IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit; **P** - purl;
st(s) - stitch(es); **st st** - stocking stitch (right side rows knit, wrong side rows purl); **cm** - centimetres;
ins - inches; **inc** - increase; **alt** - alternate; **beg** - beginning;
dec - decrease; **tog** - together;
rept - repeat; **g st** - garter stitch (every row K); **cont** - continue; **ws** - wrong side; **rs** - right side;
MI - make one st by picking up the strand between stitches and knitting through back of loop; **rev st st** (reverse stocking stitch) - right side rows purl, wrong side rows knit.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 20 sts and 30 rows to 10cm, 4ins over st st on 4.5mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

JUMPER

BACK AND FRONT (both alike) Commence at sleeve edge.

Using 4½mm needles cast on 44 (44, 45, 45, 46, 46) sts.

1st row (ws) - Knit.

Starting with a K row work in st st until work measures 11cm, 4¼ins, ending on a ws row.

Commence Sleeve Shaping

1st row - Inc in first st, K to end.

2nd row - P to last st, inc in last st. Inc 1 st at this same edge on every row until there are 58 (58, 59, 59, 60, 60) sts, ending with a P row.

Increase For Body

Next row - Cast on 48 (48, 49, 49, 50, 50) sts, K to end. 106 (106, 108, 108, 110, 110) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Commence Hem and Shoulder Shaping

1st row - K8, MI, K to last 8 sts, MI, K8.

2nd and every alt row - Purl.

3rd row - K9, MI, K to last 9 sts, MI, K9.

5th row - K10, MI, K to last 10 sts, MI, K10.

7th row - K11, MI, K to last 11 sts, MI, K11.

Cont to increase in this manner until 128 (130, 136, 138, 144, 146) sts, ending after final inc on a rs row.

Shape Neck

(ws) Dec 1 st at beg of next row, and then every 4th row until 123 (125, 131, 133, 139, 141) sts remain. Work 51 (55, 55, 57, 57, 59) rows, ending with a K row.

Inc 1 st at beg of next row, and then every 4th row until there are 128 (130, 136, 138, 144, 146) sts.

Continue Hem and Shoulder Shaping

1st row - K17 (18, 20, 21, 23, 24), K2tog, K to last 19 (20, 22, 23, 25, 26) sts, K2tog, K to end.

2nd and every alt row - Purl.

3rd row - K16 (17, 19, 20, 22, 23), K2tog, K to last 18 (19, 21, 22, 24, 25) sts, K2tog, K to end.

5th row - K15 (16, 18, 19, 21, 22), K2tog, K to last 17 (18, 20, 21, 23, 24) sts, K2tog, K to end.

7th row - K14 (15, 17, 18, 20, 21), K2tog, K to last 16 (17, 19, 20, 22, 23) sts, K2tog, K to end.

Cont to decrease in this manner until 106 (106, 108, 108, 110, 110) sts, ending after final dec on a rs row.

Purl 1 row.

Next row - Cast off 48 (48, 49, 49, 50, 50) sts, K to end.

Commence Sleeve Shaping

Dec 1 st at end of next row, and then dec 1 st at this same edge on every row until 44 (44, 45, 45, 46, 46) sts remain.

Cont to work in st st for a further 11cm, 4¼ins to match first sleeve ending on a rs row.

Knit 1 row.

Cast off.

NECK BORDER

Using 4mm needles and with right side of work facing, pick up and K72 (76, 76, 78, 78, 79) sts evenly along neck edge.

1st row - K2tog, K to last 2 sts, K2tog.

K5 more rows, dec 1 st at each end of every row; including cast off row. Cast off.

BACK and FRONT HEM

BORDERS (both alike)

Using 4mm needles, pick up and K120 (125, 132, 138, 146, 152) sts along Hem edge. Knit 1 row. Cast off loosely.

MAKING UP

Join shoulder and top sleeve seam by top sewing. Join side and under sleeve seam by top sewing.



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
