General Information

Sizing

Instructions given are for the 1st size, with larger sizes in brackets. Where only one figure or instruction is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, rows or times are worked for this size. Work all directions inside brackets to the number of times stated.

Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more, you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting your garment.

Finishing





We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your garment.

When sewing in a semi set-in sleeve you will need to fold the sleeve in half, and matching the fold to the shoulder seam, sew in position easing into the armhole.

Once your garment is complete it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

B – Dicky Bird (1067) 2 [2:2:2:3:3:3] x 50g



C – Sunshine (1066) 1 [1:1:1:2:2:2] x 50g



D – Fire Engine (1065) 2 [2:2:2:3:3:3] x 50g



E – Fluffy Clouds (1063) 2 [2:2:3:3:3:4] x 50g

EQUIPMENT

One pair of 4mm (UK8/US6) knitting needles
 One pair of 3.75mm (UK9/US5) knitting needles
 One pair of 3.25mm (UK10/US3) knitting needles
 Stitch holders
 Stitch markers

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm (4in) measured over Fair Isle stocking stitch using 3.75mm knitting needles and 22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm measured over stocking stitch using 4mm knitting needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm change to finer needles. If there are more sts and rows to 10cm change to larger needles.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

2x2 Rib

Row 1 (RS): *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep row 1 and 2.

St-St: Stocking Stitch

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep row 1 and 2.

WORKING FROM A CHART

When working from chart you will read all right side rows from right to left and all wrong side rows from left to right.

FAIR ISLE TECHNIQUE

When working with two colours at once, the colour not in use should be stranded loosely across the colour being used.

Front

Using **3.25mm needles** and **A**, cast on 106 [118:130:142:154:166:178] sts and work 23 rows in 2x2 rib.

Row 24 (WS): Rib 2 [8:4:10:6:12:8], rib2tog, (rib 8, rib2tog) 10 [10:12:12:14:14:16] times, rib 2 [8:4:10:6:12:8]. 95 [107:117:129:139:151:161] sts.

Change to 3.75mm needles and proceed as follows:

Working rows 1 to 34 in st-st as set on **Chart A** working 60 st rep 1 [1:1:2:2:2:2] times and following sts marked for your size.

Rows 1 to 34 of **Chart A** sets patt.

Keeping continuity of **Chart A** as set (throughout) work 52 [52:52:52:64:64:64] rows more.

Place marker at each end of last row for armholes.**

Work 34 [36:42:48:50:56:60] rows more.

Shape Neck

Next row (RS): Patt 39 [45:49:54:59:64:68] sts, turn and leave rem 56 [62:68:75:80:87:93] sts on needle.

Work each side of neck separately.

Next row (WS): Neck Edge. P2tog, purl to end. 38 [44:48:53:58:63:67] sts.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 34 [40:44:49:54:59:63] sts.

Work 4 [8:8:8:10:10:12] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row. 32 [36:40:45:49:54:57] sts.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (RS) Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 [2:2:2:2:2:0] sts, (K2tog) 1 [1:1:1:1:1:0] times. 28 [31:35:39:42:47:50] sts.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 27 [30:34:38:41:46:49] sts.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 [0:0:0:0:0:0] sts, (K2tog) 1 [0:0:0:0:0:0] times.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 22 [25:29:32:34:39:41] sts.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:5:5:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to end.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 18 [20:23:26:27:31:33] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 14 [15:17:20:20:23:25] sts.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to end.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 9 [10:11:13:13:15:17] sts.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt, patt to end.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 4 [5:5:6:6:7:8] sts.

Cast off rem 4 [5:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt.

With **RS** facing, working on rem 56 [62:68:75:80:87:93] sts, slip first 17 [17:19:21:21:23:25] sts onto a holder for Neckband, rejoin yarn to rem 39 [45:49:54:59:64:68] sts and patt to end.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. **Neck Edge.**

38 [44:48:53:58:63:67] sts.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 34 [40:44:49:54:59:63] sts.

Work 4 [8:8:8:10:10:12] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row. 32 [36:40:45:49:54:57] sts.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (RS): (K2tog) 1 [1:1:1:1:1:0] times, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to end. 27 [30:34:38:41:46:49] sts.

Next row: (K2tog) 1 [0:0:0:0:0:0] times, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to end. 22 [25:29:32:34:39:41] sts.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:5:5:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to end. 18 [20:23:26:27:31:33] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 14 [15:17:20:20:23:25] sts.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to end. 9 [10:11:13:13:15:17] sts.

Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt, patt to end. 4 [5:5:6:6:7:8] sts.

Cast off rem 4 [5:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt.

Back

Work exactly as given for Front until ** is reached. 95 [107:117:129:139:151:161] sts.

Work 44 [50:56:62:66:72:78] rows more.

Shape Shoulders

Next row (RS): Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:4:5:6:6:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 87 [97:107:117:125:137:145] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 79 [87:97:105:111:123:129] sts.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:5:5:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 3 [4:5:5:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 71 [77:85:93:97:107:113] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 63 [67:73:81:83:91:97] sts.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:7] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 53 [57:61:67:69:75:81] sts.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row: Cast off 4 [4:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt, patt to last 2 sts, P2tog. 43 [47:49:53:55:59:63] sts.

Next row: Cast off 4 [5:5:6:6:7:8] sts in patt, patt 34 [36:38:40:42:44:46] sts.

Leave these 35 [37:39:41:43:45:47] sts on a holder for Neckband, cast off rem sts in patt.

Sleeves (both alike)

Using **3.25mm needles** and **A**, cast on 46 [50:54:58:62:66:66] sts and work 23 rows in 2x2 rib.

Row 24 (WS): Rib 6 [4:5:4:6:5:5], rib2tog, (rib 6 [8:5:6:6:7:7], rib2tog) 4 [4:6:6:6:6:6] times, rib 6 [4:5:4:6:5:5]. 41 [45:47:51:55:59:59] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and beg with a K row, working in st-st (throughout) work 89 [85:85:93:101:113:98] rows inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 6th [5th:4th:4th:4th:4th:3rd] row. 71 [79:89:97:105:115:123] sts. Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 44 [46:46:48:48:50:50]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 14 [15:17:19:21:23:24] sts at beg of next 4 rows.

15 [19:21:21:21:23:27] sts.

Cast off rem 15 [19:21:21:21:23:27] sts.

Neckband

Join right shoulder seam. With **RS** facing, using **3.25mm needles** and **A**, pick up and knit 19 [24:24:24:25:25:27] sts evenly down left side of front neck, knit across 17 [17:19:21:21:23:25] sts from holder at front of neck, pick up and knit 19 [24:24:24:25:25:27] sts evenly up right side of front neck and 35 [37:39:41:43:45:47] sts left on a holder at back of neck. 90 [102:106:110:114:118:126] sts.

Next row: Knit.

Beg with row 1 of 2x2 rib, work 22 rows. Cast off in rib.

Making Up

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. Fold neckband in half onto **WS** and slip stitch in position. Insert sleeves by folding each sleeve in half lengthwise and place fold to shoulder seam, sew in position between **markers**. Join side and sleeve seams.

Pin your garment out to size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.

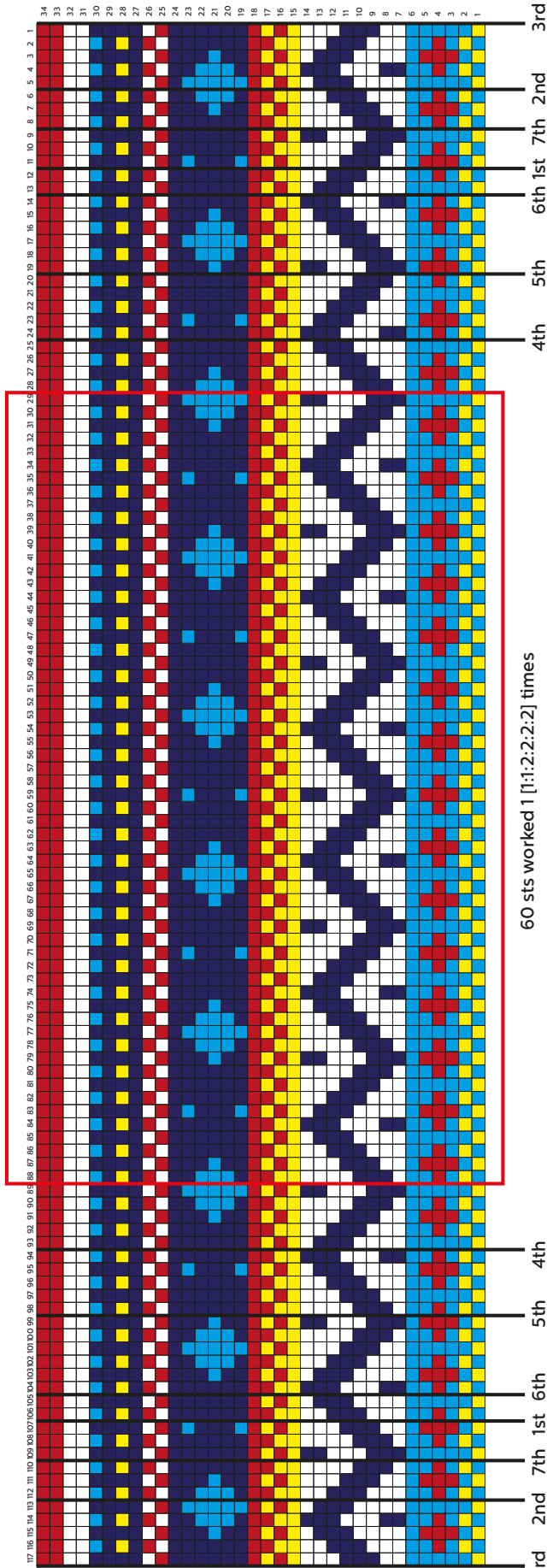


CHART
