English Rose

Materials

Signature 4Ply Yarn - The Florist Collection

Colour A English Rose (806)

Colour B Hydrangea (335)

3.5mm Crochet Hook

Small Rose

With colour A make 46 ch.

Row 1: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 dc into every ch to end, turn. (44 sts)

Row 2: ch 1, 1 dc into every st to end, turn.

Row 3: ch 5 (counts as 1 htr and ch 3), miss st at the base of ch 5 and next st, 1 htr into next st, * ch 3, miss next st, 1 htr into next st, rep from * to end, turn. (22 ch -3 sp)

Row 4: ch 1, * (1 htr, 4 tr, 1 htr) all into next ch-3 sp, sl st into next htr, rep from * to end, ending last rep with sl st to second of ch 5.

Fasten off.

Large Rose

With colour A make 57 ch.

Row 1: 1 htr into third ch from hook, 1 htr into every ch to end, turn. (55 sts)

Row 2: ch 6 (counts as 1 tr and ch 3), miss st at the base of ch 6 and next st, 1 tr into next st, * ch 3, miss next st, 1 tr into next st, rep from * to end, turn (27 ch-3 sp)

Row 3: ch 1, * (1 htr, 4 tr, 1 htr) all into next ch-3 sp, sl st to next tr, * rep from * to * 6 times, ** (1 tr, 4 dtr, 1 tr) all into next ch-3 sp, 1 dc into next tr, rep from ** to end, ending last rep with 1 dc into third of ch 6.

Fasten off.

Small Leaves (make 2)

With colour B make 11 ch.

Rd 1: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 dc into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 dtr into next 4 ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, working on the other side of foundation ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 dtr into next 4 ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 dc into next 2 ch, sl st to first dc.

Fasten off

Large Leaves (make 2)

With colour B make 15 ch.

Rd 1: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 dc into next ch, 1 htr into next 2 ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 dtr into next 2 ch, 1 trtr into the next 2 ch, 1 dtr into next 3 ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, working on the other side of foundation ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 dtr into next 3 ch, 1 trtr into the next 2 ch, 1 dtr into next 2 ch, 1 tr into next ch, 1 htr into next 2 ch, 1 dc into next 2 ch, sl st to first dc.

Fasten off.

Making Up

Weave in ends.

Block by pinning out all pieces, gently steam with an iron.

With right side facing inside, starting with the first petal (for large rose, starting with the smallest petal), roll petals to form a flower, making sure the base is flat; sew to secure as you roll with a length of yarn.

Attach small leaves to the side of small rose and large leaves to large one.



Honeysuckle

Materials

Signature 4Ply Yarn - The Florist Collection

Colour A Honeysuckle (234)

Colour B Foxglove (802)

Colour C Hydrangea (335)

3mm Crochet Hook

Petal

With yarn A make 15 ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 dc into every ch to end, turn. (14 sts)

Row 2: ch 1, 1 dc into next 10 sts, 1 htr into next 4 sts, turn.

Row 3: ch 1, 1 htr into next 4 sts, 1 dc into every st to end, turn.

Row 4: as row 2.

Row 5: ch 1, 1 dc into every st to end, turn.

Row 6: ch 1, 1 dc into next 3 sts, ch 9, turn.

Row 7: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 dc into next 7 ch, 1 dc into next 3 sts from previous row.

Row 8 & 9: ch 1, 1 dc into every st to end, turn.

Row 10: ch 1, 1 dc into next 3 sts.

Fasten off.

Honeysuckle



Crocheted in English Rose 806, Lisianthus 281 and Hydrangea 335

Filaments (make 4)

With colour B make 20 ch.

Row 1: 1 sl st into 6th ch from hook, 1 sl st into every ch to end. Fasten off.

Small Leaf (make 2)

With colour C make 9 ch.

Rd 1: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next 4 ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 dc into next ch, ch 1, working on the other side of foundation ch, 1 dc into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next 4 ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 dc into next ch, sl st to first dc. (16 sts)

Fasten off.

Large leaf (make 3)

With colour C make 9 ch.

Rd 1: 1 dc into second ch from hook, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next 4 ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 dc into next ch, ch 1, working on the other side of foundation ch, 1 dc into next ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 tr into next 4 ch, 1 htr into next ch, 1 dc into next ch, do not join rd, continue to rd 2, working around the leaf. (16 sts)

Rd 2: ch 1, * 2 dc into first dc, 2 htr into next htr, 2 tr into each of the next 4 tr, 2 htr into next htr, 2 dc into next dc, ch 1, rep from * to end, sl st to ch 1. (32 sts)

Fasten off.

Making Up

Weave in all ends.

Block by pinning out all pieces, gently steam with an iron.

With RS facing fold the flower so that the larger petal is on top, insert all 4 filaments inside the flower and sew up the side opening of the flower. Weave in the ends of the filaments around the base of flower.

Attach the leaves at the base of flower, smaller ones on the side and bigger ones around.

Fold a small part of the edge of both petals of the flower and sew in place, it gives it neater finish and helps to stop the petals from twisting. Attach the bigger petal to the big leaf to help it stay in place.
