Riley - Adult's Wavy Cabled Hat & Scarf

Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment. If you have fewer stitches than stated, you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more stitches, you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting your garments.

Finishing and Making Up

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your hat. Once your garment is complete, it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

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








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Abbreviations

repeat the instructions following the single asterisk as directed


purl 2 together P2tog





Hat & Scarf



Measurements

Hat (Head Circumference)

	Adult
cm	48
in	19

Scarf (Width x Length)

cm	22 x 136
in	8¾ x 53½

Equipment

One set 4mm (UK8/US6) DPNs for Hat
One pair 4mm (UK8/US6) knitting needles for Scarf
Cable needle
One stitch marker

Tension

30 sts and 28 rows to 10cm measured over cable rib pattern, using 4mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.

Special Abbreviations

C4B. Slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at back of work, K2 then K2 from CN.

C4F. Slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at front of work, K2 then K2 from CN.

T4B. Slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at back of work, K2 then P2 from CN.

T4F. Slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at front of work, P2 then K2 from CN.



Hat

Using 4mm DPNs, cast on 144 sts.

Ensuring sts are not twisted, join to work in the round.

Place beg of rnd marker.

Rnd 1: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

This round sets rib and is repeated.

Cont in rib until Hat measures 4cm from cast on edge.

Work in cable rib pattern as follows:

Rnd 1: *K2, C4B, (P2, K2) twice, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: *K6, (P2, K2) twice, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: *T4B, K2, C4B, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: *K2, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: *K2, P2, T4B, (K2, P2) twice, rep from * to end.

Rnds 6-8: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: *(K2, P2) twice, C4F, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 10: *(K2, P2) twice, K6, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 11: *K2, P2, C4F, K2, T4F, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 12: *K2, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 13: *K2, P2, K2, T4F, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnds 14-16: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

These 16 rnds set cable rib pattern and are repeated.

Cont in pattern until Hat measures approximately 17cm from cast on edge, ending with rnd 5.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: *K2, P2tog, K2, P2, rep from * to end. 126 sts.

Rnds 2-4: *K2, P1, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: *K2, P1, K2, P2tog, rep from * to end. 108 sts.

Rnd 6: *K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: *K2, P1, K2tog, P1, rep from * to end. 90 sts.

Rnd 8: *K2, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: *K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 72 sts.

Rnd 10: *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 11: *Sl1, K1, psso, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 54 sts.

Rnd 12: *K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rnd 13: *Sl1, K1, psso, P1, rep from * to end. 36 sts.

Rnd 14: *Sl1, K1, psso, rep from * to end. 18 sts.

Rnd 15: *Sl1, K1, psso, rep from * to end. 9 sts.

Break off yarn and thread through remaining 9 sts, draw up and fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and pin your Hat out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Scarf

Yarn note

When joining a new ball of yarn for a neater edge, join yarn a few stitches in from side edge.

Using 4mm needles, cast on 68 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 3 sts, P2, K1.

These 2 rows set rib and are repeated.

Cont in rib until Scarf measures 4cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Work in cable rib pattern as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, *K2, C4B, (P2, K2) twice, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: K1, P2, *(K2, P2) twice, K2, P6, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 3: K1, *T4B, K2, C4B, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 4: K1, P2, *K2, P2, K2, P6, K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 5: K1, *K2, P2, T4B, (K2, P2) twice, rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

Row 6: K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 7: K1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 8: As row 6.

Row 9: K1, *(K2, P2) twice, C4F, K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 10: K1, P2, *K2, P6, (K2, P2) twice, rep from * to last st. K1.

Row 11: K1, *K2, P2, C4F, K2, T4F, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 12: As row 4.

Row 13: K1, *K2, P2, K2, T4F, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 14: As row 6.

Row 15: As row 7.

Row 16: K1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 16 rows set cable rib pattern and are repeated.

Cont in pattern until Scarf measures approximately 132cm from cast on edge, ending with row 6 or 14.


Beg with row 1 of rib, work 4cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Finishing

Weave in ends and pin your Scarf out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

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
