The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**K** - Knit; **P** - Purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **st st** - stocking stitch; **tog** - together; **beg** - beginning; **alt** - alternate; **rept** - repeat; **sl** - slip; **psso** - pass slipped stitch over; **yfwd** - yarn forward; **yon** - yarn over needle; **yrn** - yarn round needle; **inc** - increase; **dec** - decrease; **0** - No stitches or rows to be worked in that particular size; **patt** - pattern; **cm** - centimetres; **ins** - inches.

### TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

24 sts and 32 rows to 10cm (4 ins) over st.st. on 4 mm Needles.

If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

### BACK

Using 3.25mm Needles, cast on 61 (67, 71, 79) sts.

**1st Row** - K1, \* P1, K1, rept from \* to end.

**2nd Row** - P1, \* K1, P1, rept from \* to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows for 4 cm (1.5 ins) finishing on a 2nd Row inc. 1 st. at end of last row for 46 (56, 61) cm. 18 (22, 24) inch sizes only. Change to 4mm Needles.

### Commence Patt.

**1st Row** - P2 (2, 2, 1), \* K3, P2, rept. from \* to last 0 (0, 0, 4) sts., K0 (0) (0) (K3, P1).

**2nd Row** - K2 (2, 2, 1), \* P3, K2, rept from \* to last 0 (0, 0, 4) sts., P0 (0) (0) (P3, K1).

**3rd Row** - P2 (2, 2, 1), \* yon., sl1, K2tog, psso, yrn., P2, rept from \* to

last 0 (0, 0, 4) sts., P0 (0) (0) (yon, sl1, K2tog, psso, yrn, P1).

**4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Rept. the last 4 rows twice more.

Change to st st (1 row knit, 1 row purl) until work measures 14 (16.5, 19, 21.5)cm, 5.5 (6.5, 7.5, 8.5) ins from commencement finishing on a P row.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5) sts. at beg of next 2 rows.

**Next Row** - K1, sl1, K1, psso., K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next Row** - Purl.

Rept the last 2 rows until 24 (25, 26, 28) sts remain finishing on a P row. Cast off.

### LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25 mm Needles, cast on 35 (39, 41, 45) sts.

Work 4 cm (1.5 ins) in rib as given for Back, finishing on a 1st Row.

**Next Row** - Rib 7, sl these 7 sts onto a safety pin, rib to end, K2tog at end of last row for (51, 61) cm. (20, 24) inch sizes only. 28 (31, 34, 37) sts.

Change to 4mm Needles.

### Commence Patt.

**1st Row** (Right Side) - P2 (1, 2, 1), \* K3, P2, rept. from \* to last 1 (0, 2, 1) sts, P1 (0, 2, 1).

**2nd Row** - K1 (0, 2, 1), \* K2, P3, rept. from \* to last 2 (1, 2, 1) sts, K2 (1, 2, 1).

**3rd Row** - P2 (1, 2, 1), \* yon, sl1, K2tog, psso., yrn., P2, rept from \* to last 1 (0, 2, 1) sts., P1 (0, 2, 1). **4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

Rept these 4 rows twice more.

Continue in st st with patt panel as follows:-

**1st Row** - K10, (14, 15, 19), P2, K3, P2, K11 (10, 12, 11).

**2nd Row** - P11 (10, 12, 11), K2, P3, K2, P10 (14, 15, 19).

**3rd Row** - K10 (14, 15, 19), P2, yon, sl1, K2tog, psso, yrn, P2, K11 (10, 12, 11).

**4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

Rept the last 4 rows until work measures same as Back to Armhole

finishing on a wrong side row.

### Shape Armhole and Front

**1st Row** - Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5), work to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**2nd Row** - Work in patt

**3rd Row** - K1, sl1, K1, pssso, work to end.

**4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

**5th Row** - K1, sl1, K1, pssso, work to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**6th Row** - As 2nd Row.

Rept. the 3rd to 6th rows until 2 sts remain. K2tog. Fasten off.

### RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.25mm. Needles, cast on 35 (39, 41, 45) sts.

Work 2 rows in rib as given for Back.

**Next Row** (Buttonhole Row) - Rib 3, cast off 1, rib to end.

**Next Row** - Rib to cast off st, cast on 1, rib to end.

Continue in rib until work measures 4 cm (1.5ins) from commencement finishing on a 1st Row.

**(51, 61) cm (20, 24) inch sizes only**

**Next Row** - K2tog, rib to last 7 sts, turn, sl the last 7 sts. onto a stitch holder.

**46 (56) cm 18 (22) inch sizes only**

**Next Row** - Rib to last 7 sts, turn, sl. the last 7 sts onto a stitch holder.

### Commence Pattern

**1st Row** - P1 (0, 2, 1), \* P2, K3, rept from\* to last 2 (1, 2, 1) sts, P2 (1, 2, 1).

**2nd Row** - K2 (1, 2, 1), \* P3, K2, rept. from\* to last 1 (0, 2, 1) sts, K1 (0, 2, 1).

**3rd Row** - P1 (0, 2, 1), \* P2, yon, sl1, K2tog, pssso, yrn, rept. from \* to last 2 (1, 2, 1) sts, P2 (1, 2, 1).

**4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

Rept. these 4 rows twice more. Continue in st st with patt panel as follows:-

**1st Row** - K11 (10, 12, 11), P2, K3, P2, K10 (14, 15, 19).

**2nd Row** - P10 (14, 15, 19), K2, P3, K2, P11 (10, 12, 11).

**3rd Row** - K11 (10, 12, 11), P2, yon, sl1, K2tog, pssso, yrn, P2, K10 (14, 15, 19).

**4th Row** - As 2nd Row.

Continue working to correspond with Left Front reversing all shapings and working armhole shaping K2tog, not sl1, K1, pssso.

### SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 3.25mm Needles, cast on 33 (35, 37, 39) sts.

Work 5 cm (2 ins) in rib as given for Back, finishing on a 2nd Row. Change to 4mm Needles and st st Continue in st st, inc 1 st at each end of the needle on the 3rd and every following 8th row until 39 (43, 47, 51) sts are on the needle. Continue without further inc until Sleeve measures 15 (16.5, 21.5, 26.5) cm, 6 (6.5, 8.5, 10.5) ins from commencement finishing on a P row.

### Shape Top

Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Next Row - Knit.

Next Row - Purl.

Next Row - K1, sl1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next Row - Purl.

Rept. the last 4 rows 2 (2, 3, 2) times more, then the last 2 rows only until 7 (7, 9, 9) sts. remain finishing on a P row.

Cast off.

### PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given. Press as instructions.

### MAKING UP

Pin sleeves into position, sew in by backstitching.

### Left Front Band

With right side of work facing, sl. sts from safety pin onto a 3.25 mm needle, rejoin yarn, continue in rib until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit up left front, across sleeve top to centre back neck. Cast off in rib. Mark positions for buttons on left front band, the first one to correspond with one

at commencement of front shaping and 2 (2,2,3) more equally spaced between.

### Right Front Band

Work as instructions given for left front band working buttonholes as before to correspond with positions marked for buttons. Join bands at centre back by top sewing. Pin front bands into position, sew on by top sewing.

Join side and sleeve seams by backstitching, omitting rib. Join rib by top sewing.

Sew on buttons.

Press seams.



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
