## WEST YORKSHIRE SPINNERS



LITTLE ARROWHEAD PLEATED DRESS


It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have too many stitches to stated tension, your tension is too tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, and your tension is too loose garment performance may be affected and you should change to a smaller needle. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting garment.

Instructions given are for the dst size, with larger sizes in brackets. Where only one figure or instruction is given, this applies to all sizes. Work all directions inside brackets the number of times stated.

## CHEST

81(86:91:96.5:101.5:106.5) cm, (32[34:36:38:40:42]in)

WAIST
63.5(67.5:71:76:81:86) cm,
(25[26.5:28:30:32:34 ]in)
WAIST
(STRETCHED TO FIT)
65(71:76:79:84:91.5) cm,
(26[28:30:31:33:36 ]in)

## LENGTH

95(96:98:99:101:102) cm,
(37.5[37.75:38.5:39:40:40.25]in)

## Tension

21 std $\times 30$ rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4 \mathrm{in}$ over stocking stitch using 4mm (US 6) knitting needles
17 sts $\times 30$ rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4$ in over arrowhead lace using 4 mm (US 6) knitting needles

A beautifully draped arrowhead lace pattern sits within the pleats of this dress meeting just above the hips. This Dress is knitted in the round to the armholes for easy construction and is finished with a pretty garter stitch edging

## Materials

## SHADE

765 Mulberry x 5(5:5:6:6:7) balls

## NEEDLES

4 mm (US 6) knitting needles
4 mm (US 6) long circular needle
4 mm (US 6) double pointed needles for armhole edging (or use circular needle and magic loop method)

## EXTRAS

$2 \times$ stitch holders
2 x stitch markers


Rnd 4: (P9, k11) to end of rnd.
These 4 rows form patt and are repeated
until work measures 42(43:44:45:46:47)cm,
16.5(17:17.25:17.75:18.25:18.5)in from cast-on edge and ending with Rnd 1 facing for the next rnd.
Next rnd (dec): *P1, p2tog, p3, p2tog, p1, k1, (yo, skpo) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from * 10(11:11:12:13:14) times more. 198(216:216:234:252:270)sts

Next rnd: (P7, k11) to end of rnd.
Now work 10 rows keeping each Arrowhead Lace pattern correct.
Next rnd (dec): *P1, p2tog, p1, p2tog, p1, k1, (yo, skpo) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from * 10(11:11:12:13:14) times more. 176(192:192:208:224:240)sts
Next rnd: (P5, k11) to end of rnd.
Now work 10 rows keeping each Arrowhead Lace pattern correct.
Next rnd (dec): *P1, sp2po, p1, k1, (yo, skpo) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from * 10(11:11:12:13:14)times more. 154(168:168:182:196:210)sts
Next rnd: (P3, k11) to end rnd.
Now work 10 rows keeping each Arrowhead Lace pattern correct.

## Sizes 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 only

Next rnd (dec): *P3tog, k1, (yo, skpo) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from * 10(11:11:12:13:14)times more. 132(144:-:156:168:180)sts
Next rnd: (P1, k11) to end of rnd.
Size 3 only
Next rnd (dec ): (K7, k2tog) 16 times, (k6, k2tog) 3 times.
149 sts
All Sizes
132(144:149:156:168:180)sts
Begin working in Stocking Stitch (ie knit every rnd) throughout.
Keeping marker to indicate beg/end of round add a second marker as folls:
Next rnd: K66(72:74:78:84:90)sts, place second marker, $k$ to end.
Next rnd (inc): K2, m1, k62(68:70:74:80:86), m1, k2, sm, k2, m1, k 62(68:71:74:80:86), m1, k2. 136(148:153:160:172:184)sts
Next 5 rnds: Knit.
Cont to work in st st whilst increasing 4 sts every 6th row a
further 8 times more as set above. 168(180:185:192:204:216)sts

## Sizes $3,4,5$ and 6 only

Inc a further 3(8:4:4)sts evenly and neatly on the next rnd. 188(200:208:220)sts
All sizes
168(180:188:200:208:220)sts

Cont straight in st st until work measures 25 cm (9.75in) from end of Lace Patt.
Remove both markers.

Cont in st st until armhole measures 18(18:19:19:20:20) cm, 7(7:7.5:7.5:8:8) in from beginning of armhole shaping and WS facing for next row.
Cast off knit-wise.

## Divide for Back and Shape armhole

## (Continue in rows)

${ }^{* *}$ Next row (RS): Cast off 6 sts, ( 1 st on RH needle)
k77(83:87:93:97:103)sts leave rem 84(90:94:100:104:110)sts on a holder for Front.
Next row (WS): Cast off 6 sts, p to end. 72(78:82:88:92:98)sts
Next row: Cast off 4 sts, k to end. 68(74:78:84:88:94)sts
Next row: Cast off 4 sts, p to end. 64(70:74:80:84:90)sts
Next row: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. 62(68:72:78:82:88)sts
Next row: Purl.
Now work in stocking stitch (in rows) as folls:
Row 1 (RS): Knit.
Row 2: Purl.
** Cont in st st as above until armhole measures
18(18:19:19:20:20) cm, 7(7:7.5:7.5:8:8) in from beginning of armhole shaping and RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulders

Cast off 13(16:17:20:22:24)sts at beg of next 2 rows.
Leave remaining 36(36:38:38:38:40)sts on a holder for back neck.
Rejoin yarn to 84(90:94:100:104:110)sts on a holder for Front and work as for Back from ** to **. 62(68:72:78:82:88)sts Cont in st st until armhole measures 13(13:14:14:15:15) cm, 5.25(5.25:5.5:5.5:6:6) in from beginning of armhole shaping and RS facing for next row.

## Shape Front neck

Next row (RS): K22(25:26:29:31:33)sts, turn, leave rem 40(43:46:49:51:55)sts on holder and work on these st only for Left Neck.
Next row (WS): Cast off 5 sts, p to end. 17(20:21:24:26:28)sts.
Next row: Knit.
Next row: Cast off 3 sts, p to end. 14(17:18:21:23:25)sts.
Next row: Knit.
Next row: P2tog, p to end. 13(16:17:20:22:24)sts.
Cont in st st until armhole measures 18(18:19:19:20:20) cm , 7(7:7.5:7.5:8:8) in from beginning of armhole shaping and WS facing for next row.
Cast off knit-wise.
With RS facing slip centre 18(18:20:20:20:22)sts onto a holder for Front neck, rejoin yarn to rem 22(25:26:29:31:33) sts, cast off 5 sts, $k$ to end. 17(20:21:24:26:28)sts.
Next row (WS): Purl.
Next row: Cast off 3 sts, $k$ to end. 14(17:18:21:23:25)sts.
Next row: Purl.
Next row: K2tog, k to end. 13(16:17:20:22:24)sts.

## NECKBAND

Join left shoulder.
Using 4mm (US 6) needles, with RS facing rejoin yarn to 36(36:38:38:38:40)sts left on a holder for Back neck. Pick up and knit 17(17:18:18:20:19)sts, evenly down left Front neck, knit 18(18:20:20:20:22)sts from front neck holder, pick up and knit 17(17:18:18:20:19)sts st evenly up right front neck. 88(88:94:94:98:100)sts
Knit 4 rows in garter stitch.
Cast off knit-wise on WS row.

## ARMHOLE EDGING

Join right shoulder seam.
Begin, with RS facing at the centre of armhole shaping of right Front (ie where work is split for Back and Front). Using 4 mm (US 6) double pointed needles (or circular needle and magic loop method), pick up and knit 40(40:44:44:48:48)sts evenly to shoulder seam, 40(40:44:44:48:48)sts from shoulder seam down other side to beg of armhole shaping. 80(80:88:88:96:96)sts
Work Garter Stitch edging in rads as folls:
Rad 1: Knit.
Rna 2: Purl.
Repeat these 2 rows once more.
Cast off knit-wise.
Repeat for left armhole edging beginning at armhole shaping of left Back.

## MAKING UP

Join right shoulder seam.
Block garment pieces using preferred method.
Fasten off any loose ends.


When casting off we recommend casting off the neck band on bigger needles to ensure case of fit
