Out of the Woods is a concept that developed from the colour palette and was influenced by a nostalgic craving for those intuitive outdoor explorations into nature. Venture into your creativity with this collection of 4 alluring garments & 3 beautiful accessory sets.

GENERAL INFO

TENSION

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size, you should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved and if you have more you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

WORKING FROM A CHART

When working from a chart you will read all right side rows from right to left and wrong side rows from left to right.

FINISHING

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your garment. When sewing in a raglan sleeve you will match row for row. When sewing in a semi set in sleeve you need to pin the sleeve in position matching the centre of the sleeve cast off to the shoulder of the body, you will then ease the sleeve into the armhole.

Once your garment is completed it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry.

MEASUREMENTS

Scarf (excluding pompoms)

width	21cm
length	174cm

Hat

To fit average size ladies head

MATERIALS

SCARF

West Yorkshire Spinners - Illustrious DK
Claret (508) 3 x 100g

NEEDLES

1 Pair 4mm (US 6/UK 8) knitting needles
Cable needle
65mm Pompom maker (optional)

HAT

West Yorkshire Spinners - Illustrious DK
Claret (508) 1 x 100g
Oddments of coloured yarn for embroidery (optional)

NEEDLES

Set of four 4mm (US 6/UK 8) double pointed needles (DPNs) or 4mm (US 6/UK 8) long circular needles (using magic loop method)
Cable needle
Stitch marker

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm measured over stocking stitch and 27 sts and 26 rows to 10cm measured over cabled pattern on 4mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension. It is important to follow the blocking instructions given below.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TENSION AS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO ACHIEVE THIS TENSION IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE SUCCESS.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1 - Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

C6F - Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k3 then k3 from cable needle.

C6B - Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k3 then k3 from cable needle.

MB - Knit into front, back and front of next st, turn, k3, turn, p3, turn, k3, turn, sl 1, k2tog, pssso. (bobble complete)

T3B - Slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2, then p1 from cable needle.

T3F - Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, p1, then k2 from cable needle.

T5R - Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2 then p1, k2 from cable needle.

PATTERN NOTES

1. The embroidery on the hat is optional.
2. Follow instructions and photography as a guide for the embroidery but feel free to personalise and add your own embroidery techniques.
3. Pompoms on scarf are also optional and do not have to be included, scarf can finish with the rib only.



SCARF

Using 4mm needles, cast on 50 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K4, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: * K2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

These 2 rows form rib with g-st border.

Cont in rib as set until work measures 10 cm, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Work placement for cable patt as follows:-

Next row (WS): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Next row: K2, p7, (k1, m1) twice, k1, p8, k2, m1, k6, m1, k2, p8, (k1, m1) twice, k1, p7, k2. 56 sts.

Next row (WS): K9, p5, k8, p12, k8, p5, k9.

Row 1 (RS): K2, p7, T5R, p8, k12, p8, T5R, p7, k2.

Row 2: K9, p2, k1, p2, k8, p12, k8, p2, k1, p2, k9.

Row 3: K2, p6, T3B, p1, T3F, p7, C6B, C6F, p7, T3B, p1, T3F, p6, k2.

Row 4: K8, p2, k3, p2, k7, p12, k7, p2, k3, p2, k8.

Row 5: K2, p5, T3B, p3, T3F, p6, k12, p6, T3B, p3, T3F, p5, k2.

Row 6: K7, p2, k5, p2, k6, p12, k6, p2, k5, p2, k7.

Row 7: K2, p5, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p6, k12, p6, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p5, k2.

Row 8: As row 6.

Row 9: K2, p5, T3F, p3, T3B, p6, C6B, C6F, p6, T3F, p3, T3B, p5, k2.

Row 10: As row 4.

Row 11: K2, p6, T3F, p1, T3B, p7, k12, p7, T3F, p1, T3B, p6, k2.

Row 12: K9, p2, k1, p2, k8, p12, k8, p2, k1, p2, k9.

Last 12 rows set cable patt and g-st border.

Cont in cable patt and g-st border until work measures 166cm, ending with row 12.

Next row: K2, p7, k2tog, p1, k2tog, p8, k1, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1, p8, k2tog, p1, k2tog, p7, k2. 50 sts.

Next row (WS): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Beg with row 1 of rib, cont in rib until work measures approximately 174cm for 12th row.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Make six, 65mm pompoms using remaining yarn and sew 3 pompoms to each end of scarf.

BLOCKING

Pin to measurements stated above, cover with damp cloths and leave to dry.

HAT

Using 4mm circular or double pointed needles, cast on 112 sts.

Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker at beg of round.

Working in rounds proceed as follows:-

Rnd 1: * K2, p2, rep from * to end.

This rnd sets rib.

Cont in rib until work measures 7cm.

Next rnd: Knit.

Rnd 1: (P7, T5R, p10, k12, p10, T5R, p7) twice.

Rnd 2: (P7, k2, p1, k2, p10, k12, p10, k2, p1, k2, p7) twice.

Rnd 3: (P6, T3B, p1, T3F, p9, k12, p9, T3B, p1, T3F, p6) twice.

Rnd 4: (P6, k2, p3, k2, p9, k12, p9, k2, p3, k2, p6) twice.

Rnd 5: (P5, T3B, p3, T3F, p8, C6B, C6F, p8, T3B, p3, T3F, p5) twice.

Rnd 6: (P5, k2, p5, k2, p8, k12, p8, k2, p5, k2, p5) twice.

Rnd 7: (P5, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p8, k12, p8, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p5) twice.

Rnd 8: As row 6.

Rnd 9: (P5, T3F, p3, T3B, p8, k12, p8, T3F, p3, T3B, p5) twice.

Rnd 10: As row 4.

Rnd 11: (P6, T3F, p1, T3B, p9, C6B, C6F, p9, T3F, p1, T3B, p6) twice.

Rnd 12: (P7, k2, p1, k2, p10, k12, p10, k2, p1, k2, p7) twice.

Last 12 rnds set cable patt.

Rep these 12 rnds once more.

Shape Crown

Rnd 25: (P2, p2tog, p3, T5R, (p3, p2tog) twice, k12, (p2tog, p3) twice, T5R, p3, p2tog, p2) twice. 100 sts.

Rnd 26: (P6, k2, p1, k2, p8, k12, p8, k2, p1, k2, p6) twice.

Rnd 27: (P2, p2tog, p1, T3B, p1, T3F, p2, p2tog, p1, p2tog, k12, p2tog, p1, p2tog, p2, T3B, p1, T3F, p1, p2tog, p2) twice. 88 sts.

Rnd 28: (P4, k2, p3, k2, p5, k12, p5, k2, p3, k2, p4) twice.

Rnd 29: (P1, p2tog, T3B, p3, T3F, (p2tog) twice, C6B, C6F, (p2tog) twice, T3B, p3, T3F, p2tog, p1) twice. 76 sts.

Rnd 30: (P2, k2, p5, k2, p2, k12, p2, k2, p5, k2, p2) twice.

Rnd 31: (P2, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p2, k12, p2, k2, p2, MB, p2, k2, p2) twice.

Rnd 32: As rnd 30.

Rnd 33: (P2tog, T3F, p3, T3B, p2tog, k12, p2tog, T3F, p3, T3B, p2tog) twice. 68 sts.

Rnd 34: (P2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k12, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2) twice.

Rnd 35: (P2tog, T3F, p1, T3B, p2tog, C6B, C6F, p2tog, T3F, p1, T3B, p2tog) twice. 60 sts.

Rnd 36: (P2, k2, p1, k2, p2, k12, p2, k2, p1, k2, p2) twice.

Rnd 37: (P2tog, T5R, p2tog, k1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k1, p2tog, T5R, p2tog) twice. 46 sts.

Rnd 38: (P1, (k2, p1) twice, k9, (p1, k2) twice, p1) twice.

Rnd 39: P1, * (k2, p1) twice, (sl1, k2tog, pss0) 3 times, (p1, k2) twice, * p2tog, rep from * to * once more, p1. 33 sts.

Rnd 40: (Sl1, k2tog, pss0) 11 times. 11 sts.

Break off yarn and thread through rem 11 sts. Pull up tight, and fasten off securely.

MAKING UP

Using photography as a guide add embroidery using oddments of Illustrious DK. Use a mixture of lazy daisy, french knots and running st to create floral and pretty embroidery.

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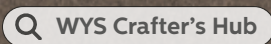
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
