Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more, you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

Finishing

Once your garment is completed it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Equipment

One set 3.25mm (UK10/US3) DPNs or one 3.25mm (UK10/US3) circular needle 40cm in length for Hat

One set 3.75mm (UK9/US5) DPNs or one 3.75mm (UK9/US5) circular needle 23cm in length for Mittens

One set 4mm (UK8/US6) DPNs or one 4mm (UK8/US6) circular needle 40cm in length for Hat and Scarf

Stitch holders and stitch markers

Tension

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm measured over stocking stitch, 23 sts and 26 rows measure over colourwork pattern, both using 4mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension.

23 sts and 32 rows to 10cm measured over stocking stitch, 24 sts and 28 rows measured over colourwork pattern, both on 3.75mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.

Special Abbreviations

M1r: Right leaning make 1 (by picking up loop between last and next stitch from back to front and knit into front of this loop).

M1l: Left leaning make 1 (by picking up loop between last and next stitch from front to back and knit into back of this loop).

Colourwork

When working in more than one colour, the colour not in use should be stranded loosely across back of work and woven in where necessary to retain elasticity of fabric.



Written Pattern

Rnd 1: Using B, Knit.

Rnd 2: * K1B, K1A, rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: Using A, Knit.

Rnd 4: * K1A, K1B, rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: Using B, Knit.

Rnd 6: Using A, Knit.

Rnd 7: As rnd 6.

Rnd 8: * K1A, K1B, K2A, rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: * K1B, K1A, rep from * to end.

Rnd 10: As rnd 8.

Rnds 11 and 12: As rnd 6.

Rnds 13 and 14: As rnds 8 and 9.

Rnd 15: Using B, Knit.

Rnd 16: * K1A, K1B, rep from * to end.

Rnd 17: Using A, Knit.

Rnd 18: As rnd 16.

Rnd 19: Using B, Knit.

Rnds 20 to 26: As rnds 6 to 12.

Rnds 27 to 31: As rnds 15 to 19.

Rnds 32 and 33: As rnds 9 and 10.

Rnds 34 to 40: As rnds 6 to 12.

Hat

Using 3.25mm circular needle or DPNs and A, cast on 120 sts.

Ensuring sts are not twisted, join to work in the round, **place beg of rnd marker**.

Rnd 1: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

This round sets rib.

Cont in rib until Hat measures 10cm from cast on edge.

Change to 4mm circular needle or DPNs and working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:

Using A, Knit 3 rnds.

Join in B, work rnds 15 to 38 as given on chart or written instructions working 4 st patt rep 30 times. (24 rnds of patt.)

Break off B, using A only.

Next rnd: (K10, K2tog) 10 times. 110 sts.

Cont in st-st until Hat measures 23cm from cast on edge.

Shape Crown

Next rnd: (K9, K2tog) 10 times. 100 sts.

Work 3 rnds.

Next rnd: (K8, K2tog) 10 times. 90 sts.

Work 2 rnds.

Next rnd: (K7, K2tog) 10 times. 80 sts.

Work 2 rnds.

Next rnd: (K6, K2tog) 10 times. 70 sts.

Work 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K5, K2tog) 10 times. 60 sts.

Work 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K4, K2tog) 10 times. 50 sts.

Work 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K3, K2tog) 10 times. 40 sts.

Next rnd: (K2tog) 20 times. 20 sts.

Break off yarn and thread through rem 20 sts, draw up and fasten off.

Scarf

Using 4mm circular needle or DPNs and A, cast on 94 sts.

Ensuring sts are not twisted, join to work in the round, **place beg of round marker.**

Rnd 1: (Wyib sl1, (K2, P2) 11 times, K2) twice.

Rnd 2: (K1, (K2, P2) 11 times, K2) twice.

These 2 rounds set rib and slip stitches for side edges.

Cont in rib until Scarf measures 8cm from cast on edge.

Next rnd: (Wyib sl1, (K14, K2tog) twice, K14) twice. 90 sts.

Join in B, working in st-st proceed as follows:

Next rnd: (K1A, work 4 st rep 11 times as set on rnd 1 of chart or written instructions) twice.

Next rnd: (Wyib sl1, work 4 st rep 11 times as set on rnd 2 of chart or written instructions) twice.

These 2 rnds set chart and slip stitches for side edges.

Beg with rnd 3 of chart or written instructions work 38 rnds more.

These 40 rnds set the pattern and are repeated.

Cont in patt until Scarf measures approximately 148cm from cast on edge, ending with rnd 5 of patt.

Break off B.

Using A only, work 8cm in rib.

Cast off in rib.

Mittens (both alike)

Using 3.75mm circular needle or DPNs and A, cast on 48 sts.

Ensuring sts are not twisted, join to work in the round, **place beg of rnd marker.**

Rnd 1: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

This round sets rib.

Cont in rib until Mitten measures 9cm from cast on edge.

Using A, Knit 1 rnd.

Join in B, working in st-st (throughout), work rnds 15 to 33 as given on chart or written instructions working 4 st patt rep 12 times.

Break off B.

Using A only (throughout) proceed as follows:

Shape Thumb Gusset

Rnd 1: K22, **place marker,** m1r, K4, m1l, **place marker,** K22. 50 sts.

Rnds 2–4: Knit slipping **markers.**

Rnd 5: K22, **sm,** m1r, K6, m1l, **sm,** K22. 52 sts.

Rnds 6–7: Knit slipping **markers.**

Cont to increase in this way working 2 sts more between **markers** in next and every foll 3rd rnd to 56 sts, then on every foll alt rnd to 62 sts.

Shape Hand Section

Next rnd: Patt 22, leave next 18 sts on a holder for thumb, **remove thumb markers,** cast on 4 sts, knit to end. 48 sts.

Work 22 rnds more without shaping.

Shape Top of Mitten

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K18, K2tog, K1) twice. 44 sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K16, K2tog, K1) twice. 40 sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K14, K2tog, K1) twice. 36 sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K12, K2tog, K1) twice.
32 sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K10, K2tog, K1) twice.
28 sts.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K8, K2tog, K1) twice.
24 sts.

Next rnd: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K6, K2tog, K1) twice.
20 sts.

Break off yarn leaving 15cm tail. With 10 sts on each needle, join top of mitten using kitchener stitch.

Thumb

With **RS** facing, using **3.75mm DPNs** and **A**, knit across 18 sts from holder, pick up 4 sts from cast on sts at beg of hand section. 22 sts.

If you are concerned about holes forming please feel free to pick up extra sts from cast on section and decrease to correct number of sts.

Work 17 rnds in st-st.

Next rnd: (K2tog) 11 times. 11 sts.

Next rnd: (K2tog) 5 times, K1. 6 sts.

Break off yarn and thread through rem 6 sts, draw up and fasten off.

Finishing

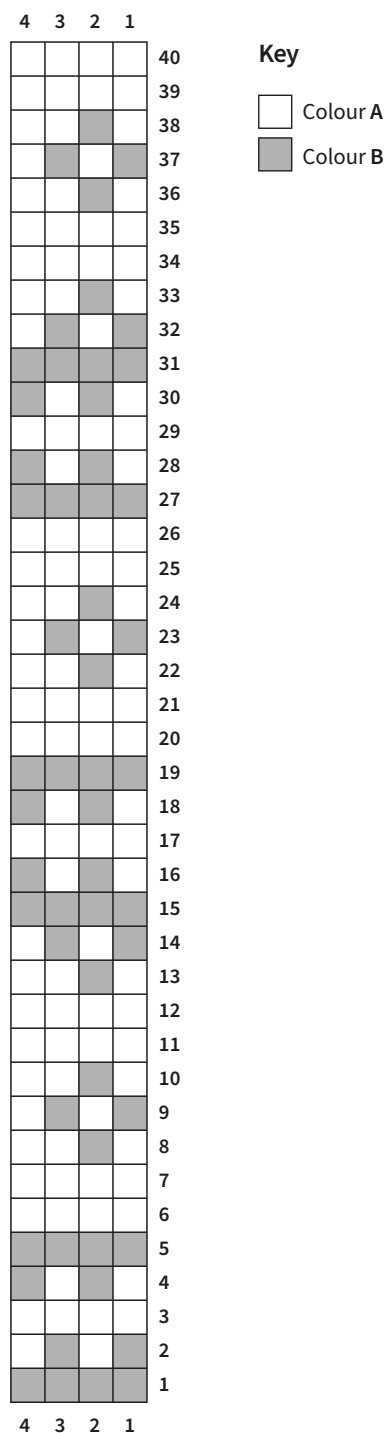
Sew in yarn ends closing any gaps around the thumbs. Fold back half of rib for turnback.

Pin Mittens out to size stated in the pattern and position end of rounds at the side seam so the thumb is positioned at the opposite side edge, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.



Chart

When working from chart you will read from right to left when working in rounds.



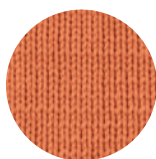
