MATERIALS

1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 – US6) Knitting Needles. 1 Pair of 3.25mm (UK10 – US3) Knitting Needles. Stitch Holders.

The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

22sts and 28 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch or Double moss-st using 4mm knitting needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

2x2 Rib.

1st row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2. 2nd row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end. Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st row: Knit. 2nd row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

HAT - VERSION I

Using 3.25mm needles and A cast on 90 [102:114]sts and work in 2x2 rib for 3 [4:5]cm, ending with a ws row.

Place a marker at each end of last row.

Work in 2x2 rib for a further 3 [4:5]cm, ending with a rs row. **Next row**: Rib 4 [5:6], rib2tog, (rib 6 [7:8], rib2tog) 10 times, rib 4 [5:6]. 79 [91:103]sts.

Break off A.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st and 4 row stripe patt of B, C, D, E and F (throughout) cont until Hat measures 13 [14:15]cm, from markers or length required, ending with a ws row.

**Shape Crown.

1st row: K1, (K2tog, K4) 13 [15:17] times. 66 [76:86]sts.

2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.

3rd row: K1, (K2tog, K3) 13 [15:17] times. 53 [61:69]sts. 5th row: K1, (K2tog, K2) 13 [15:17] times. 40 [46:52]sts. 7th row: K1, (K2tog, K1) 13 [15:17] times. 27 [31:35]sts. 9th row: K1, (K2tog) 13 [15:17] times. 14 [16:18]sts.

10th row: (P2tog) 6 [7:8] times. 7 [8:9]sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up

and fasten off.**

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam, reversing sewing from markers for turnback.

HAT - VERSION 2

Work exactly as given for Version 1 working 4 row stripe patt in B, C, D and E (throughout).

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam, reversing sewing from markers for turnback.

SCARF - VERSION I

Using 4mm needles and B cast on 24 [32:40]sts.

1st row: S1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3sts, K3.

2nd row: S1, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last st, K1.

3rd row: S1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 3sts, P2, K1.

4th row: S1, K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Rep last 4 rows 4 times more using C, D, E and F.

Using A only and keeping continuity of patt as set cont until end of 2nd Ball of A, ending with 4th row of patt.

Work Stripe Patt to match previous end.

Cast off.

SCARF - VERSION 2

Work as given for Scarf Version 1 **only** using 4 colours in stripe at each end of B, C, D, E and B.
