# **ABBREVIATIONS**

K - Knit; P - Purl; st(s) -stitch(es); alt - alternate; beg -beginning; dec - decrease; st st - stocking stitch ( I row knit, I row purl); g st - garter stitch (every row k); inc - increase; mI - make one, pick up loop before next st. and K. it t.b.l.; 0 - no stitches or rows to be worked in that particular size; patt - pattern; rept - repeat; sI - slip; tog - together; tbI - through back of loop; yfwd - yarn forward; yrn. - yarn round needle; yon - yarn over needle; cm - centimetres ins - inches.

#### **TENSION**

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

22 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) over Lace patt. on 4 mm Needles.

If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm, your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

# CARDIGAN BACK

Using 4 mm Needles cast on 67 (73, 79, 85) sts.

\*\* Next Row - Knit.

#### Commence Patt.

**Ist Row** (Right Side) - KI,\* yrn, PI, P3 tog, PI, yon., KI, rept from \* to end.

2nd Row - Purl.

3rd Row - Knit.

4th Row - Purl.

These 4 rows form the patt. Continue in patt. until work measures 12 (14, 16, 18) cm, 4.75 (5.5, 6.25, 7) ins from commencement finishing on a 2nd patt row.\*\*

# **Shape Armholes**

Keeping patt. correct. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec I st at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt row until 49 (55, 61, 67) sts remain finishing on a right side row.

**Next Row** (Dec Row) - P4 (3, 2, I) sts., [P2 tog] 21 (25, 29, 33) times, P3 (2, I, 0). 28 (30, 32, 34) sts.

SI these sts onto a st holder.

#### **LEFT FRONT**

Using 4mm Needles cast on 31 (31, 37, 37) sts.

Work as instructions given for Back from\*\* to\*\*.

(Work I row more for Right Front).

# **Shape Armhole**

Keeping Patt. correct.

**Next Row** - Cast off 3 sts, patt to end.

Work I row. (Omit this row for Right Front).

Dec I st at armhole edge on the next and every following alt row until I 22 (22, 28, 28) sts remain finishing on a right side row.

Next Row - (Dec Row) - PI (4, 0, I) sts., [P2 tog] I0 (9, I4, I3) times, P.I (0, 0, I). I2 (13, I4, I5)sts.

SI these sts onto a st holder.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Work as instructions given for Left Front.

# **SLEEVES (Both Alike)**

Using 4mm Needles cast on 29 (29, 31, 31) sts.

Work 2 rows in g st.

**Next Row** (Inc Row) - K4, m1,\* K3 (3, 2, 2), m1, rept from \* to last 4 (4, 5, 5) sts, K4 (4, 5, 5). 37 (37, 43, 43) sts.

# Commence Patt.

Continue in patt as given for Back until work measures 11 (12.5, 15, 17) cm, 4.25 (5, 6, 6.75) ins from commencement finishing on a 2nd patt row.

# **Shape Top**

Keeping patt. correct.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec I st at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt row until 19 (19, 25, 25) sts remain finishing on a wrong side row.

SI these sts onto a st holder.

# LEFT FRONT BAND

\*\*\* Using 4 mm Needles cast on 5 sts.

Continue in gst (2nd row is Right Side) until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit up Left Front finishing on a wrong side row.\*\*\*

SI these sts onto a st holder.

# **RIGHT FRONT BAND**

Work as instructions given for Left Front Band from \*\*\* to \*\*\*. Leave these sts on a needle.

#### YOKE

With right side facing, using 4 mm Needles, K5 sts. from Right Front Band, 12 (13, 14, 15) sts. from st holder at Right Front, 19 (19, 25, 25) sts from Sleeve, 28 (30, 32, 34) sts from Back, 19 (19, 25, 25) sts from Sleeve, 12 (13, 14, 15) sts from Left Front and 5 sts. from Left Front Band. 100 (104, 120, 124) sts.

\*\*\*\* Ist Row - Knit.

2nd Row (Buttonhole Row) - K2, yfwd, K2tog, K to end.
3rd Row - K5, P to last 5 sts, K5.
4th Row (Dec Row) - K9 (6, 9, 6), \* K2tog, K6 (7, 8, 9), rept from \* to last 11 (8, 11, 8) sts, K2tog, K9 (6, 9, 6). 89 (93, 109, 113) sts.
5th, 6th, 7th & 8th Rows -

**9th Row** - K5, P to last 5 sts., K5. **I 0th Row** (Buttonhole and Dec. Row) - K2, yfwd, K2tog, K5 (2, 5, 2), \* K2 tog, K5 (6, 7, 8), rept from \* to last I0 (7, I0, 7) sts, K.2 tog, K8 (5, 8, 5). 78 (82, 98, I02)

IIth, I2th, I3th Rows - Knit. I4th and I5th Rows - As 8th and 9th Rows. **16th Row** (Dec Row) - K8 (5, 8, 5), \* K.2 tog., K.4 (5, 6, 7), rept from \* to last 10 (7, 10, 7) sts, K2 tog. K8 (5, 8, 5). 67 (71, 87, 91) sts. **17th Row** - Knit. **18th Row** (Dec Row) - K8 (5, 8, 7), \* K2tog, K3 (4, 1, 1), rept. from \* to last 9 (6, 10, 9) sts, K2tog, K7 (4, 8, 7). 56 (60, 63, 65) sts. **19th Row** - Knit. **20th Row** (Buttonhole Row) - K2, yfwd, K2tog, K to end. **21st Row** - K5, P to last 5 sts, K5. **22nd and 23rd Rows** - Knit. Cast off. \*\*\*\*

#### **PRESSING**

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

Press as instructions given on ball band.

# **MAKING UP**

Pin in front bands into position, sew in by top sewing.

Join side and sleeve seams by top sewing. Pin sleeves in position. Sew in sleeves by top sewing. Sew on buttons.
