# EVE FISHTAIL SCARF



## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>cm</b>	centimetres
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>g-st</b>	garter stitch (every row knit)
<b>g</b>	grammes
<b>K</b>	knit
<b>mm</b>	millimetres
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>P</b>	purl
<b>psso</b>	pass slipped stitch over
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl1</b>	slip 1 stitch knitwise
<b>ssk</b>	slip, slip, knit together as follows: slip each of next 2 sts knitwise (one by one) onto right needle, slide left-hand needle into the front loops of these stitches and knit them together
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tog</b>	together
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yon</b>	yarn over needle
<b>yfwd</b>	yarn forward
<b>yrn</b>	yarn round needle
<b>*</b>	repeat instructions that follow the single asterisk, as directed

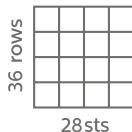

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

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## YARN

West Yorkshire Spinners Exquisite 4ply  
Bayswater (318) 1 x 100g

## MATERIALS

1 pair 3mm (US2/UK11) knitting needles  
1 pair 3.25mm (US3/UK10) knitting needles

## TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm measured over lace pattern on 3.25mm needles or size required to achieve stated tension. **It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**

### *Designer's notes:*

An elegant lace scarf designed with an eight-row pattern repeat, suitable for an adventurous beginner lace knitter. Perfect as an everyday accessory that can also be styled with an evening outfit for an extra touch of luxury and warmth.

## SCARF

**Using 3mm needles**, cast on 60 sts and knit 4 rows.

**Change to 3.25mm needles** and proceed as follows:-

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, p2 \* k7, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** K4, \* p7, k2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, p2 \* yon, ssk, k3, k2tog, yfwd, yrn, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 5:** K2, p2 \* k1, yfwd, ssk, k1, k2tog, yfwd, k1, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 7:** K2, p2 \* k2, yfwd, sl1, k2tog, pss0, yfwd, k2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 8:** K4, \* p7, k2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 1 to 8 set lace pattern with g-st borders.

Cont in patt until work measures approximately 141cm from cast on edge, ending with 8th row of patt.

(This should leave enough yarn to work 5 rows and cast off.)

**Change to 3mm needles** and knit 5 rows.

Cast off on **WS**.

## MAKING UP

Sew in loose ends and block to given measurements, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.
