30 m

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

RS = Right side SI1P = Slip next stitch purl-

wise

Rep = Repeat

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop







Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together **St(s)** = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yb = Bring yarn to back of work

Yf = Bring yarn to front of work

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
