# Ellery Blankets

## Materials and Measurements

<b>Blanket 1</b>	62 x 58	cm
<b>Width x Height</b>	24.5 x 22.5	ins
<b>Blanket 2</b>	51 x 68	cm

4.00mm (UK8-USAG/6) and 4.50mm (UK7 - USAG/6) crochet hooks.

Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean that the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

### IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the items. Blanket 1 - 16 sts. and 10 rows to 10cm, 4ins over patt on 4.00mm hook. Blanket 2 - 15 sts. and 10 rows to 10cm, 4ins over patt. on 4.00mm hook. If your tension

is tight you will need to change your hook to a larger size. If your tension is loose you will need to change your hook to a smaller size.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** - chain, **yoh** - yarn over hook, **tr** - treble, **rept** - repeat, **dc** - double crochet, **htr** - half treble.

### BLANKET 1

(Photographed in Pink, Fuchsia and White)

Using 4.00mm hook and A ch. 102.

#### Foundation Row

yoh then insert hook into 4th ch. from the hook, pull up loop (now 3 on hook), yoh and pull through 2 loops (2 left on hook) \*\*\* yoh, miss 1 ch. insert hook into next chain, pull up a loop (4 on hook), yoh, pull through 2 loops (3 left on hook), yoh pull through 3 loops, \*\* ch. 1, yoh insert hook into same ch., pull up loop (3 on hook), yoh pull through 2 loops (2 left on hook)\* Repeat from \*\*\* to \* working up to \*\* on last rept then work 1 tr into same chain, chain 3 and turn.

#### Pattern Row

yoh, insert hook in space between last V and tr., pull through loop (3 on hook) pull through 2 loops (2 left on hook) Repeat as for foundation row finishing in the same way.

Rept this pattern row using the following colour sequence: Four rows A, four rows B and four rows C. Rept this three stripe sequence three times more. Fasten off.

### Edging

**1st Row** - Using B work 1 row of dc all the way round edge of blanket with 3 dc in each corner slip stitch to join.

**2nd Row** - 3ch, 3tr into 1st dc \*miss 3dc, 1dc, 3ch, 3 tr into next dc\* Repeat from \* to \* to end finishing with 1 dc into 1st dc of previous round.

### BLANKET 2

(Photographed in Blue, Grey and White)

Using 4.00mm hook and A, ch 91

#### Foundation Row

3 tr into 4th ch from hook, \*miss 2 ch, 1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr into next ch, miss 2 ch, 3 tr into next ch, rept from \* to last 3 ch, miss 2 ch, 1 tr into last ch.

#### Pattern Row

2 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss 1 tr, 3 tr into next ch, rept from \* to \* on Foundation row to last 2 tr, miss 1 tr, 1 tr into top of ch, turn.

Rept this pattern row using the following colour sequence: Four rows A, four rows B and four rows C. Rept this three stripe colour sequence four times more. Fasten off.

### Edging

**1st Round** - Using B, work 1 row of dc round edge, work 3 dc into each corner, slip stitch into 1st dc.

**2nd Round** - \*2 ch, 2 tr into same dc as 2 ch stands, miss 2 dc, slip stitch into next dc\* rept from \* to end, slip stitch to 1st ch. Fasten off.
